OAKLAND NOTES

- Daniel Gossett allowed his ninth homer of the season in the second inning and his 10th in the fifth...has allowed a homer in six of his seven starts...his 10 homers allowed this season is second among Athletics' hurlers (Cotton, 13).
- **Gossett** (L, 7 ip, 7 h, 3 r, 3 er, 1 bb, 3 so, 2 hr) recorded his third quality start of the season, first since June 24 at Chicago...his seven innings was the longest of his career, previous high was 6.2 vs. Houston.
- Khris Davis (1-4, hr, rbi) belted his 26th homer of the season in the fourth inning...he now has 68 homers over the last two seasons, which leads the MLB.
- Blake Treinen (1 ip, 1 bb) made his Oakland A's debut after being traded from Washington yesterday...he tossed one inning.
- The Athletics' streak of five straight home victories was snapped. The club has a record of 27-22 at the Coliseum and a record of 15-29 on the road.
- Oakland suffered their first loss since the All-Star break... they entered the day one of two teams undefeated teams in the AL (Seattle, 4-0).

TAMPA BAY NOTES

- Jake Odorizzi (W, 7 ip, 1 h, 1 r, 1 er, 2 bb, 5 so, 1 hr) earned his first victory vs. Oakland...he entered the game 0-2 with a 3.97 ERA in four games vs. OAK.
- Odorizzi has now allowed a home run in each of his last 14 starts.
- Steven Souza Jr. (1-4, r, hr, rbi) added to his career-high in homers with his 19th of the season in the second...all of his homers this season have come against RHP.
- With a single in the first inning, **Evan Longoria** (2-4, r, hr, 2 rbi) extended his hitting streak to 10 games, longest of the season...he is batting .405 (15-for-37) over that span.
- **Tim Beckham** (0-2, 2 so) was ejected by home plate umpire Lance Barrett in the bottom of the fourth inning...it was his first career ejection.
- **Trevor Plouffe** (0-2) entered the game at second base in the bottom of the fourth inning, it was his first appearance at second base since 4/24/2012 and his 24th career appearance at the position.
- Alex Colomé (SV, 1 ip, 1 h, 1 r, 1 er) has convereted seven straight save opportunities and is 10 for his last 11 since blowing a save vs OAK on 6/11.
- Tampa Bay snapped a three game losing streak at the Coliseum with the victory, and clinched the season series as they improved to 4-1 vs. OAK this season.
