OAKLAND NOTES

- The Athletics snapped a streak in which they allowed at least one home run in each of the last six games (13 home runs total).
- Oakland is now 5-11 when opponents score first and 3-11 when scoring less than four.
- Rajai Davis hit a single in the third, fifth and ninth inning to snap a 0-for-6 hitless streak...the singles brought him to 1000 career hits... he now has six multi-hit games on the season, including his first three-hit game tonight.
- Andrew Triggs has allowed more hits to left-handed batters tonight (6), than he had allowed to LHB's in five games prior to the start.
- Khris Davis extended his hitting streak against the Tigers to nine games (13-for-37, .351).
- Jed Lowrie extended his hitting streak to three games (4-for-12)... he is now batting .346 (18-for-52) over his last 14 games after hitting .171 over his 12 previous contests.
- Lowrie is a .327 (36-for-110) career hitter against Detroit, which is his best average against any AL team.
- Yonder Alonso registered two RBI in the contest...he now has 12 RBI over his last 15 games and is batting .348 (16-for-46) in the same span.
- Despite coming in to the contest hitting .190 (8-for-42) against right handed pitchers, Adam Rosales recorded two hits off of righty Michael Fulmer...registered his third multi-hit game of the season.
- Matt Joyce struck out a season-high three times...last time he struck out three times or more in a game was 9/24/16 vs Washington as a member of the Pittsburgh Pirates.
- The Athletics challenged a call in the second inning...the ruling on the field was confirmed...the duration of the challenge was 59 seconds...Oakland is now 1-5 in challenges during the season.

DETROIT NOTES

- Miguel Cabrera extended his hitting streak to four games (.438, 7-for-16) with a single in the first inning...he is now batting .390 (16for-41) with three doubles, four home runs and 11 RBI over his last 11 games.
- James McCann went 0-for-4, bringing his hitless streak to 0-for-15 in his last five games, dating back to 4/27/2017 vs. Seattle.
- Victor Martinez has now hit safely in 13 of his last 17 games and is batting .299 (20-for-67) with four doubles, one home run and 14 RBI during the 17-game stretch...he recorded his third three-hit game of
- Jim Adduci recorded the second triple of his career.
- Andrew Romine recorded his 200th career hit in the third inning... he had 2 hits in the game (201 career) and one run (97 career runs).
- Michael Fulmer registered a season-high nine strikeouts...his career high is 11 (5/21/2016 vs. Tampa Bay).
- Tigers are now 11-4 when scoring five-or-more runs.
- Detroit relievers have not allowed a single run in their last five games combined.
