#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's snapped their three-game losing streak...have a 10-14 record in games decided in the last at bat...are now 3-5 on this nine-game homestand against Chicago (1-2), New York (1-2) and Detroit (1-1).
- Is the A's fifth walk off win this season...is **Kurt Suzuki's** (2 for 5) sixth walk off hit of his career (two singles, two doubles, two home runs).
- Trevor Cahill** is 0-4 with a 5.94 ERA (24 er in 36.1 ip) over his last six starts...has received run support of two runs or less in 14 of his 26 starts and is 0-8 in those starts.
- Rajai Davis** (1 for 4, sh) has hit safely in 23 of his last 25 games, batting .347 (33 for 95) with 17 runs, 10 doubles, two triples, 16 rbi and 13 stolen bases over that span.
- Adam Kennedy** (3 for 5) is 11 for 32 (.344) against Detroit this year and is a .319 (73 for 229) career hitter against the Tigers.
- Ryan Sweeney** (2 for 4) is 16 for 48 (.333) with seven extra base hits (five doubles, two home runs) over his last 13 games.

#### DETROIT NOTES

- The Detroit Tigers are now 1-1 on their six-game road trip through Oakland (1-1) and Los Angeles.
- The Tigers had their streak of hitting a home run in 10 consecutive games snapped...have hit 14 home runs total over their last 11 games.
- Armando Galarraga** is now 2-1 with a 6.00 ERA (18 er in 27.0 ip) over seven career appearances, five starts, against Oakland...is 1-0 with a 4.14 ERA (6 er in 16.2 ip) over four career appearances, two starts, against the A's at the Coliseum.
- Miguel Cabrera** (1 for 3) has a seven-game hitting streak and is batting .500 (14 for 28) over that span...is batting .368 (49 for 133) with 20 runs scored, nine doubles, six home runs and 23 RBI in 34 games following the all-star break.
- Placido Polanco** (2 for 4) is batting .379 (64 for 169) in 41 career games against Oakland, which is the highest career average against the A's among all active players.
