Additional Notes

- Chris Carter led all of Minor League Baseball with 179 hits, ranked tied for first with 310 total bases, second with 115 RBI, tied for second with 73 extra-base hits, third with 115 runs scored, tied for third with 11 sacrifice flies and tied for eighth with 43 doubles...was named the Texas League Player of the Year and named to the 2009 TL Post-Season All-Star team...led the TL with 108 runs scored, 41 doubles, 282 total bases, 82 walks, a .435 on-base percentage, .576 slugging percentage...ranked second in the TL with 165 hits, 24 home runs, a .337 (165 for 490) batting average and third with 101 RBI.
- Grant Desme was selected as the Stockton Ports 2009 Player of the Year...finished tied for fifth in all of Minor League Baseball with 31 home runs...led the Ports with 20 home runs and was third for Stockton with 51 RBI and 16 stolen bases...was one of just two players in the California League to have 15-or-more stolen bases and 20-or-more home runs (also, Joseph Dunigan)...also led the Cougars with 11 home runs and was second for Kane County with 24 stolen bases.
- Anthony Capra finished second among all pitchers in Minor League Baseball with 170 strikeouts (152.0 ip, 10.1 k/9).
- **Sacramento River Cats**
 - The River Cats ranked tied for second in the Pacific Coast League with 150 home runs.
 - Henry Rodriguez finished with 71 strikeouts in 43.2 ip (14.6 k/9) for Sacramento and had 82 strikeouts total in 48.2 ip (15.2 k/9) on the year.
 - Eric Patterson set a River Cats franchise record with 43 stolen bases (previous: 39 by Bo Porter in 2000)...also was just the second player in River Cats history to have at least 10 home runs, triples, doubles and steals in a season (also, Mark Bellhorn in 2000)...ranked second in the PCL with 11 triples and 43 stolen bases, fourth with 91 runs scored, seventh with 230 total bases and ninth with 143 hits.
 - Tommy Everidge led the River Cats with a .368 (74 for 201) batting average.
 - Matt Carson was named the River Cats 2009 Best Offensive Player and Best Defensive Player of the Year...ranked tied for sixth in the PCL with 25 home runs and led the River Cats with 77 RBI.
- **Midland RockHounds**
 - Midland led the Texas League with a team .288 batting average, 1,419 hits, 811 runs, 303 doubles, 36 triples, 749 RBI, 2,103 total bases, 576 walks, a team .366 on-base percentage and .427 slugging percentage.
 - Darren Bush was named the TL Manager of the Year and the player manager co-winners with Chris Carter mark the second occurrence in franchise history (also, Andre Ethier and Von Hayes in 2005).
 - Adrian Cardenas, Graham Godfrey and Chris Carter were named to the 2009 TL Post-Season All-Star Team.
 - Graham Godfrey led the TL with 159.1 ip, ranked tied for third with 11 wins, fifth with 110 strikeouts and seventh with a 3.50 ERA (62 er in 159.1 ip) and 1.28 WHIP.
 - Josh Donaldson finished second in the TL with 37 doubles, third with 80 walks and fifth with 91 RBI.
 - Archie Gilbert ranked tied for third in the TL with 81 runs scored and sixth with 29 stolen bases.
 - Josh Horton ranked fifth in the TL with 80 runs scored.
 - Tyson Ross went 3-1 with a 1.17 ERA (3 er in 23.0 ip) over his last four starts of the regular season.
- **Stockton Ports**
 - Stockton finished the first half of the season 25-45 (.357), which is the Ports' worst half-season record since finishing 23-47 (.329) in the second half of the 1999 season. The last time the Ports finished the first half with a winning percentage less than .400 was in 1961, when they finished 21-48 with a .304 winning percentage.
 - The Ports ranked second to last in the California League with a team total 638 runs scored and a team .258 batting average.
 - Stockton's pitching led the CL with 1,268 strikeouts (1245.2 ip, 9.2 k/9)...issued the second most walks with 526 and ranked third with a 4.15 ERA (575 er in 1245.2 ip).
 - Jermaine Mitchell ranked third in the CL 73 walks.
 - Yusuf Carter ranked sixth in the CL with .318 (112 for 352) batting average.
 - Steve Kleen led the Ports with a .342 (88 for 257) batting average.
- **Kane County Cougars**
 - The Cougars ranked second in the Midwest League with a team total 493 walks.
 - Kenny Smalley finished second in the ML with a 2.73 ERA (40 er in 131.2 ip) and ranked seventh with 119 strikeouts...also issued the seventh most walks in the ML with 60 free passes.
 - Shawn Haviland finished tied for fourth in the ML with 121 strikeouts and 11 losses.
 - Steve Kleen also led the Cougars with a .282 (73 for 259) batting average.
- **Vancouver Canadians**
 - Julio Ramos finished second in the Northwest League with a 2.38 ERA (19 er in 72.0 ip) and tied for fourth with six wins.
 - Ronny Morla ranked sixth in the NL with 73 strikeouts (63.0 ip, 10.9 k/9).
