OAKLAND NOTES

- With a home run in the first inning, **Khris Davis** has now homered four times in his last nine games after going homerless in each of his previous 12 contests...he leads the A's with 14 home runs on the year.
- Jed Lowrie (4-for-4) extended his hitting streak to six games with two singles and two doubles...he recorded his 16th multi-hit game, leading the team with 13 two-hit games, three three-hit games, and one four-hit game...today's contest marked his first four-hit game of the year and seventh of his career...last four-hit game was 4/19/2016 at New York.
- Lowrie hit .520 (13-for-25) on the homestand after going 4-for-31 (.129) over his previous eight contests...now has 14 doubles and six home runs in 45 games this year...had 12 doubles and two home runs in 87 games last year.
- Oakland has homered in 16 of their last 17 games (37 of 46 on the year)...are 20-17 when homering versus 1-8 when going homer-less...the A's have recorded 21 multi-homer games on the season.
- **Ryon Healy** extended his hitting streak to 11 games with a double in the fourth inning...is batting .311 (14-for-45) during the streak...it is his third career hitting streak of 10 or more games.
- A's pitcher **Sonny Gray** had a season-high 11 strikeouts, which was the second best single-game mark of his career (12, Sept. 23, 2014 vs. Los Angeles).
- In his longest apperance of the season (7.0 innings), **Gray** held Miami to a season-tying low three hits and just one run.

MIAMI NOTES

- Edinson Volquez extended his career long losing streak to seven games...the streak dates back to 9/15/2016...he tied Joe Fontenot to own the club's record for consecutive losses to open a season (7).
- After hitting safely in his last 15 road games, batting .379 (22-for-58 during the streak, J.T. Realmuto snapped his streak going 0-for-3 today.
- Justin Bour has hit safely in all six games on the Marlins current road trip, homering in four of the six contests...8 of his 12 homers this season have been solo shots.
- Marcell Ozuna now has a hit in all five career games against Oakland (4-for-18, two doubles, 1 home run, three RBI).
- Miami is now 1-12 when going homerless and 1-21 when out-hit by oppenent.
