OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won eight games this season, which is tied for the Major League lead...have spent each of the past 10 days with at least a share of first place in the American League West...have won 12 of their past 13 games against the Orioles, including eight straight at the Coliseum...are 67-28 (.705) against Baltimore since the start of the 1999 season, the best winning percentage against the Orioles by any American League team over that span...are 2-0 on this 10-game homestand against the Baltimore Orioles (2-0), New York Yankees and Cleveland Indians.
- A's starting pitchers are 6-0 with a 2.48 ERA (20 er in 72.2 ip) this season...since 1982, the only other time A's starters won at least their first five decisions was 2003, when they began the season 6-0.
- Dallas Braden** is 5-1 with a 1.57 ERA (6 er in 34.1 ip) in six career appearances (five starts) against Baltimore...has five of his 16 career wins against the Orioles.
- Andrew Bailey** has converted each of his past 22 save opportunities, good for the second-longest streak in Oakland history.
- Ryan Sweeney** (1 for 4) has hit safely in each of his 11 games this season (.289, 13 for 45)...the hitting streak is tied for the longest in the majors this year, and is the longest season-opening mark by an Athletic since 2004 (Jermaine Dye, 13 games).

BALTIMORE NOTES

- The Baltimore Orioles have lost eight straight games...are off to their worst start since 1998, when they began 0-21...are 0-2 on this 10-game road trip against the Oakland Athletics (0-2), Seattle Mariners and Boston Red Sox.
- The Orioles are 1 for 38 (.026) with two outs and runners in scoring position this season.
- Kevin Millwood** had nine strikeouts, a season-high for Baltimore...is 6-4 with a 3.45 ERA (37 er in 96.2 ip) in 17 career starts against the A's...had won his last three decisions against Oakland since the start of the 2008 season.
- Nick Markakis** (2 for 4) has reached base in all 11 of Baltimore's games this season...is batting .243 (9 for 37).
