TRIBE AT A GLANCE: The Indians will conclude a 4-game series with the Oakland A's in Oakland at 4:07 PM ET ... Series is part of a 7-game roadtrip to Minneapolis and Oakland (Indians are 0-6 on 'trip after sweep @MIN)...Indians just finished a 9-game homestand with the Twins, Rangers & Royals at 3-6, losing 5 of last 6 games... **Went 4-6 on last trip to KC, BAL & Detroit (swept in DET)... Indians won a season-high 5-straight games from July 23-27...** Indians are 26-33 in the 2nd half, including a mark of 14-17 on the road in the 2nd half...Tribe is 30-46 on the road, 31-41 at home and their 0-5 start to the season was their worst in 24 years (1985, 0-5)...**Worst record at the break (35-54) since 1991 (26-53)**...The Indians were swept in a 3-game set in Texas Rangers Ballpark to begin the season...On Saturday, April 18 Indians scored a club-record tying 14 runs in the 2nd inning, the most runs ever scored in MLB history in the 2nd inning (ELIAS) and most ever all'd by the Yankees in a 22-4 win... Last time a MLB team scored 14R in any inning was 6/27/03 (Red Sox did it vs. FLA)...The 50 total bases tied the club record set on 7/16/04 at Seattle... The 8 extra base hits in the 2nd inning were a modern day record (since 1900) for EB hits in any inning and the 13 hits set or tied the club record...25 hits were their most since recording 26 hits in a 10-9, 17-inning win on 5/7/95 vs. Minnesota (most in a 9.0IP since 1952)...Allowed 12 runs in the 6th inning at Boston before recording an out on May 7 (tied modern MLB record)...**Lost a season-high 6 straight games, 6/15-21, and went 5-13 in interleague play (Indians are 33-52 since 6/13, but have won 25 of their last 55 games since July 21 (25-30, .455))...Are a season-high 17.0 games out of first place & a season-high 26-games under .500 (Sept. 18, 61-87)...Have lost a season-high 7 straight games and have lost 10 consecutive road games dating back to August 30 @BAL**

PROMISING RETURN

Two key components of last year's **CC SABATHIA** trade are contributing at the big league level of late...**MATT LaPORTA** is hitting .290 (31-107) with 9 2B, 5HR & 14 RBI in 28 games (.514SLG/.827OPS) since returning from AAA Columbus on August 19...He is in just his 2nd full season of PRO ball...**OF MICHAEL BRANTLEY** has reached base safely in all 16 of his 17 games with Cleveland and owns an on-base % of .368 since coming up on Sept 1...He is hitting .314 (22-70) with 7 RBI, 7 runs and 3 steals...He is just 22 years old

STREAKING WRONG WAY:

The Indians have lost a season-high 7 straight games since Sept. 13, longest losing streak since losing 10 straight games last June 28-July 9...The 10 game road losing streak is the longest since last June 22-July 18th as well...Have not lost more than 10 str road games since June of 1991...The Indians have NEVER been swept in a 4-game series in Oakland...Last swept in road 4-game series in July of 2003 at New York-AL

IN A HUFF LHP DAVID HUFF

is bound to become the first Indians rookie to lead the team in wins since **CC SABATHIA** in 2001 (17)...The last rookie to win 10 games for Cleveland was **RYAN DRESE** in 2002...He is one of just 6 AL rookies with double digit wins this season.

CONGRATS AEROS

Akron captured their 3rd Eastern League title since 2003 with a 10-6 win last night vs. Connecticut in game 4 of the EL finals...**SCOTT BARNES** (5.0IP, 7K) got the win & **CARLOS SANTANA** homered & drove in 3 runs...**MIKE SARBAUGH** secured his third title in the Indians system (Mahoning Valley, 2004, A Kinston, 2006)...**JOHN DRENNEN** also homered and drove in two runs

UPON FURTHER REVIEW:

OF GRADY SIZEMORE's season came to an end on September 3rd...Lost and unnoticed about Sizemore's season was after his activation from the DL, his statistics were virtually similar to previous seasons...Let's take a look: (**6/23-9/3)

The Indians pitching staff has an ERA of 4.47 (527.1IP, 564H, 262ER) in the 2nd half ...**The 4.47 ERA ranks 8th best in the AL in the 2nd half... Indians are hitting .272 (560-2058) in the 2nd half w/266 runs scored in 59 games (4.51RS/GM)... Indians are 26-33 in the 2nd half...**

Despite their 61-87 record, the Indians offense currently ranks 18th in the Majors in runs scored with 717 (4.84RS/G) and are on pace to score 785 runs this year...**Hit .260 in 1st half**

DID YOU KNOW?

Indians have lost a season-high 7 straight games since Sept 13 and have lost 10 straight road games since Aug 30

Including **DAVID HUFF Friday's lineup contained 6 rookies & Valbuena PH in the 8th**

Indians have lost 16 of their last 19 games & 17 of their last 21 games since August 28.

ASDRUBAL BRINGS "A" GAME: SS ASDRUBAL CABRERA is now 14th in the AL in batting average (.305) ... **Since August 1 he is batting .321 (54-168) w/2 HR & 22RBI in 42G...** Over his last 61G since July 8th he is batting .312 (78-250) w/22 2B, 2 3B, 4HR & 30RBI...**He is 11th in the AL in doubles (38)**

ROOKIE RESIDENCE: The Indians currently have 12 rookies on their 30-man Major League roster, which is tied for the most in the Major Leagues with the Orioles, D-Backs, Reds, Pirates & Padres...**LHP TONY SIPP** has made the most of his opportunity as he has allowed just 3 runs since August 1 covering 20 games (0.98ERA, 18.1IP, 10H, 2ER, 3BB, 24K, .161avg) ...

RHP FAUSTO CARMONA (3-11, 6.58 ERA)

FAUSTO CARMONA ... Is making his 22nd start and appearance of the 2009 season today vs. Oakland A's in Oakland, his 11th start on the road this season and his 1st start vs. A's this year (7th game/6th career GS vs. OAK)... **Signed long-term contract through 2011 w/club options for 2012, 2013 & 2014 seasons on April 10, 2008.**

⇒ Product of the Indians' Dominican Academy was the Tribe's Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2003.

⇒ In 2003 was named to the **Baseball America** Low Class A All-Star team and the #3 prospect overall in the Indians organization by **BA**...Pitched primarily at A Lake County where he led the South Atlantic League in wins (17) and ERA (2.06) and was a SAL All-Star... Won 10 games between 3 stops along the Tribe's minor league trail in 2004 and after the season was added to the club's 40-man roster.

⇒ Split the 2005 minor league season between Akron and Buffalo, going a combined 13-9 w/a 3.68 ERA in 27 games/26 starts between AAA Buffalo and AA Akron...His 173.2IP led the entire Indians organization.

⇒ Was the first member of the Indians' Lake County (A) affiliate to appear in a game for Cleveland...Split 2006 between Buffalo and Cleveland...Pitched in a variety of roles for the Indians

⇒ In 2007 posted one of the finest seasons by an Indians right-handed pitcher in recent memory, finishing with 19 wins, the most by an Indians pitcher since RHP Bert Blyleven in 1984 (19) at the age of 23...Youngest Indian RHP to reach 200.0IP since Eckersley in 1977... Finished 4th in the AL Cy Young voting, 2nd in the AL in ERA, he finished T2nd in wins (19), T10th in innings (215.0)...He was the youngest Indians RHP to win 17 or more games since Bob Feller did it each year between 1938-41 (ages 19-22)...

LAST YEAR...⇒ 2008 season was interrupted in late May after making 10 solid starts to begin the season, posting an ERA of 3.10 (58.0IP, 54H, 20ER, 38BB, 23K, .254avg) before being injured in start of May 24 vs. Texas (2.0IP, 5H, 6R/ER)...Never regained his early form after his activation on July 26, yet was plagued by control problems virtually the entire season...His 38 walks at the time of his injury led the American League...Was 4-5 w/a 7.61ERA in 12 starts in the second half upon his July 26 activation from the DL (62.2IP, 72H, 53ER, .286AVG, 32BB, 35K)... ERA in the 1st inning was 7.36 (22.0IP, 25H, 18ER)...Made 6 starts for Aquilas in the Dominican Winter League after the season, going 2-2 w/a 4.41 ERA (32.2IP, 31H, 16ER, 10BB, 28K).

THIS YEAR ...Lost his first start of the year on April 8 in Texas, an 8-5 win for the Rangers and Vicente Padilla...5.0IP, 7H, 6R/ER, 2BB, 4K, HR to Cruz... Fell to 0-2 in start at KC on April 13 (5.0IP, 5H, 4R/ER, 4BB, 3K)...Got 22 runs of support in a 22-4 win at New York on April 18 for his first win of the season...6.0IP, 6H, 4R/ER...Struck out season-high 7 in start vs. Twins on April 24, losing his 3rd decision in 4 starts (6.0IP, 8H, 4ER)... **Was 1-3 w/a 6.28 ERA (28.2IP, 31H, 21R/20ER, 16BB, 18K) in 5 starts during the month of April**...Went 6.2IP in 3 straight starts, April 29-May 9...Won 2nd game of the season on May 14 in TB (5.1IP, 4H, 4ER)...

⇒Then season-low 1.1IP in ND vs. TB on May 25 as the Indians rallied from a 10-0 deficit....1.1IP, 3H, 5R/ER, 5BB, 3K... Suffered his 5th loss of the season in his start of May 30 vs. the New York Yankees in Progressive Field... Was a 10-5 loss to the Yankees and C.C. Sabathia... 4.0IP, 8H, 7R/4ER, 3BB, 2K...

During the month of May was 1-2 with a 6.90 ERA (30.0IP, 33H, 27R/23ER, 22BB, 17K) in 6 starts...Made 12th start on June 4 in Minnesota, an 11-3 loss (2.0IP, 5H, 7R/ER, two 3-run HR to Kubel) and was optioned to the Arizona Rookie League the next day...Over his last 5 starts w/Cleveland prior to his June 5 option he was 1-2 w/a 11.57 ERA (18.2IP, 26H, 24ER, 18BB, 11K)

⇒**Was in Goodyear beginning on June 5 throwing bullpens and working on mechanics and pre-pitch preparation with coordinators Julio Rangel, Dave Miller and Steve Lyons** until making his first start at Lake County on June 25 (6.1IP, 1H, 0R) and another start at Akron on June 30 (7.0IP, 4H, 1R)... **Spent July with Columbus, going 1-3 w/a 3.55 ERA in 5 starts (33.0IP, 32H, 13ER, 6BB, 27K, .250AVG)...LH hitters batted just .214 (9-42) at Columbus off him (.161 5-for-31 w/RISP as well)...Combined 3-3 w/a 2.73ERA in 7 minor league starts since being sent down on June 5 (46.1IP, 37H, 14/ER, 7BB, 39K, .215Bavg)...Walk to SO ratio was 5.57 and all'd just 1.36 walks per 9.0IP.**

⇒Recalled on July 31 and made start that night vs. Detroit (ND, 5.0IP, 4H, 2R/ER)... Lost consecutive starts Aug. 12 vs. TEX (6.0IP, 5H, 2R/ER, 3BB, 3K) and Aug. 18 vs. LAA (5.0IP, 10H, 5R/3ER, 2BB, 4K) to fall to 2-8 on the year... **Won his 1st game since May 14th in his start of August 23 vs. Seattle, a 6-1 Indians win... 7.0IP, 5H, 1R/ER, BB, 8K...** Fell to 3-10 in his last start of September 9 against the Texas Rangers in Progressive Field, a 10-3 win for the Rangers and Scott Feldman...Last a career-low 0.2IP while giving up 6 hits and 5 runs...0.2IP, 6H, 5R/ER, 1BB, 1K, 4IP, HR to Byrd (3R) & Rodriguez (2R)... **Since returning from minors is 1-5 w/a 5.48 ERA (46.0IP, 58H, 28ER, 25BB, 30K, .304AVG, 5HR) in 9 starts and has gone at least 5.0IP in 7 of the 9 starts...Over his last 4GS since August 28 he is 0-3 w/a 10.05 ERA (17.0IP, 28H, 19ER, .368AVG)**

⇒Major League batters are hitting .292 (127-435, 14HR) off him...RHH are hitting .240 (44-183,4HR, .704 OPS), 14th lowest in the AL and LHH are batting .329 (83-252, .980OPS, 10HR) ...Batters are hitting .320 (66-206) with runners on base and .312 (43-138) w/RISP... 8SB/3CS...At the time of his demotion was leading MLB w/41 walks...**Indians are 8-13 in his starts (109RS/21GS, 5.2RS/GM...ERA in first 2.0IP is 8.33 (40.0IP, 58H, 37ER)...**

LAST START: ... Fell to 3-11 in his last start of September 15 against the Minnesota Twins in the Metrodome, a 5-4 win for the Twins and Jon Rauch...5.1IP, 9H, 5R/ER, 3BB, 3K, HR to Cabrera...9pp

ON THE ROAD: Today is Fausto's 11th start/app on the road this year... **THIS YEAR** is 2-5 w/a 8.08 ERA in 10 games/starts (52.1IP, 63H, 47ER, 8HR, 32 BB, 28K) **CAREER** is 15-17 w/a 5.03ERA in 57 games/39 starts (247.0IP, 269H, 138ER, 112BB, 143K, 25HR) on the road.

TUESDAY'S STARTER: LHP AARON LAFFEY will make his 17th start/23rd appearance of the 2009 season on Tue., Sept. 22nd vs. Detroit in Progressive Field...Fell to 7-6 in his last start of Wed., September 16 in the Metrodome against the Twins, a 7-3 loss to the Twins and Nick Blackburn...6.0IP, 12H, 7R/6ER, 3BB, 0K...**Is 4-4 w/a 3.95 ERA in his last 10 starts since July 24 (59.1IP, 71H, 26ER)...** Suffered a right oblique strain on May 22nd at Cincinnati and was placed on the DL until being activated on July 8 at Chicago-AL... Made 4 rehab starts between AA Akron and AAA Columbus going 0-1 with a 6.91 ERA (14.1IP, 21H, 11R/ER, 10BB, 9K) most recently starting on July 3 for Columbus (L, 4.0IP, 10H, 7ER)... **This year with the Indians is 7-6-1 with a 4.09 ERA (105.2IP, 118H, 48ER, 49BB, 50K) in 22 games/16 starts...** Laffey began the 2009 season at AAA Columbus making 1 start before being recalled on April 15th... He made 4 starts with the Indians going 2-0 w/a 4.09 ERA (22.0IP, 21H, 10ER, 15BB, 10K) before being moved to the bullpen on May 6th...
