OAKLAND NOTES

Texas Oakland

- The A's snapped an 11-game streak in which they had committed at least one error, their longest streak since a 15-game streak from 5/3/15-5/18/15.
- Rajai Davis snapped a three-game (0-9) hitless streak with a double in the first inning.
- The A's went 4-for-6 (.667) to record three doubles and one single for four runs in the first inning...Oakland had scored just one run in the first innings of all prior contests this season and had a Major League low .048 (2-42) batting average in first innings.
- Jaff Decker has hit safely in all three of his starts since being selected from Triple-A Nashville (4/15/17).
- In his first start and second appearance for the A's this season, **Chad Pinder** registered his first hit - a double in the fourth inning - and his second career home run in the fifth inning...his first career home run was on 9/29/16 at Seattle.
- Khris Davis snapped his 0-6 hitless streak against Texas this series with his seventh home run of the season in the fifth inning...hit just three home runs in 23 games in April last year...is a .308 (28-91) career hitter against the Rangers with 13 home runs and 28 RBI in 25 games...the home runs and RBI are the most against any team.
- Davis is the fourth player in Oakland history with 7 home runs in the Athletics' first 15 games (Jermaine Dye, 2004; Jason Giambi, 2000; Reggie Jackson, 1974).
- Jesse Hahn earned the win in his second start and third appearance of the season...he gave up two hits...A's starting pitchers now have all seven of Oakland's wins.

TEXAS NOTES

- The Rangers' bullpen allowed five runs...previous to today's game, Texas relievers had not allowed a run for two consecutive games and had zero or one runs allowed in five of their last seven games.
- Joey Gallo snapped his 11-at bat hitless streak with a solo home run in the fifth inning...marked his third of the season, first on the road.
- In the third inning the Rangers challenged a play at first...the call was overturned and the runner was ruled safe...time of the review was 1:10.
- Texas manager Jeff Banister was ejected in the third inning by HP umpire Bill Welke.
- Martin Perez (1-2) was credited with the loss...allowed seven hits, four runs, one intentional walk, and two strikeouts in 3.2 innings, a season low.
- Delino Deshields recorded his first hit since 9/18/16, snapping a 0-for-21 streak.
