Baltimore Orioles (1-10) vs. Oakland Athletics (8-4)

RHP **Jeremy Guthrie** (0-2, 4.05) vs. RHP **Justin Duchscherer** (1-0, 3.46)

TODAY'S GAME: The Orioles and Athletics meet in game three of their four-game series and the third game of a 10-game road trip that includes visits to Seattle and Boston...The Birds are off to their worst start since the 1988 season, when they began 0-21...The Birds look to end an eight game losing skid since winning April 8 at Tampa Bay.

VS. OAKLAND: The Athletics lead the season series 2-0...The A's also won the season series in 2009, 5-1, as the Orioles were swept in three games in Oakland and won one of three in Baltimore...The Orioles have lost their last eight games in Oakland and have not won there since July 22, 2007, when **Jeremy Guthrie**, **Chad Bradford** and **Jamie Walker** combined on a two-hit shutout...The all-time series is now tied at 234, with the O's going 111-118 in Baltimore and 123-116 in Oakland.

ROSTER MOVE: The Orioles yesterday placed outfielder **Felix Pie** on the 15-day disabled list with an upper back muscle strain...OF **Lou Montanez** has been recalled from Triple-A Norfolk, where he was batting .259 (7-27) with five RBI in seven games...Montanez batted .319 (15-47) with three doubles and eight RBI in 20 spring training games for the O's...Montanez appeared in 29 games for the Orioles in 2009 but missed most of the season after tearing ligaments in his right thumb attempting a diving catch at Toronto on May 2...Montanez rejoined the Orioles on September 19.

GOLD GLOVES: Despite 3 errors in the last two games, the Orioles are tied for the fourth-highest fielding percentage in the major leagues (.987) as they have made just five miscues in 11 games...**All five AL East clubs are in the top half in all of baseball in fielding percentage: New York (3rd, .988), Baltimore (T-4th, .987), Tampa Bay (T-4th, .987), Boston (T-11th, .984) and Toronto (T-11th, .984).**

BROKEN BATS: Through 11 games, the Orioles are 1-for-38 (.026) with runners in scoring position and two outs, the lowest average in the majors...The O's are 10-for-78 (.128) with runners in scoring position and have left 79 runners on base (7.2 per game)...Baltimore batted .284 with RISP in 2009, finishing second in the A.L.

DOING THEIR PART: Orioles starting pitchers lead the AL in strikeouts (62) and trail only the Los Angeles Dodgers (64) in all of baseball...The starters are 22nd in the majors with a 4.86 ERA (13th in the AL) after being tied for 29th in the majors in 2009 (5.37, last in the AL)...They have walked just 17 batters, the third-lowest total in the big leagues and best in the AL...The 63.0 innings pitched are 11th in the majors and are 8th best in the AL after finishing last in the majors in 2009 (877.2 IP).

EARLY WORK: The Orioles have scored eight times in the first inning this year and just 23 runs in the other innings combined.

MAKE 'EM WORK: The Orioles are 28th in the major leagues in pitches seen per plate appearance (3.68)...**Nick Markakis** is 12th in the majors in pitches seen per plate appearance (4.46)...Opposing starting pitchers have pitched 6.0 innings or more nine times and pitched 7.0 innings or more in six of 11 games in 2010.

LATE INNING WOES: The Orioles have allowed at least one run in the 8th inning or later in nine of their 11 games this season...22 of their 59 runs allowed this year have scored in the 8th inning or later...Tuesday marked the fifth game this year in which the Birds gave up the tying or go-ahead runs in the final two frames.

A WALK IN THE PARK: **Nick Markakis** is tied for fourth in AL in walks (10)...Markakis did not draw a single walk in 63 spring training at-bats.

SPLITS: **Markakis** (.333; 8-for-24) and **Matt Wieters** (.364; 8-for-22) are hitting a combined .348 with the bases empty and .111 (Markakis - .077; 1-for-13 & Wieters - .143; 2-for-14) with men on base.

WEARING OUT THE BASEPATHS: **Matt Wieters** failed to reach base safely for the first time in his 10 games played on Friday night at Oakland...Wieters became the first catcher in Orioles history to open a season with three consecutive multi-hit games...Wieters is 10-for-36 (.278) with a homer, three runs, three RBI and five walks in 10 games.

THE RIFLEMEN: **Felix Pie** recorded his first outfield assist Monday night, throwing out **Jason Bartlett** at the plate...The Orioles have two outfield assists this year (both at the plate against the Rays) after leading the AL with 36 outfield assists in 2009...**Nick Markakis** recorded his 52nd career assist from the outfield on Opening Day...Since the start of the 2006 season, only **Alfonso Soriano** and **Jeff Francouer** (58 each) have more outfield assists than Markakis.

CLOSE CALLS: Six of the first 11 games have been decided by one or two runs...In 2009, 72 of the 162 games (44%) were decided by one or two runs with the O's going 29-43 in those games...The Birds were 17-22 in one-run games in '09...24 of the last 49 losses in '09 were by one or two runs.

SPRING TRAINING REPORT: The Orioles drew over 100,000 fans for the first time in franchise history in the Grapefruit League...The Birds went 12-17-1 during the exhibition schedule, including a 6-9 record at Ed Smith Stadium...**Nolan Reimold**'s .283 average led the club among players with 50 or more at-bats, despite starting the spring going 0-for-22 (went 15-31 after that)...**Adam Jones**' five home runs led the club and his 12 RBI tied him with **Luke Scott** for the team lead...**Brad Bergesen** led the team with three wins, while **Brian Matusz** allowed fewer combined hits (19) and walks (3) than innings pitched (24.1)...Non-roster invitee **Will Ohman** made the club by allowing just two hits and four walks in 8.2 innings (11 games).

TOMORROW'S STARTER: LH **Brian Matusz** makes his third start of the season and second road start...Both of Matusz' starts in 2010 have been come against Tampa Bay...He has walked six, including a career-high 5 in his first start of the season, and struck out 15 without allowing a home run...This will be his first start against Oakland, but Matusz is 1-1 with a 5.68 ERA and 11 K's in 12.2 IP in 2 career starts against AL West opponents (LAA & TEX).

QUICK HITS: O's have scored a total of four runs in his two starts (scored three while he was in the game)...Received two or fewer runs of support in 11 of his 33 starts in 2009...Led the AL in losses (17) and HR allowed (35) in 2009...Pitched in the 2009 World Baseball Classic for Team USA, going 0-2 with a 14.73 ERA in two games (one start)...Made his second career Opening Day start against the New York Yankees April 6, 2009 (also vs. Tampa Bay Rays in 2008)...Originally selected by the Cleveland Indians in the first round (22nd overall) in the 2002 draft out of Stanford University.

LAST START: Took the loss April 12 against Tampa Bay despite making another quality start (7.0IP, 3ER)...Has eight quality starts in 11 career outings against TB...Held RH batters to a 1-for-11 night...Allowed first HR of year to Reid Brignac.

OF LATE: Was the tough luck loser on April 7 at Tampa Bay as he was outdueled by Matt Garza (8.0IP, 2R/1ER)...Allowed three hits to RH batters in 14 at bats, but two of them drove in a total of three runs in the 4-3 loss...O's have scored a total of four runs in the two games he has started (scored three while he was in the game).

GUTHRIE VS. OAKLAND: In five career starts against Oakland, the Stanford University product is 1-3 with a 6.26 ERA (23.0IP, 16ER)...In three starts at McAfee Coliseum, Guthrie is 1-1 with a 6.75 ERA (13.1IP, 10ER).

SPRING TRAINING REPORT: Guthrie was 0-4 with a 7.40 ERA (20.2IP, 17ER) in six starts...He allowed 13 earned runs in his last 11.1 innings (over three starts).

2009 HIGHLIGHTS: Went 2-0 to begin the season (12.0IP, 3ER), winning on Opening Day vs. NYY, his 2nd career Opening Day start...Made 33 starts and reached the 200 innings pitched mark for the first time in his career...Became 5th Oriole pitcher in the 2000s to hit 200 IP plateau (Mussina-'00; Ponson-'00 & '04; Lopez-'05 and Cabrera-'07)...Tied a career-high with 10 wins and made 15 Quality Starts...Led the AL with 17 losses and 35 home runs allowed...Set career-highs in ERA (5.04), hits allowed (224), walks (60), losses (17), home runs (35) and earned runs (112)...Went 6.0 or more innings in 23 of his 33 starts...Struck out a team season-high 10 on May 30 vs. DET...Had a 2.22 ERA (65.0IP, 16ER) in his 10 victories and a 6.40 ERA (135.0IP, 96ER) in his other 23 starts...Went 2-1 with a 3.44 ERA (18.1IP, 7ER) in three Interleague starts...Pitched in the 2009 World Baseball Classic for Team USA in March, going 0-2 with a 14.73 ERA in two games (one start).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: 2008: Led team with 10 wins, 190.2 IP, 120 K and 12 losses...Finished 7th in the AL in batting average against (.242) and 8th in ERA in night games (3.50)...Threw his first career CG August 2 @SEA, allowing just one run on 4 hits and a walk while striking out 2 as he retired 26 of the final 28 batters faced in the game...Posted 19 quality starts, including 6 straight from May 13-June 7...10 of his 19 quality starts followed an O's loss and he allowed 2 or fewer earned runs in 17 of his 30 starts...The Orioles scored a total of 21 runs in the 12 games in which Guthrie was tagged with the loss...7 of Guthrie's 10 wins followed an O's loss...Threw at least 99 pitches in 22 of 30 starts...Made 9 starts in which he pitched 6.0 or more innings and allowed 2 or fewer runs without getting the win...Won 4 straight starts allowing just one run in each game before allowing 2 runs over 7.0 IP and losing vs. BOS August 18...According to *Elias*, over the last 30 seasons, the only other Orioles pitchers to win at least 4 consecutive starts and give up no more than one run in each game were Jimmy Key, who had a four-start streak in 1997, and Erik Bedard, who had a five-start streak in 2006 and a four-start streak in 2007...Was the Orioles' Opening Day starter, his first such assignment...**2007:** Was 2nd among AL rookies in ERA, strikeouts and innings pitched, 3rd in opponents batting average (.249) and tied for 3rd in wins and starts in his first year with the O's after being claimed off waivers from Cleveland on January 29...Picked up his first major league victory in relief on April 16 @TB...Earned a "Quality Start" in 10 straight outings in May and June as he worked at least 7.0 innings in 9 starts, pitching 6.1 innings in the other...**2006:** Started the season with 35.1 consecutive scoreless innings to start the AAA season...Pitched a complete game one-hitter on July 26 vs. Louisville, the hit coming with 2 outs in the 1st inning...Made his first major league start August 12 against KC (ND, 4.2IP, 5H, 4R/ER, 6BB, 5K)...**2005:** His team-high 12 wins for Buffalo were tied for 2nd in the IL...**2004:** Made his major league debut on the 28th vs. CWS...**2003:** Limited EL hitters to a .196 (44-224) average without allowing a HR in 62.2 IP...Tossed a CG 3-hitter at Norfolk on June 18 to pick up his first AAA win...**2002:** Signed a contract for 2003 on October 3 and made his debut in the Arizona Fall League.

PERSONAL/MISC: Married to the former Jenny Williams (6/20/01)...They have two kids; a daughter, Avery (3/2/04) and a son, Hudson (11/20/06)...Graduated in 1997 from Ashland (OR) HS, where he was named team MVP for football, basketball and baseball in his senior year, playing quarterback for the football team...Was class valedictorian...Attended BYU for his freshman year in 1997-98 before going on a 2-year Mormon mission to Spain, 1999-2000...Did not play baseball for two years before enrolling at Stanford in fall 2000...Speaks fluent Spanish...Was selected by the New York Mets in the 15th round of the 1997 draft and was selected in the 3rd round by the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2001, but opted to play in college both times...At Stanford in 2001, was named a 2nd team (*The Sporting News*) and 3rd team (*Baseball America*, NCBWA) All-American after leading the Cardinal in wins, going 13-4 with a 2.82 ERA...Was drafted by Cleveland in the first round (22nd overall pick) of the 2002 draft after his junior season at Stanford, in which he went 13-2 with a 2.51 ERA in 157.2 innings and 20 starts...Was named the 2002 PAC-10 Pitcher of the Year, a finalist for the 2002 Golden Spikes Award and was NCAA Regional MVP...In his two seasons at Stanford, went 26-6 with a 2.65 ERA while striking out 264 batters in 291.2 innings...Set the single-season school record for innings pitched in 2002 (157.2IP)...Was a 2-time collegiate All-America selection...Was rated by *Baseball America* as the 11th best overall prospect entering the 2002 draft.

BIRD BITS & COMMUNITY NEWS

ORIOLES HALL OF FAME: On March 22, the Orioles announced that **RAY MILLER** and the late **JOHNNY OATES** have been elected to the Orioles Hall of Fame, with induction set for pre-game on Saturday, August 7 against the White Sox... **LEN JOHNSTON** was named this year's Herb Armstrong Award winner.

THANK YOU FANS IN SARASOTA: The Orioles announced that the club surpassed the 100,000 mark in attendance at their home spring training facility for the first time in team history... In the club's first spring in Sarasota the O's drew a total of 102,219 fans, an average of 6,815 fans per game, and a 39% increase from 2009, when the team played in Fort Lauderdale... This figure represents the largest increase in Major League Baseball this spring.

O's RADIO NETWORK EXPANDS TO 43 STATIONS WITH FIRST DELAWARE AFFILIATE: The Orioles announced the addition of WOSC 95.9 FM in Bethany Beach, DE to the team's radio network, the first affiliate in Delaware since 2001... The O's radio network reaches six states and the **District of Columbia** (1): **Maryland** (16), **Virginia** (14), **Pennsylvania** (6), **West Virginia** (3), **North Carolina** (2) and **Delaware** (1).

BIRD BATS

The O's have 13 position players on the active roster, 3 left-handed hitters, 8 right-handers and 2 switch hitters... Orioles batters were 5th in the AL with a .268 average & 8th with a .332 OBP last season... They were 2nd in the AL, batting .284 with RISP and 6th with a .302 average with the bases loaded... O's DHs were 5th in average (.260), T-6th in HR (25) & 10th in RBI (82)... Baltimore PHs hit .225 (20-89) in 2009.
