Of Note: The PCL Pacific North Division is now a best 2-of-3 series after the Rainiers beat Colorado Springs 9-6 on Friday night. Chris Shelton hammered his 15th home run, Bryan LaHair drove in 3 runs and Tacoma trimmed Colorado Springs' lead to 1 game in the division. **Oswaldo Navarro** is batting .451 (23x51) with 9 runs scored, 6 doubles and 9 RBI during his current 14-game hitting streak. That hit streak is his longest of the season. **Prentice Redman** has hit safely in 10 of his last 12 games, batting .450 (18x44) with 15 runs scored, 5 doubles, 5 home runs and 14 RBI. **Jerry Owens** has recorded 6 multi-hit games, including 3 4+-hit games in his last 16 games. During this stretch he is batting .314 (27x86) with 20 runs scored, 7 extra-base hits and 5 RBI. **Bryan LaHair** has scorched 6 doubles in his last 5 games. LaHair is batting .350 (7x20) with 4 runs and 6 RBI in those 5 games. LaHair has 109 career doubles and became Tacoma's most prolific doubles hitter ever when he hit his 95th career two-bagger on 6/30 at Reno.

Of Note: Tennessee rebounded on Friday night and used a 10-run 6th inning to beat the Diamond Jaxx, 13-3. The loss pushes the Jaxx back into 2nd place, trailing the Smokies by a game with 3 tilts remaining. Luis Munoz lost for the 1st time since August 2nd, as he yielded 5 runs in 5.0 plus innings on the mound. His string of 18 consecutive scoreless innings ended in the 2nd inning. The 13 runs allowed and 16 hits surrendered were the 2nd most given up by the Jaxx this season. **Travis Garcia** has it safely in 9 of his last 11 games, batting .351 (13x37) with 5 runs, 3 doubles, 1 home run and 10 RBI. **Jose Yopez** went 1x3, extending his hitting streak to 7 games. During the streak he is batting .400 (10x25) with 5 runs, 3 doubles, 1 home run and 7 RBI.

PCL TIE-BREAKER

The PCL released a clarification of league playoff rules stating that the Tacoma Rainiers can win the PCL Pacific North Division with 3 wins in their final 4 games instead of a 4-game sweep as was prior thought.

It was determined that the intent of the playoff rule is that "best overall record" was understood to mean "won-loss percentage." It was a further determination of the PCL office that in calculating the "percentage" it will be rounded to 3 places following the decimal point, as in (76 wins - 68 losses) a percentage of .528 -- and not .5277 as when carried 4 places.

With today's clarification the Rainiers will be able to win the division with 3 wins in their final 4 games. With 3 wins the Rainiers and Colorado Springs would have an identical winning percentage therefore going to the next tie-break rule "won-loss percentage vs. division opponents." The Rainiers in this scenario would have a better divisional win percentage than Colorado Springs and win the division title. This scenario exists because Colorado Springs has had 2 games rained out this season that were not able to be made up.

Of Note: The Mavs scored in 7 of 8 times at the plate, with the lone exception being the sixth inning on their way to a 17-5 over Modesto on Friday night. Of their 23 hits, 20 were singles. Jamie McOwen hit the only home run. Tyson Gillies became the first Maverick this season to collect 5 hits in a game, as he went 5x6 with 3 RBI and 4 runs scored. **James McOwen** has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games, batting .435 (20x46). TAMEZ NAMED MWL TRAINER OF THE YEAR

Clinton LumberKings' athletic trainer **Eddie Tamez** has been named the 2009 Midwest League Minor League Athletic Trainer of the Year, announced by the Professional Baseball Athletic Trainers Society (PBATS).

The award is one of 17 presented to athletic trainers from every league in affiliated baseball. Tamez is now in consideration with the 16 other winners for the Minor League Athletic Trainer of the Year award, which will be presented at the 2009 Baseball Winter Meetings in Indianapolis, IN this December.

Tamez, 33, is in his 1st season with the LumberKings, his 3rd with the Seattle Mariners organization. He spent the 2008 season with the High Desert Mavericks of the California League and also worked in the Texas Rangers system for 3 seasons as the trainer with Spokane in 2005 and Bakersfield in 2006-2007. He's a 2003 graduate of Texas A&M Corpus Christy with a B.S. in Kinesiology.

ARIZONA LEAGUE POST-SEASON ALL-STAR TEAM

Andy Bottin who led the Mariners to first place division finishes in both halves of the Arizona League split-season, was named AZL Manager of the Year. Bottin is in his 2nd season as Mariners skipper. The M's won the West Division first half title with a 17-11 mark and the second half title with a 16-11 record.

Bottin spent 6 seasons as a Mariners coach before becoming manager in 2008. Before that, he spent 6 seasons as a coach for Everett in the Northwest League. Andy played in the New York Yankees farm system from 1967-72. A Vietnam veteran, Bottin spent 20 years as a policeman in Seattle before returning to baseball.

Kevin Mailloux was named to the All-Star team as the best second baseman in the league. In 46 games, Mailloux hit .311 with 47 hits, 29 runs scored, 14 doubles, 5 triples and 5 home runs to go along with a .397 on-base percentage and .570 slugging percentage. Mailloux ranked 11th in the league in batting average, 7th in doubles, 4th in OPS (on-base percentage plus slugging) and 6th in RBI.

LH **Anthony Fernandez** was named to the Post-Season All-Star team after going 5-3 with a 3.40 ERA (20 ER, 53.0 IP) in 13 games (2 GS). He limited opponents to a .268 (56x209) average, while walking 13 and striking out 53. His 5 wins were T3rd in AZL.

RH reliever **Jeff Breedlove** was named to the All-Star team, after finishing T1st in the league with 10 saves. He went 2-1 with 10 saves and 1.52 ERA in 20 relief appearances. He limited opponents to a .205 average, while walking 3 and striking out 29. Selections by team: Angels (3); Mariners (3); Dodgers (3); Padres (2); Indians; Giants; Brewers.

ROYSTER NAMED NORTHWEST LEAGUE ALL-STAR

The Northwest League has announced Everett AquaSox outfielder **Ryan Royster** has been named to the 2009 Postseason All-Star team.

Royster is currently 6th in the league in batting (.325) and 3rd in the league in slugging percentage (.563). Royster has also added 11 doubles, seven home runs - one of which was a grand slam, and 27 RBI in 41 games.

The 2008 13th round pick out of UC Davis has also appeared in 8 games for the Clinton LumberKings of the Midwest League. While with the LumberKings, Royster hit .333 with 3 doubles, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI. Royster is currently on the disabled list with a torn labrum in his right shoulder. He injured his shoulder in the first inning while diving for a ball in the outfield in his first game back with Everett on Aug. 15.

RAMIREZ NAMED VENEZUELAN SUMMER LG. MVP

Erasmus Ramirez was named MVP of the Venezuelan Summer League. Ramirez went 11-1 with a 0.51 ERA (5 ER, 88.0 IP) in 14 games, 13 starts. He limited opponents to a .174 average (54x310), while walking 5 and striking out 80. Ramirez recorded back-to-back 10 strikeout games, May 25 and 31 and recorded at least 3 K's in each of his appearances. He recorded 10 quality starts, including his last 5 starts.

SOUTHERN LEAGUE POST-SEASON ALL-STARS

West Tenn outfielders **Ezequiel Carrera** and **Greg Halman** were selected to the 2009 Southern League Postseason All-Star Team as voted upon by the league's field managers, radio broadcasters and print media.

Carrera, a mid-season All-Star selection as well, is leading the league with a .345 batting average and .447 on-base percentage. Carrera has collected 111 hits in 322 at-bats in 89 games this season for the Jaxx.

Halman, selected as a designated hitter, currently leads the Southern League with 25 home runs. He is 2-time Southern League hitter of the week this season.

Also, the award for the Southern League's Most Valuable Player was given to Montgomery Biscuit's outfielder, Desmond Jennings. The Southern League's Most Outstanding Pitcher was awarded to Carolina Mudcat's pitcher, Travis Wood.

CALIFORNIA LEAGUE AWARDS

For the first time since 1998, both the California League's top player and manager reside in the High Desert. On Tuesday, Mavs third baseman **Alex Liddi** was named California League MVP and manager **Jim Horner** took the league's Manager of the Year award. The last Maverick named league MVP was current San Francisco Giants pitcher Brad Penny. Don Wakamatsu-coincidentally now the manager of the Mavericks parent club, the Seattle Mariners-was the last manager to be named tops in the league.

Liddi, a native of Italy, has had a breakout season. The 21-year-old currently leads the league with a .344 average. He has hit 23 home runs, and his 101 RBI ranks 3rd in the league. He is also amongst the top 5 in hits, doubles, on-base percentage, slugging percentage, extra-base hits, and runs scored. Earlier this year he played for Team Italy in the World Baseball Classic. In June he was 1 of 4 Mavericks on the California League All-Star Team, and in July he participated in the XM All-Star Futures Game in St. Louis.

Manager **Jim Horner** has had the most successful season of his young career. With a 6-2 win over Lancaster Tuesday night, Horner's 2009 squad is just the 4th in Mavericks history to reach 80 wins in a season. He guided the Mavs to a 1st half title earlier this year, the team's first since 1993. It's only the 2nd time in team history the team has claimed titles in both halves. Horner is the only manager in Mavericks history to be at the helm for more than 1 season. It has paid dividends in 2009, making a huge jump from just 58 wins last year.

Liddi and Horner were not the only Mavericks honored by the California League yesterday. First baseman **Joe Dunigan** and pitcher **Donnie Hume** were both named to the post-season All-Star Team as well.

Dunigan's 29 homers are T2nd in the league, and his 101 RBI currently rank T3rd. He was also named to the Mid-Season All-Star Team.

Hume is the only pitcher in all of the Minors with 17 wins. He is 4th in the league in innings pitched, and he leads the Mavericks with 115 strikeouts. The lefty has shattered the team record for most wins in a season and has collected the most wins by a California League pitcher this decade.
