TRIBE AT A GLANCE: The Indians will continue a 4-game series with the Oakland A's in Oakland at 4:07 PM ET ... Series is part of a 7-game roadtrip to Minneapolis and Oakland (Indians are 0-5 on 'trip after sweep @MIN)...Indians just finished a 9-game homestand with the Twins, Rangers & Royals at 3-6, losing 5 of last 6 games... Went 4-6 on last trip to KC, BAL & Detroit (swept in DET)... Indians won a season-high 5-straight games from July 23-27... Indians are 26-32 in the 2nd half, including a mark of 14-16 on the road in the 2nd half....Tribe is 30-45 on the road, 31-41 at home and their 0-5 start to the season was their worst in 24 years (1985, 0-5)...**Worst record at the break (35-54) since 1991 (26-53)...**The Indians were swept in a 3-game set in Texas Rangers Ballpark to begin the season...On Saturday, April 18 Indians scored a club-record tying 14 runs in the 2nd inning, the most runs ever scored in MLB history in the 2nd inning (ELIAS) and most ever all'd by the Yankees in a 22-4 win... Last time a MLB team scored 14R in any inning was 6/27/03 (Red Sox did it vs. FLA)...The 50 total bases tied the club record set on 7/16/04 at Seattle... The 8 extra base hits in the 2nd inning were a modern day record (since 1900) for EB hits in any inning and the 13 hits set or tied the club record...25 hits were their most since recording 26 hits in a 10-9, 17-inning win on 5/7/95 vs. Minnesota (most in a 9.0IP since 1952)...Allowed 12 runs in the 6th inning at Boston before recording an out on May 7 (tied modern MLB record)...Lost a season-high 6 straight games, 6/15-21, and went 5-13 in interleague play (Indians are 33-51 since 6/13, but have won 25 of their last 54 games since July 21 (25-29, .463)...Are a season-high 17.0 games out of first place & a season-high 25-games under .500 (Sept. 18, 61-86)...Have equaled season-high 6-game losing streak and have lost 9 consecutive road games dating back to August 30 @BAL

DID YOU KNOW?

Indians have lost a season-high equaling 6 straight games since Sept 13 (also June 15-21) and have lost 9 straight road games since Aug 30

Indians have been hit by a pitch 78 times most in MLB... **SHOPPACH** has been hit 18 times which ties for the MLB lead (Choo is 2nd in AL w/15).

ERIC WEDGE is now in 5th place in club history with 557 managerial wins.

Indians are 56-31 when scoring 4 or more runs and 5-55 when scoring 3 or fewer.

PROMISING RETURN Two key components of last year's CC SABATHIA trade are contributing at the big league level of late...**MATT LaPORTA** is hitting .282 (29-103) with 9 2B, 5HR & 14 RBI in 27 games (.515SLG/.814OPS) since returning from AAA Columbus on August 19...He is in just his 2ND full season of PRO pall...OF MICHAEL BRANTLEY has reached base safely in all 15 of his 16 games with Cleveland and owns an on-base % of .366 since coming up on Sept 1...He is hitting .317 (22-67) with 7 RBI, 7 runs and 3 steals...He is just 22 years old

SOLID 2ND HALF: Indians LHP JEREMY SOWERS is 9th in ERA among second nalf American League pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched... JEREMY **SOWERS** has an ERA of 3.18 (56.2IP, 20ER) to go along with a 4-2 record in nine 2nd half starts...**Zack GREINKE** (2.17) leads the league.

GETTING BETTER: Since August **19 TRAVIS HAFNER** is hitting .280 (21-75) with 5 2B, 4HR & 11RBI in 20 games (.507slg/.871ops)...He has a season onbase+slugging % of .833.

PLAYOFF UPDATE Akron lost game 3 last night in Canal Park, 8-7... CARLOS SANTANA homered and LONNIE CHISENHALL was 3-for-4 w/a RS & RBI... Chisenhall is 13-for-25 (.520) in the playoffs and has an on-base % of .556... Akron leads 2 games to one and plays CT again tonight.

JEREMY SOWERS...Is making his 20th start and 21st appearance of the 2009 season today against the Oakland A's in Oakland...It is his 10th start/appearance on the road and his 1st start vs. OAK this season (1st career start vs. OAK)

- Was the 6th overall pick in the first round of the 2004 draft by the Indians...Went 10-6 with a 3.08 ERA in 19 appearances/17 starts for Vanderbilt University in 2004 (school record 122.2IP, 105H, 42ER, 26BB, 119SO) during his junior year...
- Attended Ballard High School in Louisville, KY where he was named National High School All-American by Baseball America...
- Selected by Cincinnati in the first round (20th pick overall) of the 2001 Major League Baseball Draft, but opted to attend Vandy.
- Went a combined 14-4 with a 2.37 ERA in 27 starts at A Kinston, AA Akron and AAA Buffalo in his first season as a pro in 2005 (159.1IP, 141H, 42ER, 149K, .235 avg)...Led organizational pitchers in wins and strikeouts and was named Minor League Pitcher of the Year (Bob Feller Award).
