OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's have won three-games in a row for the first time since having a seven-game winning streak from June 2-8...hit a season-high tying four home runs (also, May 23 vs. Arizona and July 20 vs. Minnesota)...are now 4-2 on this seven-game homestand against Toronto (1-2) and Texas (3-0).
- Cliff Pennington (1 for 3) hit the first home run of his career in the fourth inning.
- Mark Ellis (1 for 4) has a season-high 10-game hitting streak and is batting .375 (15 for 40) with a home run, six doubles, nine RBI and 10 runs scored over that span.
- Rajai Davis (2 for 4) is batting .333 (39 for 117) over his last 45 games.
- Tommy Everidge (0 for 3) has started each of the A's nine games since being called up July 28...has reached base via hit or walk in all nine games...had his six-game hitting streak snapped and is now batting .320 (8 for 25) over his last seven games.

TEXAS NOTES

- The Texas Rangers are 0-3 on their 10-game road trip trough Oakland (0-3), Anaheim (three games) and Cleveland (three games).
- Vicente Padilla allowed a season-high three home runs...the three home runs ties the most allowed by a Texas starter this season (four times)...is now 5-2 with a 4.97 ERA (37 er in 67.0 ip) in 14 career appearances, 12 starts, against Oakland...including 3-1 with a 6.31 ERA (29 er in 41.1 ip) over 10 career appearances, eight starts, against the A's at the Coliseum.
- Darren O'Day has retired each of his last 18 batters faced.
- David Murphy (2 for 4) had the second two home run game of his career (also, June 11, 2008 at Kansas City).
- Michael Young (1 for 3) has a season-high 12-game hitting streak and is batting .465 (20 for 43) over that stretch...the streak is also the longest by a Ranger this season.
- Marlon Byrd (1 for 4) has a seven-game hitting streak, batting .333 (9 for 27) with two home runs and six RBI over that stretch.
