#### OAKLAND NOTES

- **Jesse Hahn** picked up his first win since 4/19 vs. Texas.
- **Ryon Healy** committed his seventh error at third base...entering tonight, the Athletics were tied for second in the AL with 12 total errors by third basemen.
- **Healy** has 10 RBI during the last four games...he is batting .571 (8-for-14) during that stretch.
- **Yonder Alonso** matched a season high with three strikeouts...it was his 12th career three-strikeout game.
- The Athletics failed to hit a home run tonight after homering in four straight games...their 10 home runs from 6/2 to 6/5 were tied for most in the majors with the Astros and the Nationals.
- The Athletics have now won two consecutive games while being outhit by their opponent...the last time they did this was 6/28 and 6/29/2016 against San Francisco.

#### TORONTO NOTES

- **Kevin Pillar** singled in the fifth inning and now has a hit in 15 of his 17 career games against the Athletics.
- The Blue Jays have now scored three runs or fewer for four straight games...the last time they were held to three runs or fewer for four or more consecutive games was 4/8 to 4/13/2017.
- Toronto ended its hitless streak with runners in scoring position at 34 at bats...it is the longest streak in franchise history (previous: 30 at bats, 8/23 to 8/26/1990).
- The Blue Jays challenged a play at first in the fourth inning...the ruling on the field was reversed and the runner was safe...the approximate time of review was 51 seconds.
