TRIBE AT A GLANCE: The Indians will resume 3-game set with the Oakland Athletics today at 1:07PM ET in the Oakland Coliseum... Series is part of a 3-city, 9-game roadtrip to Minnesota, Oakland and the LA Angels.... **Are 1-3 on the trip (lost 2 of 3 in MIN)**...Just concluded a 3-game weekend series sweep of the Chicago White Sox in Progressive Field... Series was part of a 6-game homestand against the Rangers and Chicago White Sox (went **3-3** on h-stand)...Just finished a 6-game roadtrip to Chicago and Detroit to begin the 2010 season at **2-4 (swept @DET)** ... Started year 2-1 marking first time the Tribe was above the .500 since the end of 2008...The Indians were never at or above .500 last year after starting the year at 0-5 and 1-7... **Indians lost 16 straight road games from August 30, 2009- April 5, 2010 (Club Record)** ...Indians are coming off a tremendous spring where they compiled a record of 19-9-3 (.679), the best record in the Cactus League...Also led the American League in spring ERA at 3.96... **SHIN-SOO CHOO** was T7th in the AL in RBI (16), 9th in average (.393), 7th in slugging % (.696) and 9th in total bases (39).

TRIBE TO WMMS: Due to conflicts with the Cleveland Cavs playoff games, the Indians games on Sunday, April 25th & Tuesday, April 27th will be broadcast on **WMMS 100.7FM** instead of **NewsRadio WTAM 1100AM**.

ABRA CABRERA: Indians **SS ASDRUBAL CABRERA** has hit safely in each of his last 8-games batting .375 (12-32) with 6 runs scored, 4 doubles, a HR and 2RBI... Cabrera has a team-leading 6 multi hit games (T10th in AL) and has hit safely in 13 of his 15 games so far.

CHOO AL PLAYER OF WEEK: Monday, **OF SHIN SOO CHOO** was named the **AL Player of the Week** for the 1st time in his career... In 6G last week he hit .579 (11-19) w/ 5RS, 3 2B, 3HR & 11RBI... He also led MLB w/ 1.211 SLG % & a .680 OBP... Sunday he belted his 2nd career grand slam... **Choo has currently hit in 9 of this last 11 games batting .368 (14-38) w/ 4HR & 12RBI... He ranks 12th in AL in OBP (.420), T12th in RBI (12), 13th in slg % (.554), T7th in BB (12) & T15th in SB (3).**

ROAD WOES: Dating back to last year, the Indians have lost 22 of their last 25 games on the road... From August 30, 2009 at Baltimore (last 15G of 2009) through April 5 of this year Tribe lost a club record 16 straight road games... Indians are now 3-7 on the road this year and have lost 6 of their last 7 road games.

DOING THEIR PART: Indians pitching staff owns a 3.65 ERA thus far, 6th best in the American League...**Have allowed 121 hits, 2nd fewest in the AL**... Indians starters have gone 6.0 or more innings in 9 of last 11 games and 10 of 16 games this year... **Starters own a 3.00 ERA (66.0IP, 22ER) over the last 10 games and a 3.59 ERA on the year (6th best in AL)**... Tribe starters own 2 of the 8 complete games in the AL this year to date... Tribe relievers own a 3.77 ERA (8th in AL) **but have allowed just 4ER in their last 17.0IP**... **Pen also has allowed just 3 of 29 inherited runners to score, which leads MLB.**

NEED TO PICK IT UP: The Indians offense has scored just 54 runs in 16 games (3.38RS/GM)... The 54 runs are 2nd fewest in the American League... Indians are 11th in the AL with 11HR...Are 13th in the league in average (.220), 11th in on-base % (.306) & 14th in Slg % (.343)... **Are 7-9 despite being outscored 72-54.**

GOOD GLOVEWORK: Despite making 3 errors last night, the Indians currently rank 7th in the AL in fielding at .984... Finished 2009 ranked 8th in team fielding(.984)... Indians have committed 10 errors thus far, T4th fewest in the AL... **Indians pitchers have made 3 of the 10 errors.**

VOTE TRIBE: Voting for the 2010, 81st Annual Midsummer Classic to be held July 13 at Angel Stadium in Anaheim, CA is now underway online... **Fans may vote for their favorite Indians up to 25 times at Indians.com while in-park balloting at Progressive Field and Indians Team Shops will run from April 30 ending June 12**... FAUSTO CARMONA has limited opponents to a .176 avg against, 5th best in the AL.

Indians have been shutout 3 times already, most in the AL... Were shutout 11 times last year, 3rd most in the AL.

Indians have allowed 15 unearned runs, most in the Majors this season.

Indians are 7-9 despite being outscored 72-54... 54 runs scored are 2nd fewest in the American League... 28 of 54 (51.8%) runs scored have come with 2-outs.

RHP FAUSTO CARMONA (2-0, 3.60ERA)

FAUSTO CARMONA ... Is making his 4th start and appearance of the 2010 season today vs. Oakland Athletics in the Oakland Coliseum, his 2nd start on the road this season and his 1st start vs. A's this year (8th game/7th career GS vs. Oakland)... **Signed long-term contract through 2011 w/club options for 2012, 2013 & 2014 seasons on April 10, 2008.**

- ⇒ Product of the Indians' Dominican Academy was the Tribe's Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2003.
- ⇒ In 2003 was named to the **Baseball America** Low Class A All-Star team and the #3 prospect overall in the Indians organization by **BA**...Pitched primarily at A Lake County where he led the South Atlantic League in wins (17) and ERA (2.06) and was a SAL All-Star... Won 10 games between 3 stops along the Tribe's minor league trail in 2004 and after the season was added to the club's 40-man roster.
- ⇒ Split the 2005 minor league season between Akron and Buffalo, going a combined 13-9 w/a 3.68 ERA in 27 games/26 starts between AAA Buffalo and AA Akron...His 173.2IP led the entire Indians organization.
- ⇒ Was the first member of the Indians' Lake County (A) affiliate to appear in a game for Cleveland...Split 2006 between Buffalo and Cleveland...Pitched in a variety of roles for the Indians
- ⇒ In 2007 posted one of the finest seasons by an Indians right-handed pitcher in recent memory, finishing with 19 wins, the most by an Indians pitcher since RHP Bert Blyleven in 1984 (19) at the age of 23...Youngest Indian RHP to reach 200.0IP since Eckersley in 1977... Finished 4th in the AL Cy Young voting, 2nd in the AL in ERA, he finished T2nd in wins (19), T10th in innings (215.0)...He was the youngest Indians RHP to win 17 or more games since Bob Feller did it each year between 1938-41 (ages 19-22)...Went a combined 13-19 in 2008-09.

LAST YEAR...⇒ Went 5-12 with a 6.32 ERA in 24 starts with the Indians last year... Started the year going 2-6 w/a 7.42 ERA in 12 starts from the beginning of the season to June 5... Was then optioned to Arizona to throw bullpens and working on mechanics and pre-pitch preparation with coordinators Julio Rangel, Dave Miller and Steve Lyons... Was then transferred to Lake County on June 25 to make a start (6.1IP, 1H, 0R) and then made another start at Akron on June 30 (7.0IP, 4H, 1R)... Spent July at AAA Columbus going 1-3 w/a 3.55 ERA in 5 starts... Recalled to Cleveland on July 31 and was 3-6 w/a 5.29 ERA in 12 starts thru the ended the season and went at least 5.0 innings in 10 of the 12 starts... Finished his season on a high note as he won his last 2 starts of the season and allowed just 3ER in 13.0 innings...

THIS SPRING ... Was impressive this spring, going 3-0 w/a 1.38 ERA in 5G/4GS (26.0IP, 15H, 4ER, 2BB, 12K)...Limited spring hitters to a .169 avg against (15-89) w/OHR allowed...Was 3rd in the AL in spring ERA and T5th in innings pitched and wins...At one point this spring had a 17.0 inning streak of consecutive scoreless innings against.

THIS YEAR...Notched his first win in his 2010 debut at Chicago on April 7, a 5-3 win over the Sox and Randy Williams...6.0IP, 1H, 3R/ER, 6BB, 1K, 2Run HR to Konerko in the 3rd inning (only hit allowed)...Worked a season-high by an Indians starter 8.0IP in his 2nd start vs. Texas in the home opener of April 12 vs. Texas (5H, 2R)...

⇒ **Improved to 2-0 on April 18 in a 7-4 win over the White Sox in Progressive Field... 6.0IP, 6H, 3R/ER, 2BB, 4K... Has now won 6 straight starts against the White Sox dating back to Sept. 2007, the 4th longest winning streak vs. a team...** Only Livan Hernandez (8 straight vs. WAS), Jon Lester (7 vs. BAL) & Derek Lowe (7 vs. PIT) have longer such streaks. **Source ELIAS.**
 ⇒So far thru 3 starts batters are hitting just .176 (12-68, 1HR) off him, the 5th lowest mark in the AL to date...LHH are 4 for 34 (.118) off him and RHH are 8 for 34 (.235, 1HR)...Batters are 6 for 32 (.188) with runners on base and 3 for 17 (.176) with RISP....Are 6 for 7 in steals against him...Indians are 3-1 when he starts.

LAST START: ... Earned his 2nd win of the season on Sunday, April 18 vs. the Chicago White Sox in Progressive Field... Was a 7-4 win over the Sox and Gavin Floyd... 6.0IP, 6H, 3R/ER, 2BB, 4K... Allowed 3 runs on 4 hits on the 5th inning... Threw 96 pitches/61 strikes.

SUNDAY'S STARTER: RHP JUSTIN MASTERSON will make his 4th start/appearance of the 2010 season on Sunday, April 25 against the Oakland Athletics in Oakland Coliseum... Dropped his 2nd consecutive start on April 20 in a 5-1 loss to the Minnesota Twins in Target Field... 4.0IP, 5H, 5R/2ER, 5BB, 6K...Fell to 0-1 in his 2nd start of the year against the Texas Rangers on April 14, a 6-2 loss to the Rangers and Colby Lewis...6.0IP, 9H, 4R/2ER, 0BB, season-high 9K, HR to Cruz...Did not get a decision in 2010 debut of Thursday, April 8 against the Chicago White Sox in US Cellular Field, a 5-3, 11.0 inning win over the Sox and JJ Putz...5.0IP, 4H, 1 R/ER, 2BB, 5K... **So far this year is 0-2 w/a 3.00 ERA (15.0IP, 18H, 10R/5ER, 7BB, 20K) through 3 starts...** This spring went 1-2 w/a 5.14 ERA in 6 games/5 starts for the Indians (21.0IP, 28H, 12ER, 6BB, 29K, .315AVG AGAINST)...Was 2nd among AL spring pitchers in strikeouts...Started the 2009 season in the Red Sox bullpen making 4 relief appearances (6.0IP, 7H, 3ER) before being taking Daisuke Matsuzaka's spot in the rotation...Went 2-2 w/a 4.59 ERA (35.1IP, 38H, 18ER) in 6 starts before returning to the bullpen May 22...Acquired by the Indians from the Boston Red Sox on July 31 along with **LHP NICK HAGADONE & BRYAN PRICE** for **CA VICTOR MARTINEZ**... Made his first start for Cleveland August 8 at Chicago-AL (4.0IP, 4H, 1ER) and stayed in the rotation through the end of the season... Was 1-7 w/a 4.80 ERA in 10 starts (54.1IP, 54H, 29ER) as the Indians scored just 27 runs in his starts... Finished the season on a high-note as he tossed a complete game (9.0IP, 4H, 1ER, 2BB, 12K) in a 1-0 loss to the White Sox on Sept. 30...
