OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's had their sixth shutout of the season...it is their first shutout against the Yankees since June 30, 2007 at Old Yankee Stadium (won 7-0) and their first against New York in Oakland since September 2, 2005 (won 12-0)...are now 2-2 on this nine-game homestand against Chicago (1-2), New York (1-0) and Detroit.
- Brett Tomko won his first start since May 16, 2008 at Florida (for Kansas City)...is now 3-0 with a 6.63 ERA (14 er in 19.0 ip) over six career outings, one start, against the Yankees, including 2-0 with a 1.80 ERA (2 er in 10.0 ip) in three appearances, one start, against New York in his home ballparks.
- Rajai Davis (1 for 4) has a career-high 12-game hitting streak (previous high: eight, three times)...is batting .360 (18 for 50) over that streak...has also hit safely in 20 of his last 21 games (29 for 79, .367).
- Mark Ellis (1 for 3) hit safely in 18 of his last 20 games, batting .403 (31 for 77) with 15 runs, 10 doubles, three home runs and 24 RBI over that span...has a 52-game errorless streak.
- Kurt Suzuki (1 for 3) is a .420 (21 for 50) career hitter against the Yankees.
- Bobby Crosby (0 for 2) left the game after the sixth inning with tightness in his left calf.

NEW YORK NOTES

- The New York Yankees are now 3-2 on their 10-game road trip through Seattle (3-1), Oakland (0-1) and Boston.
- A.J. Burnett tossed a season-high tying 8.0 innings (also, April 14 at Tampa Bay)...it is the 20th complete game and fifth complete game loss of his career (last CG and CG-loss: August 29, 2008 at New York-AL)...is 8-4 with a 2.73 ERA (29 er in 95.2 ip) and a .227 (80 for 352) opponents batting average over his last 15 starts...is 2-3 with a 4.00 ERA (20 er in 45.0 ip) over seven career starts against the A's.
- Derek Jeter (3 for 4) is a career .358 (81 for 226) hitter at the Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum.
- Nick Swisher (1 for 4) has reached base safely in each of his last 26 games, which is the second longest such stretch of his career (36-game streak from April 7-May 19, 2006 with Oakland).
- **Jerry Hairston Jr.** (0 for 1) played in the 1,000th game of his career.
- Robinson Cano (0 for 4) had his 14-game hitting streak snapped and is now batting .403 (25 for 62) over his last 15 games.
