OAKLAND NOTES

- **Jesse Hahn** allowed his first home run since April 19...the 49.2-inning homerless streak was the fourth-longest active such streak in the majors entering today.
- **Hahn** allowed eight runs in the second inning...eight runs is the most the A's have allowed in an inning this season.
- **Khris Davis** doubled in the sixth inning...it was his 100th career double.
- After being recalled earlier today, **Bruce Maxwell** recorded his third career three-hit game (last: 9/25/2016 vs. Texas)...it was the first three-hit game by an Oakland catcher this season (last: Maxwell on 9/25/2016 vs. Texas)
- **Matt Olson** singled in the first and doubled in the eighth for the first multi-hit game of his career.
- The Athletics committed their 68th error of the season...entering today, the A's led majors in errors by 12 (Milwaukee, 55).

HOUSTON NOTES

- **Jake Marisnick** hit his 10th home run of the season, surpassing his previous career high (nine in 2015).
- The Astros scored eight runs in the second inning which is the third time they have scored eight or more runs in an inning this season (9 runs on 6/14, 11 runs on 5/29)
- **George Springer** exited the game in the first inning after being hit by a pitch...he suffered a left hand contusion and is day-to-day.
- **Norichika Aoki** recorded his third three-hit game of the season (last: 6/11 vs. Los Angeles-AL)...it was the first time he has hit multiple doubles in a game this season.
- **Josh Reddick** recorded his fifth three-hit game of the season (last: 6/11 vs. Los Angeles-AL).
- The Astros have won 10 straight games at the Coliseum, which is one shy of a franchise record for most consecutive wins at a ballpark (Great American Ballpark, 2007-2009).
