Baltimore Orioles (1-8) vs. Oakland Athletics (6-4)

RHP **David Hernandez** (0-1, 3.00) vs. RHP **Ben Sheets** (0-0, 4.09)

TODAY'S GAME: The Orioles and Athletics meet in the opener of their four-game series and the first game of a 10-game road trip that includes visits to Seattle and Boston...The Birds are off to their worst start since the 1988 season, when they began 0-21...The Birds have dropped six straight since winning April 8 at Tampa Bay.

NEW INFORMATION SOURCE: The Orioles have launched www.ospressbox.com, where media members will be able to access all official club information, such as daily minor league reports, game notes, media advisories, press clips, press releases and the game day media dining room menu.

VS. OAKLAND: The Athletics won the season series in 2009, 5-1, as the Orioles were swept in three games in Oakland and won one of three in Baltimore...The Orioles have lost their last six games in Oakland and have not won there since July 22, 2007, when **Jeremy Guthrie**, **Chad Bradford** and **Jamie Walker** combined on a two-hit shutout...The Orioles lead the all-time series 234-232, going 111-118 in Baltimore and 123-114 in Oakland.

ROSTER MOVE: The Orioles today recalled RHP **Kam Mickolio** from Triple-A Norfolk...Mickolio was 1-0 with a 1.93 ERA (9.1IP, 2ER) in nine spring training games for the Orioles...In three appearances for Norfolk this year, Mickolio allowed one earned run in three innings...He fills the roster spot opened when LHP **Michael Gonzalez** was placed on the 15-day disabled list with a left shoulder strain Wednesday.

PIE CALIENTE: Dating back to last year, **Felix Pie** has hit in a career-high nine straight games, going 14-for-33 (.424) with three doubles, a homer and four RBI...Pie has hit safely in all five games in which he has an at-bat this year (8-17, .471)...Since August 14, 2009, when he hit for the cycle against Los Angeles (AL), Pie is batting .326 (43-132) with eight doubles, a triple, eight homers, 19 RBI and 21 runs scored in 41 games...The Orioles have lost the last 15 games in which Pie has appeared.

BROKEN BATS: Through nine games, the Orioles are 1-for-31 (.032) with runners in scoring position and two outs, the lowest average in the majors...The O's are 10-for-66 (.152) with runners in scoring position and have left 67 runners on base...Baltimore batted .284 with RISP in 2009, finishing second in the A.L.

DOING THEIR PART: Orioles starting pitchers lead the AL in strikeouts (47)...The starters are 20th in the majors with a 4.82 ERA (11th in the AL) after being tied for 29th in the majors in 2009 (5.37, last in the AL)...They have walked just 16 batters, which ties for the seventh-lowest total in the big leagues and second-best in the AL...The 52.0 innings pitched are tied for 11th in the majors and are 9th best in the AL after finishing last in the majors in 2009 (877.2 IP).

EARLY WORK: The Orioles have scored eight times in the first inning this year and just 19 runs in the other innings combined.

MAKE 'EM WORK: The Orioles are 29th in the major leagues in pitches seen per plate appearance (3.65)...**Nick Markakis** is seventh in the majors in pitches seen per plate appearance (4.59).

LATE INNING WOES: The Orioles have allowed at least one run in the 8th inning or later in eight of their nine games this season (yesterday was the first game they did not allow a run in the eighth inning or later)...21 of their 49 runs allowed this year have scored in the 8th inning or later...Tuesday marked the fifth game this year in which the Birds gave up the tying or go-ahead runs in the final two frames.

GOLD GLOVES: The Orioles have the second-highest fielding percentage in the major leagues (.994) as they have made just two miscues in the field (both by **Miguel Tejada**)...The AL East has two of the top three defensive teams in baseball, with Baltimore tied for second (.994) and the Red Sox are third (.993).

A WALK IN THE PARK: **Nick Markakis** is second in AL in walks (10) behind Oakland's **Daric Barton** (11)...Markakis did not draw a single walk in 63 spring training at-bats.

MR. CLUTCH: **Miguel Tejada** is 6-for-18 with a home run and six RBI with batting with men on base and is 2-for-17 with a solo home run with the bases empty this season.

WEARING OUT THE BASEPATHS: **Matt Wieters** has reached base safely in all eight of his games and his .424 on-base percentage is 20th in the AL and 45th in the majors...Wieters became the first catcher in Orioles history to open a season with three consecutive multi-hit games...Wieters is 10-for-29 (.345) with a homer, three runs, three RBI and four walks in eight games.

THE RIFLEMEN: **Felix Pie** recorded his first outfield assist Monday night, throwing out **Jason Bartlett** at the plate...The Orioles have two outfield assists this year (both at the plate against the Rays) after leading the AL with 36 outfield assists in 2009...**Nick Markakis** recorded his 52nd career assist from the outfield on Opening Day...Since the start of the 2006 season, only **Alfonso Soriano** (58) and **Jeff Francouer** (58) have more outfield assists than Markakis.

CLOSE CALLS: Four of the first nine games have been decided by one run and another was decided by two...In 2009, 72 of the 162 games (44%) were decided by one or two runs with the O's going 29-43 in those games...The Birds were 17-22 in one-run games in '09...24 of the last 49 losses in '09 were by one or two runs.

SPRING TRAINING REPORT: The Orioles drew over 100,000 fans for the first time in franchise history in the Grapefruit League...The Birds went 12-17-1 during the exhibition schedule, including a 6-9 record at Ed Smith Stadium...**Nolan Reimold**'s .283 average led the club among players with 50 or more at-bats, despite starting the spring going 0-for-22 (went 15-31 after that)...**Adam Jones**' five home runs led the club and his 12 RBI tied him with **Luke Scott** for the team lead...**Brad Bergesen** led the team with three wins, while **Brian Matusz** allowed fewer combined hits (19) and walks (3) than innings pitched (24.1)...Non-roster invitee **Will Ohman** made the club by allowing just two hits and four walks in 8.2 innings (11 games).

TOMORROW'S STARTER: **RH Kevin Millwood** makes his third start of the season and second road start...In two starts as an Oriole, Millwood is 0-1 with a 2.13 ERA (12.2IP, 3ER)...He has allowed more home runs (four) than earned runs (three)...In five career starts in Oakland, Millwood is 2-3 with a 4.11 ERA (30.2IP, 14ER)...In his last start in Oakland (September 21, 2009), Millwood allowed one unearned run on three hits and a walk while striking out two in seven innings for the win.

QUICK HITS: The Orioles have lost his last 10 starts since he beat Oakland August 11, 2009 (Hernandez is 0-7 in that span)... Won his major league debut May 28, 2009 vs. Detroit... Was the fourth Oriole (of five) to win his major league debut in 2009... Led the Eastern League in strikeouts in 2008 (166) and the Carolina League in 2007 (168)... After 2008 season, was rated by *Baseball America* as having the best slider in the system.

LAST START: Was tagged with the loss despite making a quality start against the Toronto Blue Jays April 10 in Baltimore... Hernandez allowed two earned runs on six hits and four walks while striking out five in six innings... Two of his four walks were intentional.

HERNANDEZ VS. ATHLETICS: In his only start against the A's (August 11, 2009 in Baltimore), Hernandez worked 6.2 innings and allowed two earned runs on two hits and a walk while striking out six for the win... Hernandez has not won a game since that start.

SPRING TRAINING REPORT: Went 1-1 with a 3.00 ERA (15.0IP, 5ER) in five games (two starts)... He walked just three while striking out 20.

2009 HIGHLIGHTS: Had three stints with the Orioles: May 28-June 11, June 28-July 10 and July 20-end of the season... Won his major league debut on May 28 vs. DET, becoming fourth O's rookie (following Uehara, Bergesen and Berken and followed by Matusz) to win his ML debut in 2009, the most by a team since the Chicago White Stockings had six pitchers do it in 1888... Made four straight Quality Starts (among eight total), July 3-26, pitching to a 2.45 ERA in his four starts that month (25.2IP, 7ER)... Went 1-8 with a 7.19 ERA (56.1IP, 45ER) in his final 12 starts after going 3-2 with a 3.20 ERA (45.0IP, 16ER) in his first eight games (seven starts)... Pitched 2.2 scoreless innings, striking out four, in his only relief appearance, June 6 @OAK... Pitched to a 3.12 ERA (57.2IP, 20ER) in 10 games (nine starts) in which he won (four) or did not earn a decision (six)... Held hitters to a .184 (16-87) average with runners in scoring position... Became the 862nd player to wear an Orioles uniform.

2009 TRIPLE-A HIGHLIGHTS: Went 3-2 with a 3.30 ERA (57.1IP, 21ER) in 11 starts for Triple-A Norfolk and made one start for Double-A Bowie (4.0IP, ER)... Earned first Triple-A victory on April 23 vs. Durham... Held opposing batters to a .206 average, with LH hitting .221 and RH hitting .185... Norfolk was 5-3 in his 8 starts, and the Tides averaged 3.9 runs a game when he was on the mound (8 starts, 31 runs)... Struck out a Tides' season-high 14 batters in 7.1 innings on May 22 vs. Rochester (struck out the first seven batters of that contest)... The 14 strikeouts were the most by a Tides pitcher in a game since Octavio Dotel matched the franchise record with 17 punchouts on May 27, 1999 (Dotel shares the record with Sid Fernandez, who struck out 17 on May 7, 1984 and May 2, 1985)... At the time of his promotion, ranked second in the IL and second among Orioles minor leaguers with 60 strikeouts.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

2008: Spent the season with Double-A Bowie, where he led the Eastern League in strikeouts (166), walks (71), strikeouts per nine innings (10.60) and was third in ERA (2.68)... His 166 strikeouts led all Orioles minor leaguers and ranked 2nd in all of minor league baseball... His 10.60 strikeouts per 9-IP ratio was the 4th-best among starting pitchers in the minor leagues... His 2.68 ERA was third-best among O's farmhands... Did not allow more than four earned runs in a game, and he allowed three earned runs or less in 25 of his 27 starts... Struck out at least seven batters in a game 11 times, including a season-high 11 in 5.0 innings on April 26 at New Hampshire... Named to the 2008 Eastern League Southern Division All-Star Team... Named the Organizational Pitcher of the Month for June, going 1-0 with a 2.16 ERA in five starts... Made 11 quality starts... Had a season-high 11 strikeouts on April 26... **2007:** Led the Carolina League with 168 strikeouts and in strikeouts per nine innings (10.48) and was second in games started (27)... Was named the Orioles Pitcher of the Month for April, going 2-2 with a 2.74 ERA and 29 strikeouts in 23.0 innings on the month... Set a Frederick franchise record when he struck out 18 batters in 9.0 innings of a no-decision on September 2 vs. Winston-Salem... The previous club record was 17 strikeouts (accomplished by Arthur Rhodes in 1990)... The 18 strikeouts were the most for any minor league pitcher in a game during the 2007 season... Earned the victory in his only playoff start, in Game 1 of the Mills Cup Championship Series over Salem on September 8... **2006:** Ranked fourth in the South Atlantic League with 154 strikeouts... Allowed four earned runs in 39.2 innings in his seven wins and pitched to a 5.37 ERA (105.2IP, 63ER) in his other 21 outings.
2005: Spent his first pro season at Class A Aberdeen and held right-handed hitters to a .193 average... Made his first four appearances in relief... Allowed two earned runs or fewer in six of his eight starts... Pitched six scoreless innings and allowed one hit while striking out a season-high 12 batters in his final start of the year, September 4 at Staten Island.

PERSONAL/MISC: David Jose Hernandez... Attended Cosumnes River (CA) College, where he set the single season record for strikeouts with 119 in 2005... Finished his career with the Hawks as the all-time strikeout leader (224) and was tied for the most career victories (20).

BIRD BITS & COMMUNITY NEWS

ORIOLES HALL OF FAME: On March 22, the Orioles announced that **RAY MILLER** and the late **JOHNNY OATES** have been elected to the Orioles Hall of Fame, with induction set for pre-game on Saturday, August 7 against the White Sox... **LEN JOHNSTON** was named this year's Herb Armstrong Award winner.

THANK YOU FANS IN SARASOTA: The Orioles announced that the club surpassed the 100,000 mark in attendance at their home spring training facility for the first time in team history... In the club's first spring in Sarasota the O's drew a total of 102,219 fans, an average of 6,815 fans per game, and a 39% increase from 2009, when the team played in Fort Lauderdale... This figure represents the largest increase in Major League Baseball this spring.

O's RADIO NETWORK EXPANDS TO 43 STATIONS WITH FIRST DELAWARE AFFILIATE: The Orioles announced the addition of WOSC 95.9 FM in Bethany Beach, DE to the team's radio network, the first affiliate in Delaware since 2001... The O's radio network reaches six states and the **District of Columbia** (1): **Maryland** (16), **Virginia** (14), **Pennsylvania** (6), **West Virginia** (3), **North Carolina** (2) and **Delaware** (1).

BIRD BATS

The O's have 13 position players on the active roster, 3 left-handed hitters, 8 right-handers and 2 switch hitters... Orioles batters were 5th in the AL with a .268 average & 8th with a .332 OBP last season... They were 2nd in the AL, batting .284 with RISP and 6th with a .302 average with the bases loaded... O's DHs were 5th in average (.260), T-6th in HR (25) & 10th in RBI (82)... Baltimore PHs hit .225 (20-89) in 2009.
