OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost 13 of their past 16 against the Yankees...are 3-2 on this 10-game homestand against Baltimore (3-1), New York (0-1) and Cleveland (three games).
- Daric Barton (1 for 2, 2 bb) has reached base safely via a hit, walk or hit by pitch in 14 of his 15 games.
- Kurt Suzuki (2 for 4, 1 r, 2 rbi) has an 11-game hitting streak against New York dating back to July 18, 2008 (.426, 20 for 47)...is a .403 career hitter (25 for 62) against the Yankees, his best against any American League team.
- Ryan Sweeney (0 for 3, bb) had his 13-game hitting streak snapped and is now batting .302 (16 for 53) in 14 games...the hitting streak matched a career-high and is tied for the second-longest season-opening streak in Oakland history (record: Stan Javier, 17, in 1994).

NEW YORK NOTES

- The New York Yankees are on a season-high five-game winning streak and have won eight of their past nine...are 8-0 when leading after six innings...are 1-0 on this nine-game road trip through Oakland (1-0), Los Angeles (three games) and Texas (three games).
- The Yankees have not committed an error in their past 11 games...it is the longest April errorless streak in franchise history.
- Derek Jeter (0 for 5) had his 11-game hitting streak to start the season snapped and is now hitting .345 (19 for 55) through 12 games...is a career .311 hitter (159 for 512) against the A's...has a .358 average (86 for 240) at the Coliseum.
- Alex Rodriguez (1 for 1, 2 r, 3 bb) hit his 585th career home run...is one homer away from tying Frank Robinson for seventh place on the all-time list.
