#### OAKLAND NOTES

- Oakland has won the first three meetings of 2017, which is one more than their combined win total against Boston from the previous two seasons (2), going 1-5 against the Red Sox last year and in 2015.
- With a stolen base in the second inning, Rajai Davis now has 121 steals, tying Mike Davis in Oakland history for eighth most (Jose Canseco is seventh with 135)...Davis' 34 career stolen bases against Boston are second only to his 36 against Chicago (AL).
- Since being recalled on 5/9, Mark Canha has recorded a .440 (11-for-25) batting average, three doubles, one triple, three home runs (including his first career walk-off home run), and seven RBI.
- Khris Davis recorded his 13th home run of the season and his 10th go-ahead RBI for Oakland...is now a .388 (19-for-49) career hitter against Boston with seven doubles, three home runs and nine RBI in 12 games.
- Ryon Healy extended his hitting streak to eight games (.313/10-for-32) with a single in the fourth innning.
- The A's recorded four home runs, a season-high for a single game...
  Oakland has homered in 13 of their last 14 games (34 of 43 on the year)...are 19-15 when homering versus 1-8 when going homerless.
- A's bullpen has not allowed a run in 25 straight innings at home... the last run they allowed was in the sixth inning on May 7 vs. Detroit.
- The A's challenged a ruling on the field in the second inning in which Chris Young was called safe at second...the ruling stands after two minutes of review...Oakland is now 2-6 in challenges this season.
- Manager Bob Melvin was ejected by third base umpire and crew chief Mike Winters in the third inning...it marks his first ejection of the season.

#### **BOSTON NOTES**

- With a double in the second and a single in the fourth, Chris Young recorded his eighth multi-hit game of the season.
- With a home run in the second inning, Hanley Ramirez has reached base safely in 17 of his last 18 starts...recorded his seventh multi-hit game of the season.
- Mookie Betts (0-for-4) snapped a 41-game on base streak against AL West opponents...also snapped a four game hitting streak.
- Dustin Pedroia has hit safely in each of his last 23 games vs Oakland...during the streak, which began on 7/14/13, Pedroia has posted a .396 batting average (36-for-91), six doubles and three home runs.
- Pedroia owns the majors' longest active hitting streak against the A's at 23 games, passing Jim Rice for the longest hitting streak by a Red Sox vs. Oakland.
- There was a crew chief review in the ninth inning in which Chris Young's hit was ruled foul...the ruling on the field stands...time of the replay was one minute.
