OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics recorded their second shutout of the season (April 12 at SEA)...have won each of their past six against Cleveland, which is their longest winning streak against the Indians since July 31, 2002-April 27, 2003 when they won eight straight...have won 12 of the last 14 games between the two clubs in Oakland... have their best record after 18 games since the 1992 club started the season 12-6...are 5-3 on this 10-game homestand against Baltimore (3-1), New York (1-2) and Cleveland (1-0).
- The A's turned five double plays for the first time since June 5, 2007 vs. Boston...all five were grounded into double plays, marking the first time Oakland pitchers have induced five GIDPs since April 21, 2004 at Seattle.
- Justin Duchscherer** is 2-3 with a 2.77 ERA (8 er in 26.0 ip) in 12 career appearances (three starts) against Cleveland...is 2-1 with a 1.20 ERA (2 er in 15.0 ip) in six games (two starts) against the Indians in Oakland...A's starting pitchers have allowed three runs or less in 15 of 18 games this year and are 8-3 with a 2.90 ERA (34 er in 105.2 ip) for the season.
- Eric Chavez** (0 for 3, 1 r, 1 bb) is 0 for his last 17 with runners in scoring position and has not had a hit with RISP since June 20, 2008.
- Rajai Davis** (1 for 5, 1 r, 1 2b, 3 rbi) has hit safely in all nine of his career games against the Indians in which he has an at-bat...is batting .353 (12 for 34) in 11 games overall against Cleveland.
- Ryan Sweeney** (3 for 5, 2 r, 2 rbi) has reached base in each of his 17 games this season, which is the second-longest reaching base streak of his career (23, August 30-September 26, 2009)...is a career .400 hitter against the Indians (14 for 35).

CLEVELAND NOTES

- The Cleveland Indians were shut out for the third time this season (last: April 21 at MIN)...are now 3-7 on the road this year and have lost 22 of their last 25 road games dating back to last year...are 1-3 on this nine-game road trip through Minnesota (1-2), Oakland (0-1) and Los Angeles (three games).
- The Indians hit into five double plays, their most since hitting into six against Chicago on Aug. 7, 2009.
- Jake Westbrook** has not won a game since April 8, 2008...is 5-6 with a 4.08 ERA (37 er in 81.2 ip) in 14 career games against Oakland (13 starts).
- Asdrubal Cabrera** (1 for 4) has hit safely in each of his past eight games and is batting .375 (12 for 32) over that span.
- Shin-Soo Choo** (1 for 4) has a hit in nine of past 11 games and is hitting .368 (14 for 38) with four home runs and 12 RBI during that stretch...has reached base safely in 20 of his past 42 plate appearances.
- Travis Hafner** (0 for 1, 2 bb) has reached base safely in all 15 games in which he has played this season.
