#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics had their three-game winning streak snapped...allowed a season-high eight runs...had their nine-game winning streak against the Orioles at the Coliseum snapped (last loss: July 22, 2007)...are 3-1 on this 10-game homestand against Baltimore (3-1), New York (three games) and Cleveland (three games).
- Brett Anderson** had his scoreless innings streak snapped at 14.0 innings after allowing three runs in the third inning...the streak was the third longest season-opening streak by a starter in Oakland history...was charged with the first loss by an Oakland starting pitcher this season and A's starters are now 6-1 with a 2.66 ERA (25 er in 84.2 ip) this season.
- Kevin Kouzmanoff** (1 for 4) snapped a 0 for 9 hitless streak with a sixth-inning RBI double.
- Ryan Sweeney** (1 for 3, r, bb) has hit safely in each of his 13 games this season and is batting .320 (16 for 50) during this streak...the hitting streak is tied for the second-longest season-opening streak in Oakland history (also, Jermaine Dye, 2004, and Carney Lansford, 1987).
- Michael Wuertz** made a rehab appearance today at Triple-A Sacramento...allowed two hits, walked one and struck out one in 1.0 inning (23 pitches, 12 strikes).

#### BALTIMORE NOTES

- The Baltimore Orioles snapped a nine-game losing streak, recording just their second win of the season (also, April 8 at TB)...defeated the A's for the first time since August 11, 2009 and the first time in Oakland since July 22, 2007...are 1-3 on this 10-game road trip through Oakland (1-3), Seattle (three games) and Boston (three games).
- The Orioles tied a season-high with eight runs...went 3 for 7 with two outs and runners in scoring position and are now 5 for 51 (.098) in those situations.
- Brian Matusz** tied a career-high with eight strikeouts (third time, last: April 13 vs. TB)...extended his winning streak to a career-high six games and has posted a 3.96 ERA (22 er in 50 ip) over eight games during this span.
- Nick Markakis** (2 for 4, 1 r, 1 rbi) has reached base safely via hit or walk in all 13 of Baltimore's games this season.
- Ty Wigginton** (2 for 4, 3 r, 1 hr, 4 rbi) has hit four of Baltimore's past six home runs.
