- A's pitching recorded four strikeouts to tie the Athletics franchise record of 1117 set in 2001.
- A's starting pitchers are 0-6 with a 9.40 ERA (31 er in 29.2 ip) over the last seven games.
- Craig Breslow has not allowed a run in his last 11 outings (13.1 ip) and now has a 1.08 ERA (3 er in 25.0 ip) over his last 21 games.
- Jack Cust (0 for 3) now has 185 strikeouts for the season, which is tied for the third most strikeouts in a season in American League history.
