TRIBE AT A GLANCE: The Indians will begin a 4-game series with the Oakland A's in Oakland at 10:07 PM ET ... Series is part of a 7-game roadtrip to Minneapolis and Oakland (Indians are 0-3 on 'trip after sweep @MIN)...Indians just finished a 9-game homestand with the Twins, Rangers & Royals at 3-6, losing 5 of last 6 games... **Went 4-6 on last trip to KC, BAL & Detroit (swept in DET)... Indians won a season-high 5-straight games from July 23-27...** Indians are 26-30 in the 2nd half, including a mark of 14-14 on the road in the 2nd half...Tribe is 30-43 on the road, 31-41 at home and their 0-5 start to the season was their worst in 24 years (1985, 0-5)...**Worst record at the break (35-54) since 1991 (26-53)...**The Indians were swept in a 3-game set in Texas Rangers Ballpark to begin the season...On Saturday, April 18 Indians scored a club-record tying 14 runs in the 2nd inning, the most runs ever scored in MLB history in the 2nd inning (ELIAS) and most ever all'd by the Yankees in a 22-4 win... Last time a MLB team scored 14R in any inning was 6/27/03 (Red Sox did it vs. FLA)...The 50 total bases tied the club record set on 7/16/04 at Seattle... The 8 extra base hits in the 2nd inning were a modern day record (since 1900) for EB hits in any inning and the 13 hits set or tied the club record...25 hits were their most since recording 26 hits in a 10-9, 17-inning win on 5/7/95 vs. Minnesota (most in a 9.0IP since 1952)...Allowed 12 runs in the 6th inning at Boston before recording an out on May 7 (tied modern MLB record)...**Lost a season-high 6 straight games, 6/15-21, and went 5-13 in interleague play (Indians are 33-49 since 6/13, but have won 25 of their last 52 games since July 21 (25-27, .481)...**Are a season-high 17.0 games out of first place & a season-high 23-games under .500 (Sept. 16, 61-84)

PROMISING RETURN

Two key components of last year's CC SABATHIA trade are contributing at the big league level of late...**MATT LaPORTA** is hitting .292 (28-96) with 8 2B, 5HR & 13 RBI in 25 games (.531SLG/.834OPS) since returning from AAA Columbus on August 19...He is in just his 2nd season of PRO ball...**OF MICHAEL BRANTLEY** has reached base safely in all 13 of his 14 games with Cleveland and owns an on-base % of .371 since coming up on Sept 1...He is hitting .328 (19-58) with 6 RBI, 7 runs and 3 steals...He is just 22 years old

SOLID 2ND HALF: The Indians have two pitchers in the top 10 in ERA among second half American League pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched... **JEREMY SOWERS** is 9th (3.18, 56.2IP, 20ER) & **JUSTIN MASTERSON** is 10th (3.23, 47.1IP, 17ER) ...**JOHN LACKEY** (2.29) leads in the AL in 2nd half ERA

GETTING BETTER: Since August 19 **TRAVIS HAFNER** is hitting .292 (21-72) with 5 2B, 4HR & 11RBI in 19 games (.528slg/.898ops)...He has a season on-base-slugging % of .839.

THIS & THAT Due to the PGA schedule on NBC, the Indians/Baltimore game scheduled for broadcast on WKYC-TV3 has been moved to air on WKYC on Saturday, Sept. 26 instead...Sept 27 will air on STO only...The Indians are a better road draw in 2009 than 2008 after 73 dates (2,038,883 in 2009 compared in 1,968,865 in 2008, up 3.6% on the year)...

PLAYOFF UPDATE Akron squeezed by Connecticut for a 7-6 win last night and lead the best-of-five series 2-0... **2B JOSH RODRIGUEZ** hit a three-run homer in the ninth and **RHP JOSH JUDY** (S, 1.0IP, 3H, 2R) earned the save... **RHP JEANMAR GOMEZ** went 5.0IP and gave up 2R on 6H with 5K... **LF JERAD HEAD** was 3-for-4 with RBI and 3R...Mahoning Valley lost the deciding game 3 of the NYPL finals, 5-2, to end their outstanding season.

UPON FURTHER REVIEW: OF GRADY SIZEMORE's season came to an end on September 3rd...Lost and unnoticed about Sizemore's season was after his activation from the DL, his statistics were virtually similar to previous seasons...Let's take a look: (**6/23-9/3)

As a starter for Cleveland this year **JUSTIN MASTERSON** is 1-4 w/a 4.10 ERA in 7 starts (37.1IP, 37H, 17ER, 26K, .268AVG)

The bullpen ERA over the last 35 games is 3.95 (118.1IP, 112H, 52ER)...

Indians are averaging 5.3 runs per game on the road (.278AVG/.457SLG/.354OBS) compared to 4.6 runs/gm at home (.254AVG/.385SLG/.329OBS)

ERIC WEDGE is now in 5th place in club history with 557 managerial wins.

2nd HALF PICKUP: The Indians pitching staff has an ERA of 4.42 (503.1IP, 534H, 247ER) in the 2nd half ... **The 4.42 ERA ranks 7th best in the AL in the 2nd half... Indians are hitting .275 (539-1957) in the 2nd half w/259 runs scored in 56 games (4.63RS/GM)...** Indians are 26-30 in the 2nd half... Despite their 61-84 record, the Indians offense currently ranks 7th in the Majors in runs scored with 710 (4.89RS/G) and are on pace to score 793 runs this year...**Hit .260 in 1st half w/451RS in 89G...Had an ERA of 5.40 in the 1st half**

RHP JUSTIN MASTERSON (4-7, 4.25 ERA)

JUSTIN MASTERSON... Is making his 14th start and 40th appearance of the 2009 season today against the Oakland A's in Oakland ... It is his 8th start/9th appearance as an Indian... Also is his 8th start/20th appearance on the road and his 1st start/4th game vs. OAK this year
 => **Acquired by the Indians along with LHP NICK HAGADONE and RHP BRYAN PRICE on July 31, 2009 in a trade with the Boston Red Sox in exchange for CA VICTOR MARTINEZ.**
 => First ever Jamaican born pitcher, 4th player joining Chili Davis, Devon White and Rolando Roomes in the Major Leagues...
 => Originally selected by the Boston Red Sox in the 2nd round (71st overall) of the 2006 First-Year Player draft out of San Diego St. University... Was ranked as the 24th overall draft-eligible prospect in 2006 by **Baseball America**.
 => Went 3-1 w/a 0.85 ERA in 14 appearances (31.2IP, 20H, 4R/3ER) during his first season as a pro in 2006... Struck out 33 and walked just 2 at Single-A Lowell before being promoted to Wilmington where he tossed 3.2 scoreless inning (BB, 2K) in the Carolina League playoffs vs. Frederick.
 => Advanced from Single-A Lancaster to Double-A Portland in 2007... Was a combined 12-8 w/a (153.2IP, 152H, 74ER, 40BB, 115K) in 27 starts between the two stops... Combined to go unbeaten over a 12-start span from June 7-August 5, posting a record of 10-0 w/a 1.72 ERA (78.1IP, 15ER)... Named the 4th best prospect, 2nd best pitcher in the Red Sox organization following the season by **Baseball America**... Also rated as having the "Best Fastball" by the publication.

LAST YEAR ... => Began the 2008 season as a starter at Double-A Portland and finished as a member of the Red Sox bullpen... Was a combined 2-3 w/a 3.96 ERA (47.2IP, 43H, 21ER, 17BB, 45K) in 12 games/9 starts with Pawtucket and Portland at the minor league level... Made his Major League debut on April 24th vs. the Angels (ND, 6.0IP, 2H, 1R/ER) as he made a spot start... Was the 3rd Sox pitcher since 1956 to pitch at least 6.0IP while allowing 2 hits or less in his debut, joining Jim Lonborg (1965) & Billy Rohr (1967)... Shuffled between Boston, Pawtucket and Portland until July 20th where he stayed with the Sox through the remainder of the season... **Went 6-5 with a 3.16 ERA (88.1IP, 68H, 31ER, 40BB, 68K) in 36 appearances/9 starts with Boston**... His 3.16 ERA was 5th best on the Red Sox staff... Made 9 starts over 3 stints with Boston in the season's first half, going 4-3 w/a 3.67 ERA (54.0IP, 22ER)... Moved to the bullpen in July and was 2-2 with a 2.36 ERA (34.1IP, 9ER) in 27 appearances to end the regular season... Set a Red Sox rookie record with 9 appearances in the playoffs going 1-0 with a 1.86 ERA (9.2IP, 2ER).

THIS YEAR ... Started the season in the Red Sox bullpen making 4 relief appearances to begin the season, posting a 4.50 ERA (6.0IP, 7H, 3ER, BB, 7K) before taking Daisuke Matsuzaka's spot in the rotation... Made his first start of the season on April 20 vs. Baltimore in Fenway Park, a 12-1 Sox win as he earned his 1st victory of the season (5.1IP, 4H, 1R/ER, 2BB, 3K)... Won his 2nd start as well on April 26 vs. New York (5.1IP, 6H, 1R/ER, BB, 4K)... Suffered his 1st loss of the season on May 1 in a 6-2 loss to the Tampa Bay Rays in Tampa, FL... 6.0IP, 6H, 6R/ER, 3BB, 6K... Took the loss vs. Cleveland on May 6, a 9-2 loss to the Indians in Progressive Field... 6.1IP, 8H, 6R/ER, 3BB, 6K... Did not receive a decision on May 12 at LA Angels (6.0IP, 5H, 2R/ER, 4BB, 3K)... Made his 6th and final start with the Red Sox on May 17 at Seattle (ND, 6.1IP, 9H, 2R/ER, 0BB, 6K)... **Was 2-2 w/a 4.58 ERA (35.1IP, 38H, 18ER, 13BB, 28K) in 6 starts with the Sox**

=> Returned to the bullpen on May 22 vs. the NY Mets as he tossed 3.0 innings, allowing 1 run on 3 hits... Made 2 other relief appearances in May, allowing 1 run in 4.1 innings... Made 9 relief appearances during the month of June going 0-0 w/a 4.38 ERA (12.1IP, 12H, 7R/6ER, 4BB, 15K)... Did not allow an earned run in 6 consecutive appearances (8.0IP) from June 4 thru June 19th... Was 1-1 w/a 5.73 ERA (11.0IP, 8H, 8R/7ER, 4BB, 13K) over his final 9 appearances in July with the Sox... Made his final appearance with the Red Sox on July 29 vs. Oakland as he tossed 2.0 innings, allowing 1 unearned run while walking 1 and striking out 3... **As a reliever with the Red Sox was 1-1 with a 4.42 ERA (36.2IP, 34H, 20R/18ER, 12BB, 39K) in 25 relief outings... Was 0-1 in save opportunities... Did not allow an earned run over his last 4 appearances covering 7.0 innings of work (2H, 2BB, 8SO).**

=> **Acquired by the Indians on July 31 along with LHP NICK HAGADONE and RHP BRYAN PRICE in exchange for CA VICTOR MARTINEZ... Was added to the Indians Major League Roster August 1**... Made his 1st appearance with the Indians on August 1 vs. Detroit as he tossed 3.0 scoreless innings, allowing 2 hits while walking 1 and striking out 4... Made first start for Cleveland on August 8 in Chicago, an 8-5 loss to the Sox and DJ Carrasco... 4.0IP, 4H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 4K... Left w/a 4-1 lead (Ohka took loss)... 6.1P... Fell to 3-4 on the year in his start of Aug 14 in the Metrodome vs. the Twins, an 11-0 win for the Twins and Scott Baker (CG 2-hitter)... 3.1IP, 6H, 7R/6ER, 5BB, 3K... Earned his 1st victory as an Indian on August 20 against the LA Angels in Progressive Field, a 11-3 win over the Angels as he allowed just 1 unearned run in 6.1 innings... 6.1IP, 3H, 1R/0ER, 4BB, 3K... Won his last start of Saturday, Sept. 12 in Progressive Field vs. KC, a 13-6 win over the Royals and Luke Hochevar... 6.0IP, 7H, 3R/ER, 1BB, career-high 6K... Is 3-0 w/a 2.84 ERA over his last 3 starts (19.0IP, 16H, 6ER)... Also Won 3 straight decisions, June 7-23... Picked up his first Major League win in his start of Sunday, June 7 in Chicago, an 8-4 win over the Sox and Colon... 5.0IP, 4H, 3R/ER, 3BB, 3K, HR to A Ramirez... Lost his Major League debut against the Tampa Bay Rays in St. Pete on May 17, a 7-5 win for the Rays and Sonnanstine... 3.2IP, 7H, 7R/ER, 4BB, 2K... **He is now 10-7 w/a 6.14 ERA in 21 starts for Cleveland (114.1IP, 147H, 78ER, 37BB, 57K)...** At AAA Columbus David is 5-1 w/a 4.35 ERA in 7 starts (39.1IP, 35H, 19ER, 5HR, 16BB, 32K, .241AVG)... At time of his May 17 promotion he was T1st in the IL in wins...
