TRIBE AT A GLANCE: The Indians will continue a 4-game series with the Oakland A's in Oakland at 10:07 PM ET ... Series is part of a 7-game roadtrip to Minneapolis and Oakland (Indians are 0-4 on 'trip after sweep @MIN)...Indians just finished a 9-game homestand with the Twins, Rangers & Royals at 3-6, losing 5 of last 6 games... Went 4-6 on last trip to KC, BAL & Detroit (swept in DET)... Indians won a season-high 5-straight games from July 23-27... Indians are 26-31 in the 2nd half, including a mark of 14-15 on the road in the 2nd half....Tribe is 30-44 on the road, 31-41 at home and their 0-5 start to the season was their worst in 24 years (1985, 0-5)...**Worst record at the break (35-54) since 1991 (26-53)...**The Indians were swept in a 3-game set in Texas Rangers Ballpark to begin the season...On Saturday, April 18 Indians scored a club-record tying 14 runs in the 2nd inning, the most runs ever scored in MLB history in the 2nd inning (ELIAS) and most ever all'd by the Yankees in a 22-4 win... Last time a MLB team scored 14R in any inning was 6/27/03 (Red Sox did it vs. FLA)...The 50 total bases tied the club record set on 7/16/04 at Seattle... The 8 extra base hits in the 2nd inning were a modern day record (since 1900) for EB hits in any inning and the 13 hits set or tied the club record...25 hits were their most since recording 26 hits in a 10-9, 17-inning win on 5/7/95 vs. Minnesota (most in a 9.0IP since 1952)...Allowed 12 runs in the 6th inning at Boston before recording an out on May 7 (tied modern MLB record)...Lost a season-high 6 straight games, 6/15-21, and went 5-13 in interleague play (Indians are 33-50 since 6/13, but have vot 25 of their last 53 games since July 21 (25-28, .472)...Are a season-high 17.0 games out of first place & a season-high 24-games under .500 (Sept. 17, 61-85)

DID YOU KNOW?

Indians have lost 14 of their last 17 games & 15 of their last 19 games since August 28.

The bullpen ERA over the last 36 games is 3.83 (122.1IP, 113H, 52ER)...

Indians are averaging 5.3 runs per game on the road (.277AVG/.455SLG/.354OB) compared to 4.6 runs/gm at home (.254AVG/.385SLG/.329OB)

SHIN SOO CHOO ranks 9th in the AL in on-base percentage (.395) & T16th in the league in 2Bs (34)...He is T4th with 11 outfield assists...Has just 10 walks in his last 42 games after drawing 60 in his first 99 games (is 13th in the AL in walks)

TRAVIS HAFNER is now 11th on the Indians alltime HR list w/161... Keltner is 10th w/ 163.

Indians have used 52 players this year (29 pitchers, 23 position players)...29 pitchers T1st most in MLB this year

Indians have been hit by a pitch 78 times most in MLB... **SHOPPACH** has been hit 18 times which ties for the MLB lead (Choo is 2nd in AL w/15).

ERIC WEDGE is now in 5th place in club history with 557 managerial wins.

Indians are 56-31 when scoring 4 or more runs and 5-54 when scoring 3 or fewer.

PROMISING RETURN Two key components of last year's CC SABATHIA trade are contributing at the big league level of late...MATT LaPORTA is hitting .283 (28-99) with 8 2B, 5HR & 13 RBI in 26 games (.515SLG/.816OPS) since returning from AAA Columbus on August 19...He is in just his 2ND full season of PRO ball...**OF MICHAEL BRANTLEY** has reached base safely in all 14 of his 15 games with Cleveland and owns an on-base % of .358 since coming up on Sept 1...He is hitting .317 (20-63) with 7 RBI, 7 runs and 3 steals...He is just 22 years old

SOLID 2ND HALF: Indians LHP JEREMY SOWERS is 9th in ERA among second half American League pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched... JEREMY SOWERS has an ERA of 3.18 (56.2IP, 20ER) to go along with a 4-2 record in nine

GETTING BETTER: Since August **19 TRAVIS HAFNER** is hitting .280 (21-75) with 5 2B, 4HR & 11RBI in 20 games (.507slg/.871ops)...He has a season onbase+slugging % of .833.

IN A HUFF LHP DAVID HUFF is bound to become the first Indians rookie to lead the team in wins since CC SABATHIA in 2001 (17)...The last rookie to win 10 games for Cleveland was RYAN DRESE in 2002...He is one of just 6 AL rookies with double digit wins this season.

PLAYOFF UPDATE Akron will play game 3 tonight with a chance to their 3rd Eastern League championship since 2003 after beating Connecticut, 7-6, on Wednesday to lead the best-of-five series 2-0... 2B JOSH RODRIGUEZ hit a three-run homer in the ninth and RHP JOSH JUDY (S, 1.0IP, 3H, 2R) earned the save... LF JERAD HEAD was 3-for-4 with RBI and 3R...Mahoning Valley lost the deciding game 3 of the NYPL finals Wednesday, 5-2, to end their outstanding season.

UPON FURTHER REVIEW: OF GRADY SIZEMORE's season came to an end on September 3rd...Lost and unnoticed about Sizemore's season was after his activation from the DL, his statistics were virtually similar to previous seasons...Let's take a look: (**6/23-9/3)

LHP DAVID HUFF (10-7, 6.14ERA)

<u>DAVID HUFF</u>... Is making his 22nd start of his Major League career today vs. the Oakland A's in Oakland ...It is his 12th career start on the road and his 2nd career start vs. the A's... Selected by Cleveland in the "Sandwich" round (39th overall) between the 1st/2nd rounds of the 2006 First-Year Player Draft out of UCLA...

⇒He was 7-4 with a 2.98 ERA (129.2IP, 121H, 50R/43ER, 27BB, 100K) in 16 starts for the Bruins during his junior year of 2006, tossing 3 complete games...Named to the PAC-10 All Conference First Team

⇒In 2007 was named to the Carolina League all-star team, going 4-2 w/a 2.72 ERA in 11 starts (59.2IP, 57H, 18ER, 15BB, 46K, 4HR)...Last start came on 5/31...Missed the last 3 months of the season w/a left elbow strain.

LAST YEAR ... In 2008 David enjoyed a breakout year between Akron and Buffalo, putting together a combined 11-5 record with a 2.52ERA (146.1IP, 112H, 41ER, 13HR, 29BB, 143K, .210 AVG) in 27G/26GS... For the year he led all Indians minor league pitchers in ERA, was T4th in wins and was 2nd in strikeouts and innings pitched...His combined .210 average against between Akron and Buffalo was the 11th lowest mark among ALL full season minor league pitchers...Following the season he was named the 6th best prospect in the International League by *Baseball America*. ⇒Began the season at AA Akron and won his last 5 decisions from April 20-May 31...Promoted to Buffalo on June 1...Over his last 9 outings at Akron his ERA was 1.11 (57.0IP, 33H, 7ER) and worked at least 5.0IP in all 9 games...Promoted to Buffalo where he dominated hitters as he went 6-4 w/a 3.01 ERA (80.2IP, 68H, 27ER, 8HR, 15BB, 81K) in 16 starts... Held batters to a .224 (68-303) average at Buffalo...Over his last 9 starts at Buffalo he was 4-2 w/a 2.32 ERA (42.2IP, 34H, 11ER)...Combined on the year he went at least 5.0IP in 23 of his 27 starts
⇒Entered 2008 as the 8th best prospect in the Indians organization

THIS YEAR/SPRING... This year at AAA Columbus David was 5-1 w/a 4.35 ERA in 7 starts (39.IP, 35H, 19ER, 5HR, 16BB, 32K,.241AVG)...At the time of his May 17 promotion he was T1st in the International League in wins...This spring limited to 2 outings (4.0IP, 8H, 4R/ER) due to left shoulder tendinitis and was re-assigned to minor league camp on March 19

⇒ Went at least 5.0IP in all 7 of his starts and fanned a season-high 7 on April 25 vs. Indy...IL hitters are batting .241 (35-145) w/5HR allowed...LHH are batting .275 (11-40) w/1HR and RHH are batting .229 (24-105) with 4HR allowed...Batters are batting .283 (15-53) with runners on base and .281 (9-32) with RISP....Tossed 6.0 shutout IP on May 1 vs. Durham.

⇔ Made his Major League debut on May 17 as his contract was purchased that day from AAA Columbus...Fell to 0-1 in the 7-5 Tampa win... 3.2IP, 7H, 7R/ER, 4BB, 2K... Did not get a decision in his start of Saturday, May 23 in Cincinnati, a 7-6 comeback win over the Reds and David Weathers...3.0IP, 7H, 6R/ER, 1BB, 3K, 3HR to Hernandez & Votto (2HR)...Tossed season-high 4.0IP in start of May 28 (4.0IP, 4H, 0R) vs. TB, but did not get a decision thanks to a 2:40 rain delay in the 5th inning of an eventual 2-1 win... Fell to 0-2 after his start on Tuesday, June 2 against the Minnesota Twins in the HHH Metrodome, a 4-3 loss to the Twins despite tossing a career-high 5.0 innings... 5.0IP, 9H, 4R/ER, 0BB, 5K, HR to Mauer...Threw 98 pitches/64 strikes.

⇒Picked up his first Major League win in start of Sunday, June 7 in Chicago, an 8-4 win over the Sox and Colon...5.0IP, 4H, 3R/ER, 3BB, 3K, HR to A Ramirez...Notched 2nd straight win in start vs. STL on June 12 (career-high7.1IP, 6H, 3R/ER)...Worked a career-high 8.0IP shutout innings in start of June 23 at PIT (9.0IP, 4H, 0R, 2BB, 2K)... The 3 straight wins equals an Indians individual season-high... Fell to 3-3 in start vs. CIN on June 28 (5.0IP, 6ER) ... Earned his 4th win of the season on July 3, a 15-3 victory over the Oakland Athletics in Progressive Field... 6.0IP, 8H, 3R/ER, BB, 4K...Worked into the 8th inning and won his 5th game at Toronto on July 23 (7.2IP, 8H, 4R/ER) and worked into the 8th inning in loss at LA Angels (7.0+IP, 8H, 5R/ER) on July 28... Won 8th game at KC on August 26 (6.0IP, 7H, 2R/ER) and 9th game in last start of Sept 6 vs. Minnesota (7.0IP, 2H, 1R/ER) & team-high 10th game on Sept. 12 vs. KC (6.0IP, 7H, 3R/ER)... Over his last 3 starts his ERA 2.84 (19.0IP, 16H, 6ER)... Has won 3 straight starts for the 2nd time this year... Over his last 16 starts since June 7th he is 9-5 w/a 5.56 ERA (98.2IP, 120H, 61ER)... Over his last 6GS he is 5-1 w/a 4.54 ERA (33.2IP, 39H, 17ER)...

⇒ Leads the team lead in wins (10), which are t4th among AL rookie pitchers…Is 9th in the AL in rookie IP and 4th in winning % (.588)

⇒ Thru 21 starts batters are hitting .308 (147-477) w/16HR, including a .297 (91-306, 10HR) by RHH and a .327 (56-171, 6HR) mark vs.

LHH…Batters are hitting .284 (64-225) with runners on base and .323 (41-127) with RISP… Has 5SB against/1CS…Indians are averaging 5.9 RS/GM in his 21GS (124R)…Indians are 13-8 in his starts… Nine of his 10 wins have come in games following an Indians loss …Huff is now 9-3 in his 15 starts following a Cleveland loss (Indians are 11-4 overall in those games)

SATURDAY'S STARTER: LHP JEREMY SOWERS will make his 20th start/21st appearance of the 2009 season Saturday, Sept. 19 against the Athletics in Oakland...Did not get a decision in his last start of Monday, Sept. 14 in the Metrodome vs. the Minnesota Twins, a 6-3 loss to the Twins and Ron Mahay despite leaving with a 3-0 lead (Twins scored 6 runs in the 8th inning)...7.0IP, 6H, 0R, 2BB, 2K...Improved to 6-9 in his start of Sept. 4 vs. the Twins in Cleveland, a 5-2 win over the Twins and Carl Pavano...6.0IP, 6H, 2R/ER, 0BB, 1K... Over his last 9 starts he is 4-2 w/a 3.18 ERA (56.2IP, 50H, 20ER)... He was optioned out on July 9 and has made 1 start in Columbus (7/19 vs SYRA, 6.1IP, 7H, 5R)...At Columbus he is 2-2 w/a 2.89 ERA in 6 starts (37.1IP, 36H, 12ER, 9BB, 27K) compared to a 6-9, 4.49ERA mark in Cleveland (114.1IP, 115H, 57ER)...Won his first game as a starter in start vs. Cincinnati Reds in Cleveland after losing 3 straight decisions, June 6-21...9-2 win over the Reds and Harang...7.0IP, 6H, 2R/ER, 1BB, 6K...Made the first relief appearance of his Major League career in his outing of May 25 vs. Tampa in an 11-10 comeback win (came back from 10-0 TB lead)...W#1, 5.0IP, 3H, 0R, 1BB, 1K...Seasonhigh IP by a Tribe reliever this season... Sowers was optioned to AAA Columbus out of spring training on March 24 after going 0-2 with a 4.91 ERA (14.2IP, 20H, 10R/8ER, 7BB, 6K) in 6 games/ 2 starts in Arizona... Has never faced Oakland.
