OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are on a three-game losing streak and are 3-5 in their past eight after starting the season 6-2...have lost 14 of their past 17 against the Yankees over the last three years...are 3-3 on this 10-game homestand against Baltimore (3-1), New York (0-2) and Cleveland (three games).
- Ben Sheets** is now 1-1 with a 1.38 ERA (2 er in 13 ip) in two career starts against the Yankees.
- Kurt Suzuki** (0 for 3, hbp) had his 11-game hitting streak against New York snapped and is now batting .400 (20 for 50) in his past 12 games against the Yankees...is a career .385 hitter (25 for 65) against New York, his best against any American League team.
- Ryan Sweeney** (1 for 4) has reached base in each of his 15 games this season.

NEW YORK NOTES

- The New York Yankees are on a season-high six-game winning streak and have won nine of their past 10...have now matched the 1926 Yankees all-time franchise record by winning each of their first five series of the season... are 9-0 when leading after six innings...are 2-0 on this nine-game road trip through Oakland (2-0), Los Angeles (three games) and Texas (three games).
- New York has not committed an error in their past 12 games...it is the longest single-season April errorless streak in American League history.
- Phil Hughes** took a no-hitter into the eighth inning...was broken up with a leadoff single by Eric Chavez...recorded a career-high 10 strikeouts (previous: 9, May 20, 2009 at BAL).
- Derek Jeter** (1 for 4, bb) has hit safely in 12 of his past 13 games and is batting .339 (20 for 59) over that span...is a career .311 hitter (160 for 516) against the A's...has a .357 average (87 for 244) at the Coliseum.
- Alex Rodriguez** (2 for 4, 1 r, 1 3b) has reached base in 16 of his past 24 plate appearances.
- Mariano Rivera** has converted 62 of his past 66 save opportunities.
