Series is part of a 3city, 9-game roadtrip to Minnesota, Oakland and the LA Angels.... Are 1-2 on the trip...Just concluded a 3-game weekend series sweep of the Chicago White

Sox in Progressive Field... Seroes was part of a 6-game homestand against the Rangers and Chicago White Sox (went 3-3 on h-stand)....Just finished a 6game roadtrip to Chicago and Detroit to begin the 2010 season at **2-4** (swept @DET) ... Started year 2-1 marking first time the Tribe was above the .500 since the end of 2008...The Indians were never at or above .500 last year after starting the year at 0-5 and 1-7... *Indians lost 16 straight road games from August 30, 2009- April 5, 2010 (Club Record*) ...Indians are coming off a tremendous spring where they compiled a record of 19-9-3 (.679), the best record in the Cactus League...Also led the American League in spring ERA at 3.96...**SHIN-SOO CHOO** was T7th in the AL in RBI (16), 9th in average (.393), 7th in slugging % (.696) and 9th in total bases (39).

JAKE WESTBROOK ... Is making his 4th start and appearance of the season tonight vs. the Oakland Athletics in the Oakland Coliseum, his 3rd start on the road and his 1st start against the Athletics this year...It is his 13th start and 14th appearance in his career against the Athletics...

The 30-year-old was acquired from the New York Yankees on July 25, 2000 along with **RHP ZACH DAY** to complete the June 29, 2000 trade that sent **OF DAVID JUSTICE** to the New York Yankees in exchange for **OF RICKY LEDEE** and two players to be named.

GIDP Induced, MLB, 2004-2007 JAKE WESTBROOK, CLE Mark Buehrle, CWS 103 Brandon Webb, ARI 101 Carlos Silva, MIN 100 Derek Lowe, BOS-LAD 99

The Danielsville, GA native began his pro career in 1996 after being selected out of Madison County High School w/the 21st overall pick in the first round by the Colorado Rockies...Spent 2 seasons in the Rockies system ('96-97) before being traded in a 3-player deal to the Montreal Expos...Spent the 1998-99 seasons in the Expos system before being shipped to New York. The 2004 All-Star won a combined 44 games and topped the 200.0 inning mark in each of the three seasons (2004-06) with the Tribe... Finished the 2004 season with the 3rd lowest ERA (3.38) in the AL ... Jake is one of just four AL pitchers to post at least 14 wins in each season between 2004-2006...In 2006 won 15 games for 2nd straight season and led MLB pitchers in total chances in both 2005-06. Signed a 3-year contract extension thru the 2010 season on April 13, 2007...Was limited to just 5 starts in 2008 and did not

appear at the big league level in 2009 due to reconstructive surgery on his right elbow in June of 2008...Last win was April 8, 2008.

LAST YEAR ... Season was limited to just 3 minor league rehab starts as he rehabbed from June 2008 reconstructive right elbow surgery followed by elbow/forearm tightness during his rehab that ended his season before it began... Rehabbed in Goodyear, AZ in spring training and over the first two months of the regular season before making 2 rehab starts at AA Akron on June 6 & 12 (7.0IP, 4H, 0R)... Was shut down from throwing for 3 weeks before resuming rehab and made 1 more start on Akron on August 4 before more soreness in the elbow region and was ordered not to throw for 6 weeks, ending his season... Began rehabbing again in October 2009 and made 4 starts for Ponce in the Puerto Rican Winter League beginning November 28 in which he tossed a total of 13.1 innings...

SECOND OPENING GO AROUND ... Jake made his second career opening day start Monday, April 5 in the exact location of his first opening day assignment on April 4, 2005 against these White Sox...In the 2005 game, won by Chicago, 1-0, Jake tossed a complete game and was the tough-luck loser to Mark Buehrle in a game that took just 1:51 to play...CG, 8.0IP, 4H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 3K...

THIS SPRING ... Went 2-0 w/a 4.86 ERA in 5 spring starts (16.2IP, 19H, 9ER, 2HR, 9BB, 11K) and limited spring hitters to a .297 (19-64) average against...Best start of the spring came on March 16 vs. SF (4.0IP, 2H, 1R/ER, 1K)...Worked 6.0IP (91 pitches) in final minor league start on March 31.

Did not receive a decision despite tossing 8.0 innings and allowing 2 runs on April 12 in the Indians home opener, a 4-2 loss to the Texas Rangers in Progressive Field... 8.0IP, 5H, 2R/ER, 4BB, 4K... Improved to 2-0 on April 18 in a 7-4 win over the White Sox in Progressive Field... 6.0IP, 6H, 3R/ER, 2BB, 4K... So far this year is 2-0 w/a 3.60 ERA (20.0IP, 12H, 8R/ER, 12BB, 9K) in 3 starts... Has limited hitters to a .176 avg against, 7th best in the American League...Was impressive this spring, going 3-0 w/a 1.38 ERA in 5G/4GS (26.0IP, 15H, 4ER, 2BB, 12K)...Limited spring hitters to a .169 avg against (15-89) w/0HR allowed...Was 3rd in the AL in spring ERA and T5th in innings pitched and wins...
