OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's have lost four of the last six games...are 2-4 on this nine-game homestand against Chicago (1-2), New York (1-2) and Detroit.
- Brett Anderson is 4-2 with a 3.20 ERA (64.2 ip, 51 h, 23 r, 23 er, 21 bb, 64 so) and .215 (51 for 237) opponents batting average over his last 10 starts...is 0-2 with a 5.68 ERA (12 er in 19.0 ip) and .304 (24 for 79) opponents average in three career starts against the Yankees...is 7-2 in 13 starts with run support of two runs or more.
- Nomar Garciaparra (0 for 0) made his first pinch-running appearance since July 25, 1997 in game two of a doubleheader vs. Anaheim for Boston...it is the third pinch-running appearance of his career (also, September 6, 1996 at Chicago).
- Kurt Suzuki (1 for 4) has hit safely in all eight of his games against New York this year, going 14 for 33 (.424) with three doubles, two home runs and nine RBI over that span...had his seven-game streak with collecting a RBI against the Yankees snapped, which matched Jose Conseco (August 24, 1988-August 30, 1989) for the longest such streak in Oakland history...is a .397 (23 for 58) career hitter against the Yankees with two home runs and 11 RBI in 15 games.
- Jack Cust (2 for 2) snapped a career-high and A's season-high 23-game streak without an RBI with a solo home run in the sixth inning (last RBI: July 23 at New York on a sacrifice fly)...also snapped a career-high homerless streak (81 at bats).
- Rajai Davis (1 for 4) has hit safely in 21 of his last 23 games, batting .349 (29 for 83) with 16 runs and 13 stolen bases over that span.

NEW YORK NOTES

- The New York Yankees have won 14 of their last 17 games...are 61-28 in their last 89 games...are now 5-2 on their season-long 10-game road trip through Seattle (3-1), Oakland (2-1) and Boston.
- Yankees starting pitchers are 9-3 with a 2.46 ERA (23 er in 84.0 ip) and .211 (64 for 304) opponents average over their last 13 starts.
- Alfredo Aceves earned his eighth win of the season, which are the most wins by a Yankee reliever since Luis Vizcaino also won eight
 in 2007.
- Derek Jeter (2 for 4) has a seven-game hitting streak and has hit safely in 14 of his last 15 games, batting .409 (27 for 66) over that span...is a career .366 (86 for 235) hitter at the Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum.
- Nick Swisher (1 for 4) has reached base safely in each of his last 28 games, which is the second longest such stretch of his career (36-game streak from April 7-May 19, 2006 with Oakland).
- Robinson Cano (0 for 3) struck out a career-high three times (three times, last: April 27, 2007 vs. Boston).
