### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics have won seven of their past eight games against Cleveland...have won 13 of the past 16 games between the two clubs at the Coliseum...are 9-2 this season when scoring first...went 6-4 on this 10-game homestand against Baltimore (3-1), New York (1-2) and Cleveland (2-1)...begin a six-game road trip tomorrow, with two games in Tampa Bay and then four games in Toronto.
- Gio Gonzalez tied a career-high with seven innings pitched (Sept., 6, 2009 vs. SEA)...is 2-0 with 1.62 ERA (3 er in 16.2 ip) in three career starts against Cleveland...A's starting pitchers have allowed five runs over the last five games (5 er in 31.0 ip, 1.45 ERA) and have allowed three runs or less in 17 of 20 games this year...are 9-3 with a 2.65 ERA (35 er in 118.2 ip) for the season.
- Andrew Bailey extended his scoreless innings streak to a career-high 16.0 innings (previous: 15.1 ip, June 14-July 19, 2009).
- Eric Chavez (2 for 4) snapped a 0-for-17 stretch with runners in scoring position with a two-run double in the first inning, his first hit with RISP since June 20, 2008... scored the 726<sup>th</sup> run of his career, moving him past Sal Bando for sole possession of fourth place in Oakland history...is one extra-base hit shy of tying Reggie Jackson for fifth on the A's career list...
- Rajai Davis (0 for 1) had his 10-game hitting streak against Cleveland in games in which he has an at-bat snapped...is batting .333 (13 for 39) in 13 games against the Indians overall.
- Eric Patterson (2 for 4) tied a career-high with three RBI (Sept. 24, 2009 vs. TEX).
- Ryan Sweeney (1 for 4) has reached base in each of his 19 games this season, which is the second-longest reaching base streak of his career (23, August 30-September 26, 2009)...has now reached base in 42 of his past 43 games dating back to August 30 of last year and is batting .333 (55 for 165) over that span...is a career .372 hitter against the Indians (16 for 43)
- Michael Wuertz threw two scoreless innings (1 h, 2 so) in a rehab appearance with High-A Stockton at Modesto...threw 26 pitches (21 strikes).

#### **CLEVELAND NOTES**

- The Cleveland Indians are 4-8 on the road this year and have lost 23 of their last 27 road games dating back to last year...are 2-4 on this nine-game road trip through Minnesota (1-2), Oakland (1-2) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Justin Masterson has lost his past nine decisions dating back to Aug. 20, 2009 (vs. LAA)...has now lost 11 straight road decisions (last win: June 18, 2008 at PHI).
- Asdrubal Cabrera (1 for 4) has a hit in nine of his past 10 games and is batting .333 (13 for 39) over that span.
- Shin-Soo Choo (2 for 4) has a hit in 11 of past 13 games and is hitting .391 (18 for 46) during that stretch...has reached base safely in 24 of his past 50 plate appearances.
- Austin Kearns (0 for 4) had his eight-game hitting streak in games in which he has an at-bat snapped...is now batting .323 (11 for 34) this season.
