OAKLAND NOTES

- Sean Manaea (L, .1 ip, 6 h, 6 er, bb) endured the shortest outing of his career, lasting only a third of an inning...all seven batters he faced reached base, and he allowed three doubles...Manaea recorded new career lows in innings (.1) and pitches thrown (28).
- Michael Brady (5.1 ip, 7 h, 3 er, 5 so, 2 hbp) gave the Athletics 5.1 innings in long relief...it was Brady's second consecutive game going at least 5 innings in a relief role.
- The Athletics allowed seven runs in the first inning...it was the 15th time that the team has given up seven in the opening frame...the last time was 6/3/2016 at Houston, a game the A's lost by a 12-2 final.
- In his first game as an Athletic, Boog Powell (1 for 4, r, bb, 3 so) also recorded his first hit and run scored with the club.
- With 11 strikeouts, the Athletics recorded their 59th double-digit strikeout game of the season...this matches their all-time mark of 59, which they set in 2012.
- The eight doubles allowed by Athletics pitchers are an Oakland record...the previous record was seven, on 12 separate occasions.

BALTIMORE NOTES

- **Dylan Bundy** (W, 6 ip, 7 h, 3 er, 3 bb, 10 so, 2 hr) went six strong innings, allowing three runs on seven hits...Bundy tied his career high in strikeouts, which was set in his last start on 8/7/17 at Los Angeles-AL.
- **Bundy** threw 104 pitches...in 23 starts, he has thrown at least 100 pitches 15 times.
- The Orioles scored seven runs in the first inning for the 12th time in franchise history...the last time was 5/20/2008 at New York-AL, a game the O's won 12-2.
- Tim Beckham (4 for 5, 3 r, 3 2b, bb) extended his hitting streak to 12 games, matching a career high set on 4/4/2017 vs. New York-AL, while he was a member of the Rays...it was Beckham's third career four-hit game, and first career game with three doubles.
- **Beckham** is one of three players in Orioles history to begin his Baltimore career with a hitting streak of 12 or more games...the other two are David Newhan and Javy Lopez, both in 2004.
- Welington Castillo (0 for 5, r, rbi) failed to extend his tengame hitting streak to eleven games.
- The Orioles hit eight doubles, their most since 6/14/2012 vs. Pittsburgh.
- With his single in the first inning, **Chris Davis** (2 for 4, bb) snapped an 0-for-13 stretch.
