Baltimore Orioles (1-11) vs. Oakland Athletics (9-4)

LHP **Brian Matusz** (1-0, 4.38) vs. LHP **Brett Anderson** (1-0, 0.00)

TODAY'S GAME: The Orioles and Athletics meet in game four of their four-game series and the fourth game of a 10-game road trip that includes visits to Seattle and Boston...Baltimore looks to avoid being swept by the A's, something that has not happened in a 4-game set between the teams in Oakland since August 23-26, 2004...The Birds are off to their worst start since the 1988 season, when they began 0-21...The Birds look to end a nine game losing skid (23 runs scored in that stretch, average of 2.56) since winning April 8 at Tampa Bay.

ABOUT YESTERDAY: **Jeremy Guthrie** has not allowed a 1st inning run this season after posting a 7.99 ERA (32.2IP, 29ER) in the opening frame in 2009...**Matt Wieters** snapped an 0-for-14 streak with a 4th inning single...A's RHP Justin Duchscherer went 5.2 innings, only the third time in 12 games the opposing starter failed to go 6.0 or more innings against the O's...Before Saturday's game, 7 consecutive starters had gone 6.0+ against the O's, with Brandon Morrow (TOR, April 9 - 5.0IP) the last starter failing to do so...**Miguel Tejada** tied his season-high with 3 hits (also April 9 vs. TOR) before leaving with a mild groin strain; he is day-to-day...Going ahead 3-2 in the top of the 8th gave the Orioles their first lead since they were up 3-0 on Tampa Bay in the 7th inning on April 13, a total of 37 innings.

VS. OAKLAND: The Athletics lead the season series 3-0...The A's also won the season series in 2009, 5-1, as the Orioles were swept in three games in Oakland and won one of three in Baltimore...The Orioles have lost their last nine games in Oakland and have not won there since July 22, 2007, when **Jeremy Guthrie**, **Chad Bradford** and **Jamie Walker** combined on a two-hit shutout...Oakland now leads the all-time series, 235-234, with the O's going 111-118 in Baltimore and 123-117 in Oakland.

THE BIG MAN: **Mark Hendrickson** has allowed the lowest opponents batting average (.125; 3-for-24) among AL relievers (min. 20 at-bats).

ROSTER MOVE: The Orioles yesterday placed outfielder **Felix Pie** on the 15-day disabled list with an upper back muscle strain...OF **Lou Montanez** has been recalled from Triple-A Norfolk, where he was batting .259 (7-27) with five RBI in seven games...Montanez batted .319 (15-47) with 8 RBI in 20 spring games for the O's.

BROKEN BATS: Through 12 games, the Orioles are 2-for-44 (.045) with runners in scoring position and two outs, the lowest average in the majors...**Garrett Atkins'** 2-out, 2 RBI single to tie the game in the 6th was the 2nd 2-out hit with RISP of the season for the O's, with the other being Roberts' infield single in the top of the 5th inning on April 8 at Tampa Bay...The O's are 11-for-87 (.126) with runners in scoring position and have left 88 runners on base (7.3 per game)...Baltimore batted .284 with RISP in 2009, finishing second in the A.L.

DOING THEIR PART: Orioles starting pitchers lead the AL in strikeouts (65) and trail only the Los Angeles Dodgers (67) in all of baseball...They have walked just 18 batters, tied for the fewest in the big leagues and the best overall in the AL...The 69.2 innings pitched are 11th in the majors and are 8th best in the AL after finishing last in the majors in 2009 (877.2 IP).

EARLY WORK: The Orioles have scored eight times in the first inning this year and just 26 runs in the other innings combined.

MAKE 'EM WORK: The Orioles are 28th in the major leagues in pitches seen per plate appearance (3.68)...**Nick Markakis** is 15th in the majors in pitches seen per plate appearance (4.43)...Opposing starting pitchers have pitched 6.0 innings or more nine times and pitched 7.0 innings or more in six of 12 games in 2010.

LATE INNING WOES: The Orioles have allowed at least one run in the 8th inning or later in 10 of their 12 games this season...24 of their 63 runs allowed this year have scored in the 8th inning or later...Saturday marked the sixth game this year in which the Birds gave up the tying or go-ahead runs in the final two frames.

A WALK IN THE PARK: **Nick Markakis** is tied for fourth in AL in walks (11)...Markakis did not draw a single walk in 63 spring training at-bats.

WEARING OUT THE BASEPATHS: **Markakis** has reached base safely in all 12 games this season...**Matt Wieters** failed to reach base safely for the first time in his 10 games played on Friday night at Oakland, and has reached in 10 of 11 games played...He became the first catcher in Orioles history to open a season with three consecutive multi-hit games.

THE RIFLEMEN: **Felix Pie** recorded his first outfield assist Monday night, throwing out **Jason Bartlett** at the plate...The Orioles have two outfield assists this year (both at the plate against the Rays) after leading the AL with 36 outfield assists in 2009...**Nick Markakis** recorded his 52nd career assist from the outfield on Opening Day...Since the start of the 2006 season, only **Alfonso Soriano** and **Jeff Francouer** (58 each) have more outfield assists than Markakis.

CLOSE CALLS: Seven of the first 12 games have been decided by one or two runs...In 2009, 72 of the 162 games (44%) were decided by one or two runs with the O's going 29-43 in those games...The Birds were 17-22 in one-run games in '09...24 of the last 49 losses in '09 were by one or two runs.

SPRING TRAINING REPORT: The Orioles drew over 100,000 fans for the first time in franchise history in the Grapefruit League...The Birds went 12-17-1 during the exhibition schedule, including a 6-9 record at Ed Smith Stadium...**Nolan Reimold's** .283 average led the club among players with 50 or more at-bats, despite starting the spring going 0-for-22 (went 15-31 after that)...**Adam Jones'** five home runs led the club and his 12 RBI tied him with **Luke Scott** for the team lead...**Brad Bergesen** led the team with three wins, while **Brian Matusz** allowed fewer combined hits (19) and walks (3) than innings pitched (24.1)...Non-roster invitee **Will Ohman** made the club by allowing just two hits and four walks in 8.2 innings (11 games).

TOMORROW'S STARTER: **RH Brad Bergesen** makes his third start of the season and first road start...In two starts this season, Bergesen is 0-1 with an 11.74 ERA (7.2IP, 10ER)...In three starts against the Mariners last season, Bergesen went 1-1 with a 2.14 ERA (21.0IP, 5ER), 7 walks & 13 strikeouts...He registered 3 Quality Starts against Seattle and was 0-1 with a 3.46 ERA (13.0IP, 5ER) in 2 starts at Safeco.

QUICK HITS: Last name is pronounced MAT-iss...**Opponents are batting just .190 against him (8-42) with no extra-base hits...**Is making his 11th major league start...**Is riding a career-high five game winning streak...**Matched his career-high in strikeouts April 13 vs. Tampa Bay (also August 30 vs. CLE)...Is in his second professional season...Did not lose a game from May 8, 2009 (in the Carolina League) until August 9, 2009 when he was beaten by **Roy Halladay** in Toronto...Was 11-2 with a 1.99 ERA (113.0IP, 25ER) in 19 career minor league games...Made 12 quality starts out of 19 starts in the minor leagues (one was shortened to one inning due to his promotion)...Was the fifth player from the 2008 draft to reach the big leagues, following **Gordon Beckham, Conor Gillaspie, Ryan Perry** and **Daniel Schlereth**...Attended the University of San Diego, where he was a two-time finalist for the Golden Spikes Award and led the NCAA in strikeouts with 141 in 2008.

LAST START: Allowed a bunt single and a check-swing infield single through seven innings against Tampa Bay April 13 before allowing four singles in the eighth (all scored)...Tied his career-high with eight strikeouts...O's scored twice in eighth to tie it but lost in 10 innings.

OF LATE: In his first start of 2010, April 8 at Tampa Bay, Matusz battled control issues, walking a career-high five batters, including the two runners that scored (the three walks in the third inning alone tied his career-high)...Matusz struck out seven, including the last three batters he faced and held the heart of the Rays lineup (Crawford, Zobrist, Longoria, Pena and Upton) a combined 1-for-8 with two walks...Picked off two runners in his first outing...In second start, allowed six singles (two through seven innings) and tied his career high with eight strikeouts.

LIFETIME VS. OAKLAND: Matusz has never faced the Athletics.

SPRING TRAINING REPORT: Went 1-2 with a 2.59 ERA (24.1IP,7ER) in six starts and allowed fewer combined hits (19) and walks (3) than innings pitched (24.1).

2009 HIGHLIGHTS: Spent time with Class-A Frederick, Double-A Bowie and the Orioles (recalled on August 4) in his first professional season...Became fifth of five O's rookie pitchers to win their major league debut in 2009 (also Uehara, Bergesen, Berken and Hernandez), the most by a team since the Chicago White Stockings had six pitchers do it in 1888...Won the Jim Palmer Award for the best pitcher in the Orioles' minor league system...Was named Orioles Organizational Pitcher of the Month for June and July...Pitched 5.0 innings, allowing one earned run to earn the win in his debut, August 4 @DET...Recorded first major league strikeout in the 2nd inning, getting Miguel Cabrera swinging to lead off the inning...Pitched to a 3.12 ERA (26.0IP, 9ER) in his final four starts, going 3-0 with 18 strikeouts and six walks...Finished the season with a four-game winning streak and pitched 7.0 innings in each of his final three starts...Held lefties to a .200 average (7-35)...Did not allow a hit with a runner on third and two outs in eight plate appearances against (0-for-7 with a walk allowed)...Made 12 quality starts out of 19 starts in the minor leagues (one was shortened to one inning due to his promotion)...Was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week with Double-A Bowie, July 6-12 (8.0IP,1H,11K)...Went 7-0 with a 1.55 ERA in eight starts with the Baysox before being called up to Baltimore on August 4...Was named to the 2009 Carolina League All-Star Team with Single-A Frederick, but was promoted to Bowie before the game...Was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week, May 25-31 (1-0,2GS,0ER)...Pitched in MLB Future's Game for Team USA on July 12 in St. Louis (1.0IP, H, ER, BB)...Named the Orioles' #1 prospect by *Baseball America* after the season.

2009 HIGHLIGHTS AT DOUBLE-A BOWIE: Was unbeaten in seven starts and was pulled from his eighth start after one inning when the Orioles decided to promote him for his major league debut...Allowed one hit in eight innings while striking out 11 without walking a batter July 7 vs. Harrisburg...Threw a seven-inning shutout against Akron July 2...Made Double-A debut against Reading June 17...Five of his eight starts at Bowie were quality starts with one of the outings being just one inning due to his promotion.

2009 HIGHLIGHTS AT HIGH-A FREDERICK: Did not allow a run in his last 23.0 innings of work over four starts from May 20-June 5 before his promotion to Bowie...Struck out a career-high 13 against Wilmington on May 8...Notched first pro win April 14 against Myrtle Beach...Seven of his 10 starts for Frederick were quality starts.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: 2008: Made his pro debut with the Surprise Rafters in the Arizona Fall League, where he went 2-4 with a 4.73 ERA (26.2IP, 14ER) in seven games (six starts) and recorded 31 strikeouts and seven walks in 26.2 innings...Was selected to play in the AFL's Rising Stars Showcase...Was named both the Orioles' and Arizona Fall League's #3 prospect by *Baseball America* after the season.

COLLEGIATE CAREER: In three seasons at the University of San Diego, went 26-8 with a 2.94 ERA (317.0IP, 101ER) in 48 games (45 starts) with school record 397 strikeouts...Was a two-time finalist for the Golden Spikes Award, given to the best amateur baseball player in the nation; a 2008 finalist for the Roger Clemens Award; a Louisville Slugger first-team All-American and a 2007 member of the USA Baseball National Team...Led the Toreros to a program-best No. 4 national ranking in 2007 and is the highest draft pick in school history...**2008:** Went 12-2 with a 1.71 ERA (105.0IP, 20ER) and an NCAA-leading 141 strikeouts...Tied the school's single-game record with 17 strikeouts in a victory over Harvard on March 22...Was named the West Coast Conference Pitcher of the Year after leading the NCAA in strikeouts...**2007:** Named to the Wallace Award Watch list for the best collegiate player in the nation...Was named to the Roger Clemens Award Watch list vying for the nation's best collegiate pitcher...Was a finalist for the Golden Spikes Award for the Nation's best Collegiate Player...Helped team win the WCC regular-season Championship...Named first-team All-WCC...Named National Pitcher of the Week twice...Named WCC Pitcher of the Month once...Named first-team All-American by the NCBWA...Was named second-team All-American by *Collegiate Baseball*...Played for Team USA during the summer of 2007...**2006:** Made 15 appearances (13 starts) and posted a 4-3 record with an ERA of 4.25...Rivals.com named him a second-team Freshman All-American...Was also named a Freshman All-American by *Collegiate Baseball*...Was named to *Baseball America's* All-Freshman team.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Earned two varsity letters in baseball at St. Mary's High (AZ)...Posted an 8-1 record with an ERA of 0.50 as a senior en route to earning the state of Arizona Player of the Year award along with a *Baseball America* All-America distinction...Was drafted in the fourth round of the 2005 Major League Baseball draft by the Angels...Was named first-team All-State as a junior after posting a 8-2 record with an ERA of 0.95.

BIRD BITS & COMMUNITY NEWS

ORIOLES HALL OF FAME: On March 22, the Orioles announced that **RAY MILLER** and the late **JOHNNY OATES** have been elected to the Orioles Hall of Fame, with induction set for pre-game on Saturday, August 7 against the White Sox...**LEN JOHNSTON** was named this year's Herb Armstrong Award winner.

THANK YOU FANS IN SARASOTA: The Orioles announced that the club surpassed the 100,000 mark in attendance at their home spring training facility for the first time in team history...In the club's first spring in Sarasota the O's drew a total of 102,219 fans, an average of 6,815 fans per game, and a 39% increase from 2009, when the team played in Fort Lauderdale...This figure represents the largest increase in Major League Baseball this spring.

O's RADIO NETWORK EXPANDS TO 43 STATIONS WITH FIRST DELAWARE AFFILIATE: The Orioles announced the addition of WOSC 95.9 FM in Bethany Beach, DE to the team's radio network, the first affiliate in Delaware since 2001...The O's radio network reaches six states and the **District of Columbia** (1): **Maryland** (16), **Virginia** (14), **Pennsylvania** (6), **West Virginia** (3), **North Carolina** (2) and **Delaware** (1).

BIRD BATS

The O's have 13 position players on the active roster, 2 left-handed hitters, 9 right-handers and 2 switch hitters...Orioles batters were 5th in the AL with a .268 average & 8th with a .332 OBP last season...They were 2nd in the AL, batting .284 with RISP and 6th with a .302 average with the bases loaded...O's DHs were 5th in average (.260), T-6th in HR (25) & 10th in RBI (82)...Baltimore PHs hit .225 (20-89) in 2009.
