OAKLAND NOTES

- **Daniel Gossett** (6.0 ip, 5 h, 1 r, 1 er, 3 bb, 7 so) posted a career-high seven strikeouts (previous: six, four times; last: 8/28/2017 at Los Angeles-AL).
- **Ryon Healy** (0-for-4, r, bb, 3 so) snapped a five-game hitting streak...he was batting .400 (8-for-20) during the streak.
- **Matt Joyce** (0-for-3, r, bb, 3 so) snapped a seven-game hitting streak...he was batting .355 (11-for-31) during the streak.
- **Marcus Semien** (1-for-3, r, 3 bb, so) stole his 10th base of the season, matching his 2016 total...last season, his 10th stole base came in his 157th game...he reached that mark in his 66th game this season.
- **Khris Davis** (2-for-6, 2 rbi, 3 so) drove in his 100th and 101st runs of the season...he is the first Athletic with back-to-back 100-RBI seasons since Miguel Tejada (2000-2003) and Eric Chavez (2001-2003)
- The A's walked 13 times, which were their most walks since May 18, 2007 against San Francisco when they also had 13.

HOUSTON NOTES

- **Juan Centeno** (0-for-0) exited the game in the second inning with an apparent injury...he is being evaluated for a concussion.
- **Jake Marisnick** (0-for-3, 2 so) extended his hitless streak to 14 at bats.
- **Tyler Clippard** (0.1 ip, 1 h, 3 r, 3 er, 3 bb) walked three consecutive batters in the sixth inning, bringing his season total to 30 walks...entering today, he was tied for ninth among AL relievers in walks.
- The Astros have lost three straight games to the Athletics for the first time since they lost five straight from 8/7/2015 to 9/8/2015.
- This marks the first time the Astros have lost back-to-back games at the Coliseum since 7/18 and 7/19/2016...they won 10 straight games in the interim.
