OAKLAND NOTES

- Jed Lowrie has a 70-game errorless streak as a second baseman...
 it is tied for the third-longest such streak in Oakland history.
- With a win tonight, the Athletics now have won their last four, their first four-game winning streak of the season...the last time they won four or more in a row was 9/12-9/15/2016 at Kansas City.
- Adam Rosales has now hit safely in four consecutive games.
- Trevor Plouffe registered the 100th home run of his career...marked his fourth home run in his last seven games, including back-to-back home runs (4/20 v. SEA, 4/21 v. SEA).
- Yonder Alonso registered his third home run of the season in the seventh inning...the home run gave the A's a 2-1 lead, marking the third time Alonso had a go-ahead RBI.
- Sean Manaea yielded one run and five hits in six innings to earn his first win of the season...he is now 3-0 against Seattle with one no decision (5/4/16)...has a team-high 26 strikeouts.
- Matt Joyce snapped an 0-for-13 hitless streak with a single in the seventh inning.
- The Athletics challenged a play at first base in the bottom of the fifth innning...the ruling on the field was confirmed...the time of the review was 1:16 seconds...on the season, Oakland is now 0-3 on replay challenges.

SEATTLE NOTES

- With a single in the sixth inning, Nelson Cruz extended his hitting streak against the Athletics to 10 games, dating back to 8/13/2016... he is batting .357 (15-for-42) during that stretch.
- Mitch Haniger extended his on base streak to 22 games, dating back to 9/29/2016...had his first triple of the season and his 16th RBI...leads the Mariners in RBI (Robinson Cano, 12).
- The Mariners entered the contest ranked first in the Majors with 23 double plays turned in...including tonight's first, third and eighth inning double plays, they now have 26 DP's and have recorded at least one double play in 15 of their last 18 games, including nine games with at least two double plays.
- Hisashi lwakuma recorded his first loss against the Athletic's after having won five consecutive decisions versus Oakland, dating back to 9/6/15.
- Guillermo Heredia registered his second multi-hit game of the season with a single in the third inning...last multi-hit game was 4/16/17 versus Texas.
- Seattle recorded two stolen bases (Taylor Motter, Nelson Cruz)...
 the Mariners have been successful on 15 of their 18 stolen base
 attempts (83.3%).
- After reaching base safely in all eight road games this year, Robinson Canó did not reach against the A's...with a strike out in the eighth inning, his lifetime batting average dropped to .105 (2-for-19) versus Sean Doolittle.
- Jarrod Dyson has reached safely in 15-of-his-last-16 games.
