#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Athletics have now won back-to-back games in which they trailed after the seventh inning or later...they had lost 28-straight such games prior to this weekend, which was the longest active streak in the majors.
- Yonder Alonso hit his ninth home run of the season in the fourth inning...he has now matched his career high for home runs in a season (2012).
- Alonso is the only American League player to hit five home runs this week.
- Trevor Plouffe recorded his first multi-hit game of the season.
- Ryon Healy hit his second career walk-off home run (other: 7/23/2016 vs. Tampa Bay).
- The Athletics allowed just one home run this series after allowing 10 last series vs. Minnesota...it was the first time the A's had allowed 10 or more home runs in a three-game series since 8/23 to 8/25/2011 vs. New York-AL.
- In the second inning, the Athletics challenged a play at second base...the ruling on the field was overturned and the runner was caught stealing...the time of review was 2:25.

#### **DETROIT NOTES**

- Miguel Cabrera extended his hitting streak to six games (.391, 9-for-23) with a single in the fifth inning...he is now batting .375 (18-for-48) with three doubles, four home runs and 12 RBI over his last 13 games.
- Victor Martinez has now hit safely in 15 of his last 19 games and is batting .303 (23-for-76) with four doubles, one home run and 15 RBI during the 18-game stretch.
- With singles in the third and fifth innings, Dixon Machado recorded his third career two-hit game (last: 9/28/2015 at Texas).
- James McCann snapped an 0-for-17 streak dating back to 4/27 with a home run in the sixth inning...six of his 10 hits this season have been home runs.
- Nicholas Castellanos doubled in the third inning and now is one double shy of 100 career doubles...prior to today's game, he was tied for third in the American League in doubles this season.
