#### OAKLAND NOTES

- **Matt Chapman** (2-for-3, r, 2 rbi, 2 bb, hr) became the second rookie (Kevan Smith, Chicago-AL) to hit a home run off of Dallas Keuchel this season...it was just the 13th home run allowed by Keuchel overall this season.
- **Marcus Semien** (0-for-4, r, rbi, 2 bb, 2 so) stole his 11th base of the season, matching a career high (2015).
- The A's hit four home runs today, their 205th, 206th, 207th and 208th of the season, surpassing the 2002 team's total for fourth in A's history.
- The A's swept their second four-game series of the season (other: 6/15-6/18 vs. New York-AL)...it was the first time they have recorded two four-game sweeps at home in a season since 1977 (4/11-4/14/1977 vs. California, 9/26-9/28/1977 vs. Kansas City).
- A's batters walked 25 times this series, which is tied for the third most by a team in a four-game series this season.
- **Mark Canha** (3-for-4, rbi, so) recorded his third three-hit game of the season (last: 5/19 vs. Boston).

- **Dallas Keuchel** (5.2 ip, 6 h, 4 r, 4 er, 4 bb, 4 so, hr) issued a season-high four walks today...the Astros walked seven batters with the bases loaded this series, bringing their season total to 12.
- **Josh Reddick** (0-for-3) snapped his hitting streak at eight games...this matched his longest hitting streak of the season.
- **Jose Altuve** (2-for-4, r) hit his 242nd career double and is now in sole possession of the sixth spot on the Astros' career doubles list.
- **J.D. Davis** (1-for-1, r, rbi, hr) hit his first career pinch hit home run in his second career pinch hit at bat.
- **Jake Marisnick** (0-for-2, 2 so) was ejected in the fifth inning by home plate umpire Ramon De Jesus.
