### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's are batting .301 (154 for 512) with 89 runs scored and 39 doubles over the last 14 games...are 1-2 on this seven-game homestand against Toronto (1-2) and Texas (four games).
- A's starting pitchers are 2-4 with an 8.60 ERA (43 er in 45.0 ip) over the last eight games.
- **Vin Mazzaro** has allowed at least six runs in each of his last four starts and is one of only three pitchers in Oakland history to have done so (also, Dave Stewart from June 10-25, 1991 and Bill Krueger from May 26- June 14, 1985)...is 0-3 with a 11.29 ERA (23 er in 18.1 ip) over that span.
- **Russ Springer** tossed a season-high 2.0 innings, which are his most innings pitched since also tossing 2.0 innings on September 28, 2005 at St. Louis for Houston.
- **Adam Kennedy** (1 for 4) has a season-high nine-game hitting streak and is batting .333 (15 for 45) over that span.
- **Mark Ellis** (1 for 4) has a seven-game hitting streak and is batting .357 (10 for 28) with a home run, five doubles, five RBI and nine runs scored over that span.
- **Rajai Davis** (2 for 4) has a career-high tying seven-game hitting streak, batting .400 (10 for 25) over that stretch.

- **Ricky Romero** is 7-1 with a 3.36 ERA (22 er in 59.0 ip) over his last nine starts.
- **Josh Roenicke** made his Blue Jays debut.
- **Aaron Hill** (2 for 5) has hit a home run in back-to-back games for the fourth time this season...has a 12-game hitting streak and is batting .353 (18 for 51) with six home runs, five doubles and 16 RBI over that stretch.
