### OAKLAND NOTES

- Jed Lowrie has a 71-game errorless streak as a second baseman...
   it is the third-longest such streak in Oakland history.
- With three singles today, **Lowrie** recorded his second three-hit game of the season (other: 4/4/2017 vs. Los Angeles-AL).
- After committing at least one error in 11 consecutive games, the Athletics have now been error-free in four straight games...the last time the A's went four games without committing an error was 9/19-9/23/2016 vs. Houston...the A's lost all four of those games.
- With a win today, the Athletics now have won their last five, their first five-game winning streak of the season...the last time they won five or more in a row was 5/28-6/1/2016.
- Adam Rosales hit the second lead-off home run of his career to tie the game (other: 5/3/2013 vs. New York-AL).
- Rosales extended his hitting streak to five games with a lead-off home run...he is batting .353 (6-for-17) during that stretch.
- Ryon Healy hit a home run and a double today and is now batting .529 (9-for-17) over his last six games.
- Ryan Madson recorded his first 1+ inning save since 6/28/16 at San Francisco.
- The Athletics challenged a play at first in the bottom of the eighth inning...the ruling on the field was overturned.

#### **SEATTLE NOTES**

- The Mariners dropped their sixth straight road game, and are 1-9 away from Safeco this season.
- With a single in the first inning, Nelson Cruz extended his hitting streak against the Athletics to 11 games, dating back to 8/13/2016... he is batting .390 (16-for-41) during that stretch.
- Mitch Haniger was hit by a pitch in the third inning, extending his on base streak to 23 games, which dates back to 9/29/2016
- Jarrod Dyson has reached safely in 16-of-his-last-17 games.
- Dyson was thrown out trying to steal second in the third inning...this
  marked the first time he has been caught stealing since 8/25/16 at
  Boston...he had 16 stolen bases during that stretch
- Robinson Canó singled twice and hit a home run for his first threehit game of the season.
- **Kyle Seager** hit his 11th career triple in the eight inning...it was his first career triple as a pinch hitter.
- In his second career appearance, Chase De Jong threw 4.0 scoreless innings, giving up one hit and two walks while striking out two batters
- The Mariners challenged the ruling that there was no violation of the slide rule in the eighth inning...the ruling on the field was confirmed.
