OAKLAND NOTES

- The A's have registered home runs in 45 of 56 games...Oakland now has 84 home runs for the season, the most in Athletics history after 56 games
- Oakland has hit a home run all of their home games except for four... of the A's 84 home runs, 51 have come in the Coliseum...the A's lead the majors in home runs at home.
- Matt Joyce has reached base in five straight games and has at least one walk in his last four games...recorded his first grand slam of the season, his fifth career grand slam...first since 5/25/2012.
- Sonny Gray matched a season-high seven inningss pitched.
- Khris Davis registered a home run and two RBI in the seventh inning to record his second game-tying RBI of the year...he now has 11 multi-hit games (three three-hit games) this season.
- Trevor Plouffe extended his hitless streak to 22 at bats.
- Chad Pinder snapped his hitless streak of four games (0-for-13) • with a double in eighth inning.
- The Athletics challenged a play at second in the eighth inning...the ruling on the field was confirmed.....the A's are now 3-9 in challenges for the season.
- Frankie Montas allowed a season-high two home runs and five earned runs

WASHINGTON NOTES

- Ryan Zimmerman extended his hitting streak to eight games with a single in the second inning...in that span, he is 14-for-32 (.438) with two doubles, three home runs, nine RBI and eight runs.
- Zimmerman recorded his 25th multi-RBI game and his 23rd multihit game of the season...his ninth three-hit game this year.
- Ten of Zimmerman's 16 home runs this season have come with runners on base...with 231 career home runs, he is just three away from tying Vladimir Guerrero for first on the franchise (WSH/MON) all-time list...he is six away from tying Frank Howard (237) for the most home runs in D.C. baseball history.
- With a single in the sixth inning, Michael A. Taylor has hit safely in 16 of his last 20 games.
- · Matt Wieters recorded a single in the seventh and has now hit safely in 22 of his last 28 games, reaching base safely in 34 of 45 games.
- Trea Turner recorded a triple and two RBI in the sixth inning to give Washington the lead...it marks his third triple of the season...he recorded his 15th two-hit game.
- Tanner Roark has thrown seven innings pitched or more in his last three straight starts, tied for the third-longest such streak of his career.
- The Nationals recorded back-to-back home runs in the ninth inning, their fourth set of the season.
