#### WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox, defending American League Central champions, have lost five of their last seven games as they continue a six-game, seven-day trip tonight in Oakland ... righthander Jose Contreras takes the mound for the White Sox, who have lost 12 of their last 15 games on the road.
- The White Sox opened the trip by losing two of three games to Seattle, including a 1-0, 14-inning setback on Wednesday (see note below) ... Ken Griffey Jr. hit a game-winning single with two outs in the 14th ... Mark Buehrle threw 8.0 scoreless IP in a no decision, and Mark Kotsay recorded his first multihit game since joining the Sox.
- Alexei Ramirez hit a game-winning, three-run homer in the ninth inning off David Aardsma on Tuesday to give the Sox a 3-1 victory ... John Danks earned the win, allowing one run over 8.0 IP with eight strikeouts, and Bobby Jenks recorded his first save since 7/20 vs. Tampa Bay as the Sox improved to 1-49 this season when trailing after eight innings.
- The Sox lost the opener on the trip, 6-4, as Seattle scored three runs in the sixth inning to erase a 4-3 deficit.
- Following this series, the Sox return home for six games in seven days vs. Kansas City (8/17-19) and Balitmore (8/21-23).
- The White Sox went 6-4 on their last homestand vs. the Yankees (3-1), Angels (2-1) and Cleveland (1-2) ... the Sox lost each finale against the Yankees and Angels in bids for sweeps.
- The Sox have used 87 different lineups this season.

#### WHITE SOX VS. OAKLAND

- The A's lead the season series, 3-1, after winning three of four games in Chicago on 6/1-4 ... the Sox won the opener before Oakland won the last three by a 17-3 margin, including a pair of
- The Sox are batting .205 (25-122) with a 4.00 ERA (16 ER/36.0 IP) and have been outscord by Oakland, 19-9.
- The White Sox went 5-4 in 2008 for their first series win since 1999 (1-7-1) ... Chicago took two of three games on 8/15-17 for its first season series win at McAfee Coliseum since 8/28-30/00 ... the Sox also won back-to-back games at Oakland for the first time since 8/29-30/00.
- The Sox trail all-time, 254-276 ... they are 43-49 at U.S. Cellular Field and 139-157 in Oakland ... since the start of the 2001 season, Oakland is 49-24 overall and 28-8 at home

#### ROSTER MOVES

- Prior to tonight's game, the White Sox placed INF Chris Getz on the 15-day disabled list (retro to 8/12) with a strained right oblique and recalled INF Brent Lillibridge from Class AAA Charlotte.
- Lillibridge, 25, was hitting .252 (62-246) with three homers, 24 RBI and 17 stolen bases in 67 games with Charlotte ... he also has batted .162 (11-68) in 24 games with the Sox this season.

  Getz, 25, is batting .267 (83-311) with two home runs, 28 RBI
- and 18 stolen bases in 89 games with Chicago in 2009 ... he ranks among the AL rookie leaders in numerous categories.

#### POSTING ZEROES

- The White Sox suffered a 1-0 loss in 14 innings at Seattle on Wednesday ... it was the Sox longest scoreless game since 9/22/75 at California when they dropped a 3-0 decision in 16 innings on Adrian Garrett's three-run homer off Goose Gossage.
- The club record for scoreless innings to start a game is 17 set on 6/8/47 vs. Washington and 5/15/18 at Washington, both of which resulted in 1-0 losses in 18 innings.
- The Sox struck out 16 times on Wednesday, were 1-14 with runners in scoring position and left 14 runners on base.

## PEAVY UPDATE

- Jake Peavy, who has been on the disabled list since 6/13 with a strained tendon in his right ankle, threw 3.0 scoreless IP last night in his first rehabilitation start ... Peavy allowed just one hit and one walk and struck out five vs. Pawtucket ... he threw 43 pitches (26 strikes), and his fastball reached 94 mph.
- Peavy, who was acquired from San Diego on 7/31, is scheduled to make his next start for Charlotte on Tuesday.

- The White Sox victory on Tuesday at Seattle was their first when trailing after eight innings since 8/24/08 vs. Tampa Bay and first on the road since 7/25/08 at Detroit ... the Sox were 0-49 this season when behind entering the ninth.
- Alexei Ramirez hit his first career home run in the eighth inning or later that gave the Sox the lead ... he tied games with solo homers on 7/1/08 vs. Cleveland in the 10th inning and 8/5/08 vs. Detroit in the eighth, both of which the Sox eventually won.

#### SOUTHPAW SUCCESS

- The White Sox are 20-16 vs. left-handed starters this season after going 31-20 in 2008  $\dots$  the Sox rank second in the American League with a .284 (301-1,059) average vs. lefties
- Alexei Ramirez (3rd, .385) and Paul Konerko (4th, .373) rank among the AL leaders vs. lefties.

#### PACK YOUR BAGS

- The White Sox are in the middle of a stretch from 8/10-9/3 where they play 17 of 23 games on the road (1-2 so far) ... the Sox also are on the road for 11 games at Boston (four), New York and Minnesota (three each) and the Cubs (one) from 8/24-9/3.
- The Sox are 3-12 on the road since 7/4 to fall to 25-30 ... in those 15 games, the Sox are hitting .235 (120-511) with a 4.51 ERA (65 ER/129.2 IP) and have been outscored, 72-53 ... five of the 12 losses have come by one run and four by two runs.

#### **UNPACK YOUR BATS**

- The White Sox have scored five runs or less in 22 of their last 26 games ... the Sox went 22-107 (.205) with seven runs scored in the three-game series at Seattle and were 5-28 with runners in scoring position.
- Jermaine Dye is hitless in his last 12 at-bats and is 1-18 (.056) in his last five games ... Paul Konerko has gone 2-21 (.095) over his last six games, and rookie Gordon Beckham is 4-26 (.154) in his last seven.

## THOME TALK

■ Jim Thome needs one home run to tie Reggie Jackson for 12th place on the all-time list with 563 and one walk to move past Eddie Yost into 10th with 1,615 ... Thome moved past Willie McCovey into 38th all-time on 8/8 with 1,557 RBI.

## **BULLPEN RELIEF**

■ The White Sox bullpen owns a 2.33 ERA (15 ER/58.0 IP) over its last 20 games, lowering its season ERA from 4.15 to 3.83.

#### BAT IT LIKE BECKHAM

- Gordon Beckham is attempting to become the 10th White Sox Player to earn American League Rookie of the Year honors but first since Ozzie Guillen in 1985.
- Beckham, the AL Rookie of the Month for July, is hitting .340 (54-159) with 16 doubles, five homers and 32 RBI in his last 43 games, the eight-highest average in the AL in that span.
- Beckham, who has played in just 61 games since his recall on 6/4, leads AL rookies in average (.295), RBI (40), on-base (.369) and slugging percentage (.465), doubles (19) and extra-base hits (T1st, 25).
- After a 2-28 start, he is batting .329 (62-189) ... Beckham also is hitting .356 (36-101) on the road, .377 (20-53) with runners in scoring postion and .458 (11-24) with RISP and two outs.

#### STARTER STRUGGLES

■ White Sox starting pitchers have allowed just one run on 13 hits in 16.0 IP over the last two games ... that is in contrast to the previous 10 games from 7/31-8/10 when the rotation posted a 7.52 ERA (44 ER/52.2 IP), allowing 71 hits (.335 average) with only one quality start.

## **CLEAN IT UP**

■ The White Sox have committed just one error in their last five games but still rank last in the American League with a .980 fielding percentage ... the Sox have allowed 55 unearned runs, second-most in the AL behind Kansas City (56)

#### CONTRERAS AT A GLANCE

- The 37-year-old right-hander makes his 18th start of 2009 and first vs. Oakland since 5/21/07.
- Has lost four straight decisions ... lost five straight earlier this season (4/10-5/8) ... owns double-digit losses in a season for just the second time in his career (also 2007).
- Is 0-4 with a 6.75 ERA (18 ER/24.0 IP) over his last five starts.
- Opponents are hitting .257 (97-378), with lefties at .246 (47-191) and right-handers at .267 (50-187).
- Is averaging 5.7 IP and 96.6 pitches per start ... the Sox are 5-12 in his starts ... has posted six quality starts, but none since 7/8 vs. Cleveland (last victory) ... received a decision in all but two of his starts (4/26 vs. Toronto and 8/4 vs. the Angels).
- Has not allowed a home run in his last five starts, his longest stretch since 5/4-6/7/07 (seven starts) ... allowed 12 home runs in 2008 and 21 in 2007.
- Recalled from Class AAA Charlotte between games of a split doubleheader on 6/8 and threw back-to-back scoreless outings on 6/8-2 vs. Detroit and 6/13 at Milwaukee (8.0 IP in both).
- Named American League Player of the Week for 6/8-14 (first career weekly honor)
- Began the season 0-5 for the first time in his career ... optioned to Class AAA Charlotte on 5/10 and recalled on 6/8.
- His start on 4/10 vs. Minnesota (4 ER/5.0 IP) came just 242 days after undergoing surgery to repair his left Achilles tendon ... suffered the injury on 8/9/08 vs. Boston while attempting to cover first base in the second inning.
- Originally signed by New York-AL as a free agent on 2/6/03 ... traded by the Yankees to the White Sox, along with cash considerations, in exchange for pitcher Esteban Loaiza on 7/31/04.

#### LAST START

- Saddled with his 11th loss of the season on 8/9 vs. Cleveland ... surrendered four runs on six hits over 4.2 IP ... failed to toss at least 5.0 IP for the second straight start and the fifth time this season ... walked two and struck out two.
- Did not allow a run in the first four innings ... allowed four runs on four hits, while walking two batters, in the fifth inning.
- Threw 87 pitches (54 strikes) ... exited the game trailing, 4-3 ... Sox lost, 8-4.
- Had been 5-0 with a 1.80 ERA (7 ER/35.0 IP) in his previous six games (five starts) against the Indians.

### SHORT DAY'S WORK

- Is averaging 5.7 IP per start, his lowest mark since 2004 (5.5).
- Has averaged less than 6.0 IP only one other time in his career (2004).
- Three of his starts have been less than 4.0 IP while nine have been less that 6.0 IP.
- White Sox starting pitchers are averaging 6.0 IP per start this season, their lowest average since 2002 (5.8 IP).

#### **BAD COMPANY**

- Contreras' 11 losses are tied for the third-most in the American League, along with Minnesota's Francisco Liriano ... Oakland's Trevor Cahill and Baltimore's Jeremy Guthrie lead the league with 12.
- Has issued 17 walks since the All-Star break, tied with three other players for third-most in the AL ... the Yankees' A.J. Burnett ranks first with 20 free passes.
- His 5.09 ERA would be seventh highest in the AL if it was to qualify.

#### SECOND-HALF BLUES

- Is 0-4 with a 6.75 ERA (18 ER/24.0 IP) since the All-Star Break ... has gone 9-20 with a 5.79 ERA (129 ER/200.2 IP) in second halves of seasons since 2006.
- Last win in the second half of a season came on 9/19/07 at Kansas City (0 ER/9.0 IP).
- Was 22-9 with a 3.88 ERA (108 ER/250.2 IP) in the second half from 2003-05, including 11-2 in 2005.

#### DID YOU KNOW?

■ According to the Elias Sports Bureau, on 6/8-2 vs. Detroit, Contreras became just the second pitcher since 1900 to go at least 30 days in between appearances in one season and return to throw 8.0 IP or more in a game, while allowing no more than one hit ... Montreal's Kirk Rueter threw a one-hit shutout on 8/27/95 vs. San Francisco after spending three and one-half months in the minor leagues.

#### 2008 SEASON

- Went 7-6 with a 4.54 ERA (61 ER/121.0 IP) in 20 starts before suffering a season-ending Achilles tendon injury in 2008 ... ruptured his left Achilles tendon on 8/9 vs. Boston while attempting to cover first base in the second inning.
- Made 20 or more starts for the fifth straight season ... lowered his ERA from 5.57 in 2007 to 4.54.
- The White Sox went 11-9 in his starts (11-19 in 2007).
- Lasted at least 6.0 IP in 15 starts and 7.0 IP seven times (4-1 with a 1.94 ERA)... made 11 quality starts, one shy of his 2007 total (12).
- Went 4-3 with a 3.25 ERA (22 ER/61.0 IP) at home, compared to 3-3 with a 5.85 ERA (39 ER/ 60.0 IP) on the road ... ERA was 3.32 in 13 night starts (7.03 during the day) ... 10 of 12 home runs were surrendered to left-handers and 10 were solo ... opponents were successful on 16-17 stolen base attempts ... recorded 64.2 percent of his outs on ground balls (210 GO), which would have tied the Yankees Andy Pettitte for the second-highest mark in the American League if qualified.

#### CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Ranks ninth in wins among Cuban-born pitchers with 69 ... was named to the 2006 All-Star Team (did not pitch) ... is 3-3 with a 3.77 ERA (18 ER/43.0 IP) in 12 career postseason appearances (11 starts).
- Has struck out 10 or more batters four times in his career (last 5/25/08 vs. LAA) ... was named American League Pitcher of the Month for September 2005 and April 2006.

#### VS. OAKLAND

- Makes his eighth career start vs. the A's ... is 3-3 with a 6.00 ERA (24 ER/36.0 IP).
- Has gone 2-0 with a 2.92 ERA (4 ER/12.1 IP) in his last two starts against Oakland.
- Is 1-2 with a 7.85 ERA (16 ER/18.1 IP) in four career starts at the Oakland Coliseum ... earned his first victory in his last start in Oakland on 4/9/07 (1 ER/6.0 IP).
- Last faced the A's on 5/21/07 at U.S. Cellular Field ... picked up the win, allowing three runs on nine hits over 6.1 IP.
- Has gone the longest amount of time in between starts vs. Oakland among all other American League teams.
