THREE DOT NUMBERS

Seattle is 6-1 when Ichiro homers, as he did Wednesday...Seattle struck out 12 times Wednesday but still won: club is 5-12 when it collects 10+ K's.

SLUGGING SHORTSTOP

Since returning from AAA Tacoma Aug. 13, Josh Wilson is hitting .394 (13x33) with 7 R, 2 2B, 3 HR & 5 RBI & a 1.156 OPS...he's hit in 7 of 9 games played.

2+ x 600+

Ichiro went 2-for-4 Wednesday, the 609th multiple-hit game of his 9-year MLB career...that's the most multi-hit games over a 9-year span during the live-ball era (since 1920), with the previous high of 581 by Rogers Hornsby (1920-28 and 1921-29)...**Ichiro leads the Majors with 60 multi-hit games, including 17 in his last 24 games.**

CHASING TY COBB

Ichiro is on pace to record 243 hits, which would extend his streak of consecutive 200-hit seasons to an all-time record 9 straight...if he reaches 200 hits (17 hits short) he will tie the AL record for most 200-hit seasons in a career held by Ty Cobb...the all-time record is 10 by Pete Rose.

Won 12 of last 15 one-run games, including 9 straight June 19-July 29...overall, are 28-16 in 1-run games, including 18-5 at home...Seattle leads the Majors with 28 one-run victories (LAD is 2nd with 21)...**Mariners club record for one-run wins 31 set in 1982...MLB record is 40 (BAL, '70 & '74).**

TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners conclude a two-team, six-game roadtrip with the third (1-1) of three at the Cleveland Indians...this trip began with three games (1-2) in Detroit...Seattle begins a 10-game homestand Monday against the A's (3 games), Royals (4 games) and Angels (3 games)...Mariners are 12 games out of first place in AL West behind division leader Los Angeles, 7.5 games back in the Wild Card race (behind BOS)...today's game will be televised in the Northwest on FSN in HD, and broadcast on 710 AM and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...lost yest, but are 3-3 in last 6 and 6-7 in last 13...are 12-12 following a 4-game losing streak (July 24-27)...overall won 19 of 37, 21 of 42, 28 of 53, 31 of 57 & 33 of last 60 games...trailed at some point in 32 of 63 victories (52%)...also had a lead in 33 of 60 defeats...league-best 28-16 in 1-run & 11-14 in 2-run games...32-27 at Safeco Field and 31-33 on the road.

SUNDAY BEST...Felix Hernandez is scheduled to start today for Seattle in the series finale...Felix leads the AL in road ERA at 1.92 (trails only JA Happ, PHI, in MLB) and is 2nd in the AL in road wins with 8 (Sabathia, 9)...Felix has allowed 1 or 0 ER in 7 of his last 10 road starts (6-0, 1.22 5/14-current).

HOME ON THE ROAD...Seattle lost last night, but is still 35-35 in Progressive Field...it is 1 of only 4 current or former AL road parks in which the Mariners boast a .500 record or better, joining Tropicana Field (29-17), old Metropolitan Stadium (18-17-1) and Rogers Centre 49-49.

TOUGH ONES...Seattle is 2-3 on this 6-game trip and all three losses have come in their opponents final at-bats, including a pair of walk off losses, 8/20 @DET (B9) and 8/22 @CLE (B11).

30 SOMETHING...Russell Bryanan hit his 30th homer of the season, his third in three games, last night...he is just the 11th Mariner in club history to hit 30 or more...it's now been done 23 times, by 11 guys: Ken Griffey Jr. (6x), Alex Rodriguez (4x), Jay Buhner (3x), Bret Boone (2x), Richie Sexson (2x), Edgar Martinez, Raul Ibanez, Gorman Thomas, Tino Martinez, Paul Sorrento and Brayan...on the list, Sexson, T. Martinez and Sorrento were also first baseman.

ON A ROLL...Russell Bryanan has homered in 3 straight games...it's the fifth time in his career to homer in a trio of games consecutively...last homered in four straight May 23-June 6, 2008.

START ME UP...Ichiro doubled to lead off the game Thursday, and later scored on a Sweeney sac fly...in his first plate appearance in a game this season, Ichiro is batting .330 (38x115) with 9 doubles, 3 home runs and, eventually, 7 steals...as an aside, the double came with two strikes: Ichiro is batting .280 (63x225) with two strikes, 5th-best in the American League.

STREAKER...Ichiro hit in 12 straight games (Aug. 9-21: 20x54/.370)...is already his 33rd career hitting streak of 10 or more games...Ichiro debuted in 2001; no other player has more than 28 since then (Miguel Tejada).

COUNTDOWN TO 200 & 2,000...Ichiro enters today's game 17 hits short of 200 for the season and 12 hits short of 2,000 for his MLB career...if he reaches 200 hits (on pace for 243), it will be his 9th consecutive 200-hit season, breaking the all-time record currently held by Willie Keeler (1894-1901).

NO REST FOR THE WEARY...today is game #19 (9-9) in a stretch of 33 games in 34 days, Aug. 4-Sept. 6, for the Mariners...Mariners spent the one off day flying from Seattle to Detroit...it's game #6 (2-3) in a stretch of 20 games in 20 days.

FOOL ME ONCE...Ichiro has not gone hitless in consecutive games since Aug. 13-15, 2008...that's a **streak of 156 consecutive games without going hitless in back-to-back games**...the streak is the longest in the Majors since Stan Musial (174 games) in 1943-44 and the longest AL streak since Doc Cramer (191 games) in 1934-35...thanks to SABR's Trent McCotter & Elias for the research help.

DOWN BUT NOT OUT...Seattle has had 14 different players spend time on the disabled list this year, the most in the American League...those players have combined to miss 723 games this season...

DID YOU KNOW?...that Mariners are trying to set a new season-high for consecutive games with a home run?...Seattle has homered in its last 6 contests (Aug. 16-current), slugging a total of 11 homers...the 6 straight games with a HR matches its longest stretch of the season, also July 16-22.
