OAKLAND NOTES

- Rajai Davis extended his hitting streak to four games...he is hitting .278 (5-for-18) during this homestand.
- In his third multi-hit game of the year, Chad Pinder recorded his fifth home run of the year in the fourth inning...it is the first time in his career that he has hit home runs in back-to-back games...
- Ryon Healy extended his hitting streak to nine games (.306/11-for-36) with a single in the fourth innning.
- The A's matched their season-high with three errors in today's game, last occurence was 4/28/17 vs. Houston.
- Oakland has homered in 14 of their last 15 games (35 of 44 on the year)...are 19-16 when homering versus 1-8 when going homerless.
- A's bullpen snapped a streak in which they had not allowed a run in 27 straight innings at home.

BOSTON NOTES

- Dustin Pedroia has hit safely in each of his last 24 games vs Oakland...during the streak, which began on 7/14/13, Pedroia has posted a .396 batting average (38-for-96), six doubles, three home runs, and 14 RBI.s
- Pedroia owns the majors' longest active hitting streak against the A's at 24 games, passing Jim Rice for the longest hitting streak by a Red Sox vs. Oakland.
- Mitch Moreland and Hanley Ramirez both extended their hitting streaks to four games...Ramirez has now reached base safely in 18 of his last 19 starts and today recorded his eighth multi-hit game, first game with three hits and first game with.
- Andrew Benintendi has now reached base in 32 of 41 games this year...he stole two bases today, the first time he has had a multisteal game in his career.
- With a double in the eighth, Jackie Bradley Jr. snapped an 0-11 hitless streak...it marked his second double of the year...today marked his seventh multi-hit game.
- Christian Vázquez went 3-for-5 (.600) today and recorded his sixth multi-hit game, second with three hits...he also had one run and one RBI.
- The Red Sox stole a season-high four bases (Benintendi (2), Bogaerts, Vázquez).
