OAKLAND NOTES

- Paul Blackburn (6.1 ip, 8 h, 5 er, 1 bb, 4 so) turned in another lengthy start, going into the seventh inning while allowing five runs on eight hits and recording his second major league victory...in his six starts this season, Blackburn has continued into the seventh inning in three of them.
- Marcus Semien's (2 for 5, 2 r, 4 rbi) grand slam was the second of his major league career...his first came on 4/23/14 at Detroit, while he was a member of the White Sox.
- With Bruce Maxwell's (1 for 4, r, 2b, bb) strikeout in the eighth inning, the Athletics set a new franchise record for strikeouts in the month of July, with 229...The previous record was 225, set in 2012.
- Blake Treinen (1 ip, sv) recorded his first save as an Athletic, after being acquired from Washington on 7/16/2017.
- Oakland hit three doubles, the fourth consecutive game in which the Athletics have hit at least three...It was the second time in 2017 that the team has hit three doubles in four consecutive games...the first stretch came from 6/6/2017 vs. Toronto to 6/10/2017 at Tampa Bay.
- Chad Pinder (r) made his first appearance since being activated off of the diabled list...he had not appeared since 6/23/2017 at Chicago-AL...Pinder was placed on the DL with a strained left hamstring.

- Matt Cain (5 ip, 7 h, 2 er, 3 bb, 1 so) lasted only five innings, allowing two runs on seven hits, and did not take a decision... Cain has not won a decision since 5/15/17 vs. Los Angeles-NL.
- Carlos Moncrief (2 for 4, rbi, 2b) recorded his first major league hit and RBI with his single in the fourth inning...his double in the 7th inning was the first extra-base hit in his career.
- Denard Span (1 for 5) broke an 0-for-14 stretch with a single in the seventh inning.
- Buster Posev (2 for 4. r. rbi) recorded his 32nd multiple-hit game of the season, the most of any Giants player.
- Johnny Cueto threw three innings in a rehab start for Class-A San Jose, allowing no runs and two hits while walking one and striking out four.
