OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's are now 2-3 on this nine-game homestand against Chicago (1-2), New York (1-1) and Detroit.
- The A's committed a season-high tying four errors (three time, last: July 18 vs. LAA).
- Vin Mazzaro is 2-0 with a 3.52 ERA (6 er in 15.1 ip) over his last three starts.

- Kurt Suzuki (1 for 4) has hit safely and driven in a run in all seven of his games against New York this year, going 13 for 29 (.448) with three doubles, two home runs and nine RBI...is a .407 (22 for 54) career hitter against the Yankees with two home runs and 11 RBI in 14 games.
- Rajai Davis (0 for 4) had his career-high 12-game hitting streak snapped and is now batting .333 (18 for 54) over his last 13 games.
- Mark Ellis (0 for 4) had his 52-game errorless streak snapped after committing an error in the seventh inning, was the fourth errorless streak of 50 or more games in his career.
- Adam Kennedy (0 for 4) struck out a career-high four times (previous high: three, 10 times, last: August 14 vs. Chicago).

- The New York Yankees are now 4-2 on their season-long 10-game road trip through Seattle (3-1), Oakland (1-1) and Boston.
- CC Sabathia is now 5-7 with a 5.80 ERA (69 er in 107.0 ip) and a .290 (121 for 417) opponents batting average over 18 career starts against Oakland...the 5.80 ERA is his second highest ERA against any American League team in his career (6.16 ERA vs. NYY)...is now 2-4 with a 6.35 ERA (36 er in 51.0 ip) and .300 (60 for 200) opponents average over nine career starts against the A's at the Coliseum...the 6.35 ERA at the Coliseum is his third highest average at any Major League ballpark in his career (min. 10.0 ip)...has an 8.71 ERA at Coors Field and 8.61 ERA at Old Yankee Stadium.
- Derek Jeter (3 for 5) has a six-game hitting streak and has hit safely in 13 of his last 14 games, batting .403 (25 for 62) over that span...is a career .364 (84 for 231) hitter at the Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum.
- Nick Swisher (1 for 5) has reached base safely in each of his last 27 games, which is the second longest such stretch of his career (36-game streak from April 7-May 19, 2006 with Oakland).
