OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's are 3-3 on this seven-game homestand against Kansas City (2-1) and Seattle (1-2).
- Brett Anderson** made his 26th start of the season, which is tied for fourth in Oakland history and fifth in Athletics history by a player under the age of 22...is 2-1 with a 3.75 ERA (10 er in 24.0 ip) in four career starts against the Mariners.
- Michael Wuertz** has not allowed a run in 27 of his 30 outings at home and has a 1.11 ERA (4 er in 32.1 ip) and .138 (15 for 109) opponents batting average in Oakland...first batters faced are 0 for their last 21 with two walks and 11 strikeouts.
- Andrew Bailey** had his scoreless streak snapped at 12.1 innings when Jose Lopez hit a two-run home run in the ninth inning...it was the first home run Bailey allowed to a right-handed hitter this year...has converted each of his last 17 save opportunities dating back to June 17 and is 2-2 with a 1.67 ERA (6 er in 32.1 ip) during this span.
- Adam Kennedy** (2 for 4, bb) has a five-game hitting streak and is 9 for 20 (.450) during this streak.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The Seattle Mariners are 2-1 on this 10-game road trip with Oakland (2-1), Los Angeles (three games) and Texas (three games).
- Seattle had their six-game winning streak against the A's snapped...have won 14 of the last 18 games against the A's...since the start of the 2007 season, the Mariners are 34-19 against Oakland.
- Ichiro Suzuki** (3 for 5) has a six-game hitting streak and is batting .423 (11 for 26) during this span...has a 16-game hitting streak against Oakland dating back to last year and is hitting .389 (28 for 72) during this streak...is one hit shy of 2,000 career hits in Major League Baseball...is six hits short of becoming the first player to have nine consecutive 200-hit seasons.
- Mike Sweeney** (4 for 5) matched his season high with four hits (June 25) and has now hit safely in 11 of his last 13 games (21 for 48, .438).
- Bill Hall** (0 for 5) was 0 for 5 with a career high five strikeouts
