OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 2-1 on this four-game homestand against the Seattle Mariners...each of the A's first three games this year have been decided in the winning team's final at-bats, the first time that has happened in Oakland history...it's the first time they've earned consecutive walk-off wins since June 2-3, 2008.
- Justin Duchscherer made his first Major League appearance since August 18, 2008...is 1-5 with a 3.90 ERA (60 IP, 26 ER) in 32 career appearances (five starts) vs. Seattle...last faced the Mariners in 2008 and went 1-1 with a 1.29 ERA in two starts...last win came on July 8, 2008 against Seattle, a two-hit shutout in an A's 2-0 win.
- The A's bullpen has recorded the decision in the first three games of the season for only the second time in Oakland history (1997).
- Tyson Ross made his Major League debut.
- Daric Barton (1 for 3) is a career .320 hitter (32 for 100) against Seattle...best mark against any team.
- Travis Buck has not committed an error in his career and has a 152-game errorless streak, which is third longest in Oakland history by an outfielder.
- Kurt Suzuki recorded his seventh career walk-off hit.
- Ryan Sweeney (2 for 4) is the only Athletic to hit safely in each of the first three games.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The Seattle Mariners are 1-2 on this seven-game road trip against the Oakland Athletics (1-2) and Texas Rangers.
- Ryan Rowland-Smith is 2-1 with a 3.37 ERA (42.2 IP, 16 ER) in 11 career appearances (six starts) against the A's...went 1-0 with a 2.55 ERA (17.2 IP, 5 ER) in three starts vs. Oakland in 2009.
- Franklin Gutierrez (2 for 4) extended his hitting streak to eight games dating back to last season...is batting .400 (12 for 30) with four doubles, five RBI and seven runs scored over that span.
- Ichiro Suzuki (1 for 4) is now riding a 23-game hitting streak against Oakland...is hitting .373 (37 for 99) during that stretch with four doubles, one triple and seven RBI...is the second-longest hit streak of his career against an opponent, trailing only 26-game hit streak against the Kansas City Royals (April 14, 2005 to April 15, 2008).
