OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's completed their first four-game series sweep since August 26-29, 2005 at Baltimore and their first at home since August 23-26, 2004, also against Baltimore...have won a season-high tying seven straight games (also, June 2-8)....are 12-2 over their last 14 games, outscoring their opponents 88 to 41 over that span...are now 4-0 on this eight-game homestand against Cleveland (4-0) and Texas (four games).
- The A's pitching staff has allowed 12 runs over the last seven games and only nine earned...has a 1.29 ERA (9 er in 63.0 ip) and .179 (40 for 223) opponents batting average over that span.
- Dana Eveland is now 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA (2 er in 12.0 ip) and a .234 (11 for 47) opponents batting average in two career starts against Cleveland, both in Oakland.
- Rajai Davis (2 for 5) has an eight-game hitting streak (14 for 33, .424)...is also 37 for 94 (.394) with 13 multiple hit games, 19 runs, 16 RBI and 13 stolen bases over his last 22 games.
- Adam Kennedy (3 for 5) extended his hitting streak to seven games, batting .419 (13 for 31) over that stretch...is batting .400 (26 for 65) with 11 multiple hit games in 15 games in September.

CLEVELAND NOTES

- The Cleveland Indians have lost a season-high eight straight games (previous high: six, June 15-21), which is the Indian's longest losing streak since losing 10 straight last year from June 28-July 9...have also lost 11-straight road games which is their longest losing streak on the road since losing 12 straight from June 21-July 12, 1991...were swept in a four-game series for the first time since July 17-20, 2003 at New York-AL and for the first time ever in Oakland...have lost 11 of their last 12 games and are 3-17 over their last 20 contests...finished 0-7 on their seven-game roadtrip through Minnesota (0-3) and Oakland (0-4).
- Fausto Carmona is now 0-4 with a 10.72 ERA (27 er in 22.2 ip) and a .373 (38 for 102) opponents batting average over his last five starts.
- Michael Brantley (3 for 4) has reached base safely via hit or walk in 17 of his 18 games to start his career.
- Matt LaPorta (1 for 4) has hit safely in seven of his last eight games, batting .355 (11 for 31) with two home runs and six RBI over that span.
- Jhonny Peralta (0 for 3) is currently 0 for his last 21 at bats.
