## OAKLAND NOTES

• The Oakland A's had their fifth shutout of the season (last, July 6 at Boston)...had their first shutout against the Rangers since July 18, 2007...are now 3-2 on this seven-game homestand against Toronto (1-2) and Texas (2-0).

• Gio Gonzalez is 2-0 with a 1.93 ERA (18.2 ip, 10 h, 4 r, 4 er, 10 bb, 21 so, 0 hr) over his last three starts.

• Nomar Garciaparra (1 for 4) is a .387 (101 for 261) career hitter against Texas, the second best mark ever against the Rangers.

• Tommy Everidge (2 for 3) has started each of the A's eight games since being called up a week ago today...has reached base via hit

or walk in all eight games and has hit safely in seven, including each of his last six (8 for 22, .364).

• Mark Ellis (3 for 4) has a season-high nine-game hitting streak and is batting .389 (14 for 36) with a home run, five doubles, nine RBI and nine runs scored over that span.

• Rajai Davis (0 for 3) had his career-high tying eight-game hitting streak snapped and is now batting .379 (11 for 29) over his last nine games.

## TEXAS NOTES

• The Texas Rangers are 0-2 on their 10-game road trip trough Oakland (0-2), Anaheim (three games) and Cleveland (three games).

• Eddie Guardado made the 900<sup>th</sup> appearance of his career, becoming the 21<sup>st</sup> pitcher in Major League history to appear in at least 900 games...is just the fifth lefthander in ML history to do so (also, Jesse Orosco-1252, Mike Stanton-1178, John Franco-1119 and Dan Plesac-1064)...is one of three active pitchers with at least 900 appearances (also, Trevor Hoffman and David Weathers).

• Doug Mathis had his 22.0-inning scoreless streak as a reliever snapped in the eighth inning...the 22.0 innings are the second most scoreless relief innings to begin a career since research is first available in 1954.

• Michael Young (1 for 3) has a season-high tying 11-game hitting streak (also, April 26-May 7) and is batting .475 (19 for 40) over that stretch...the streak is also the longest by a Ranger this season.

• Marlon Byrd (2 for 4) has a six-game hitting streak, batting .348 (8 for 23) with two home runs and six RBI over that stretch.
