OAKLAND NOTES

- Tonight's walk-off marks the first time the Athletics have won threestraight games in walk-off fashion since 6/1-6/3/2004...it marks the first time they won back-to-back games on walk-off home runs since June 1-2, 2004 (Bobby Kielty and Mark Kotsay).
- The Athletics are now 1-1 when playing extra innings...previous extra inning contest was against the Angels as well...Oakland snapped a three-game losing streak to the Angels.
- With a home run in the fourth inning, **Jed Lowrie** extended his hitting streak to six games (8-for-25, .320)...is batting .338 (22-for-65) over his last 17 games after hitting .171 over his previous 12 contests.
- Lowrie hit his second home run of the night in the 11th inning to record his fourth career game-ending RBI...it was his second walk-off home run (Aug. 21, 2010 vs. Toronto)...it is his second go-ahead RBI on the season and third career multi-homer game, previous was 10/3/2010 vs. New York.
- **Trevor Plouffe** recorded his second multi-hit game of the season with a double in the third inning and a home run in the fifth inning...the last time he had back-to-back multi-hit games was 8/29-8/30/2016 vs Clevaland.
- Adam Rosales extended his hitting streak to six games...is 7-for-23 (.304) with four RBI over his last six games.
- Kendall Graveman pitched 7.0 innings to tie a season-high and was one strike out away from tying his season-high of seven strikeouts.
- Stephen Vogt snapped an 0-for-10 hitless streak with a single in the seventh...it is his first hit throughout the A's current homestand.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Angels are now to 3-3 in extra innings.
- In his sixth apperance for the Angels this season, Luis Valbuena hit his first home run of the season...it took him 25 games in 2016 to record a home run.
- The Angels have now homered in 21 of last 25 meetings with Oakland.
- Danny Espinosa extended his hitless streak to 31 at-bats...his streak dates back to 4/26/2017 vs Oakland.
- Ben Revere had his third multi-hit game of the season with two doubles and a single in the contest, while Luis Valbuena tallied his second multi-hit game of the season with a home run in the first inning and a single in the 11th inning.
- With two strikesouts in the second innning, Ricky Nolasco amassed 1,400 career strikeout...he is currently tied with Aaron Sele for 240th all time in strikeouts.
- Nolasco recorded a season-high 10 strikeouts...previous season high was seven on 4/13/2017 vs. Texas...today marks the first time he has struck out more than 10 batters since 8/28/2013 (11).
- Andrelton Simmons left the game in the bottom of the second with a contusion on his left hand and right thumb...x-rays were negative and he is listed as day-to-day.
