OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics went 3-1 on this four-game homestand against the Seattle Mariners after losing the season series 14-5 last year...begin a six-game road trip against the Los Angeles Angels and Mariners tomorrow.
- Brett Anderson** is 3-2 with a 2.83 ERA (35.0 IP, 11 ER) in six career starts against Seattle...is 5-1 with a 1.82 ERA (34.2 IP, 7 ER) in his past six starts dating back to last season.
- Daric Barton** (3 for 4) had a career-high four RBI (previous, 3 RBI, two times. Last: Sept. 11, 2009 at MIN)...is a career .337 hitter (35 for 104) against Seattle...best mark against any team.
- Rajai Davis** (2 for 5) and **Mark Ellis** (2 for 4) have three multiple-hit performances in four games this season...are hitting .316 (6 for 19) and .438 (7 for 16), respectively.
- Ryan Sweeney** (1 for 4) is the only Athletic to hit safely in each of the first four games (5 for 17, .294).

SEATTLE NOTES

- The Seattle Mariners are 1-3 on this seven-game road trip against the Oakland Athletics (1-3) and Texas Rangers.
- Doug Fister** is 1-1 with a 2.25 ERA (16.0 IP, 4 ER) in three career starts against the A's.
- Franklin Gutierrez** (1 for 3) extended his hitting streak to nine games dating back to last season...is batting .394 (13 for 33) with five doubles, five RBI and eight runs scored over that span.
- Ichiro Suzuki** (0 for 4) had his 23-game hitting streak against Oakland snapped...is hitting .359 (37 for 103) in his past 24 games against the A's...was the second-longest hit streak of his career against an opponent, trailing only 26-game hit streak against the Kansas City Royals (April 14, 2005 to April 15, 2008).
