## OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 5-6 over the last 11 games after starting 6-2...had their six-game winning streak against Cleveland snapped, which was their longest winning streak against the Indians since July 31, 2002-April 27, 2003 when they won eight straight...are 5-4 on this 10-game homestand against Baltimore (3-1), New York (1-2) and Cleveland (1-1).
- Brett Anderson left the game after six innings with tightness in his left elbow...is 9-5 with a 2.85 ERA (41 er in 129.1 ip) over his past 21 starts after starting his career 3-7 with a 5.74 ERA in his first 13 starts...is 1-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1 er in 12.0 ip) in two career starts against Cleveland...A's starting pitchers have allowed three runs or less in 16 of 19 games this year and are 8-3 with a 2.82 ERA (35 er in 111.2 ip) for the season.
- Rajai Davis (1 for 4) has hit safely in all 10 of his career games against the Indians in which he has an at-bat...is batting .342 (13 for 38) in 12 games overall against Cleveland.
- Ryan Sweeney (1 for 4) has reached base in each of his 18 games this season, which is the second-longest reaching base streak of his career (23, August 30-September 26, 2009)...has now reached base in 41 of his past 42 games dating back to August 30 of last year and is batting .335 (54 for 161) over that span...is a career .385 hitter against the Indians (15 for 39).
- Kurt Suzuki was scratched from the lineup with soreness in his left side.

- The Cleveland Indians improve to 4-7 on the road this year, though they have lost 22 of their last 26 road games dating back to last year...are 2-3 on this nine-game road trip through Minnesota (1-2), Oakland (1-1) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Asdrubal Cabrera (0 for 3) had his eight-game hitting streak snapped and is now batting .343 (12 for 35) over his past nine games.
- Shin-Soo Choo (2 for 4, ibb) has a hit in 10 of past 12 games and is hitting .381 (16 for 42) during that stretch...has reached base safely in 22 of his past 46 plate appearances.
- Travis Hafner (0 for 4, bb) has reached base safely in all 16 games in which he has played this season.
