TRIBE AT A GLANCE: The Indians will conclude 3-game set with the Oakland Athletics today at 1:07PM ET in the Oakland Coliseum... Series is part of a 3-city, 9-game roadtrip to Minnesota, Oakland and the LA Angels.... **Are 2-3 on the trip (lost 2 of 3 in MIN)**...Just concluded a 3-game weekend series sweep of the Chicago White Sox in Progressive Field... Series was part of a 6-game homestand against the Rangers and Chicago White Sox (went **3-3** on h-stand)...Just finished a 6-game roadtrip to Chicago and Detroit to begin the 2010 season at **2-4 (swept @DET)** ... Started year 2-1 marking first time the Tribe was above the .500 since the end of 2008...The Indians were never at or above .500 last year after starting the year at 0-5 and 1-7... **Indians lost 16 straight road games from August 30, 2009- April 5, 2010 (Club Record)** ...Indians are coming off a tremendous spring where they compiled a record of 19-9-3 (.679), the best record in the Cactus League...Also led the American League in spring ERA at 3.96... **SHIN-SOO CHOO** was T7th in the AL in RBI (16), 9th in average (.393), 7th in slugging % (.696) and 9th in total bases (39).

LOOKIN FOR A BAY SERIES WIN: The Indians and A's will play the rubber game of a 3-game set today in Oakland with the Indians looking for their 1st outright series win in Oakland since July 29-31 of 2002... Indians have lost 8 of their last 9 series in Oakland (split a 2G series in 2006)... The winning pitchers for the Tribe in taking 2 of 3 from Oakland in 2002 were Terry Mulholland & Ryan Dreese.

TWO OUT MAGIC: The Indians have scored 33 of their 60 (55%) runs this season with 2-outs... It is the highest percentage of runs scored in the American League with two outs...Courtesy **STATS LLC**.

KEARNS COMING THROUGH: OF AUSTIN KEARNS has hit in each of the 8 games he has batted in as he is hitting .367 (11-30) with 4 doubles and 4RBI thus far... His 3RBI yesterday were the most he has driven in since hitting a grand slam & driving in 4 runs April 18 of last year vs. Florida.

FANTASTIC FAUSTO: Yesterday, **FAUSTO CARMONA** improved to 3-0 on the season as he allowed just 1 run in 7.1 innings to the A's... **His 3 wins are tied for the AL lead**...Carmona has now tossed at least 6.0 innings in each of his 4 starts this year and now owns 3 of the Tribe's 8 wins... Carmona has allowed 3 or fewer runs in each of his 4 starts and has limited opponents to a .196 avg against, which is 6th best in the AL.

DOING THEIR PART: Indians pitching staff owns a 3.49 ERA thus far, 5th best in the American League... **Have allowed 128 hits, 2nd fewest in the AL**... Indians starters have gone 6.0 or more innings in 9 of last 11 games and 11 of 17 games this year...

Starters own a 2.82 ERA (73.1IP, 23ER) over the last 11 games and a 3.43 ERA on the year (5th best in AL)... Tribe starters own 2 of the 8 complete games in the AL this year to date... Tribe relievers own a 3.63 ERA (6th in AL) and have allowed just 4ER in their last 18.2IP... **Pen also has allowed just 3 of 31 inherited runners to score, which leads MLB.**

NEED TO PICK IT UP: The Indians offense has scored just 60 runs in 17 games (3.53RS/GM)... The 60 runs are 2nd fewest in the American League... Indians are 11th in the AL with 11HR...Are 14th in the league in average (.224), 11th in on-base % (.310) & 14th in Slg % (.341)... **Are 8-9 despite being outscored 73-60.**

RHP JUSTIN MASTERSON (0-2, 3.00ERA)

JUSTIN MASTERSON... Is making his 4th start and appearance of the 2010 season today against the Oakland Athletics in the Oakland Coliseum... It is his 14th start/15th appearance as an Indian... Also is his 3rd start and appearance on the road and his 1st start this year vs. the Athletics (2nd GS/5th game career).

⇒ **Acquired by the Indians along with LHP NICK HAGADONE and RHP BRYAN PRICE on July 31, 2009 in a trade with the Boston Red Sox in exchange for CA VICTOR MARTINEZ.**

⇒ First ever Jamaican born pitcher, 4th player joining Chili Davis, Devon White and Rolando Roomes in the Major Leagues...

⇒ Originally selected by the Boston Red Sox in the 2nd round (71st overall) of the 2006 First-Year Player draft out of San Diego St. University... Was ranked as the 24th overall draft-eligible prospect in 2006 by **Baseball America**.

⇒ Went 3-1 w/a 0.85 ERA in 14 appearances (31.2IP, 20H, 4R/3ER) during his first season as a pro in 2006 for Lowell and Wilmington

⇒ Advanced from Single-A Lancaster to Double-A Portland in 2007... Was a combined 12-8 w/a (153.2IP, 152H, 74ER, 40BB, 115K) in 27 starts between the two stops... Named the 4th best prospect, 2nd best pitcher in the Red Sox organization following the season by **Baseball America**... Also rated as having the "Best Fastball" by the publication.

Went 6-5 with a 3.16 ERA (88.1IP, 68H, 31ER, 40BB, 68K) in 36 appearances/9 starts with Boston... His 3.16 ERA was 5th best on the Red Sox staff...

⇒ Began the 2008 season as a starter at Double-A Portland and finished as a member of the Red Sox bullpen... Made 9 starts over 3 stints with Boston in the season's first half, going 4-3 w/a 3.67 ERA (54.0IP, 22ER)... Moved to the bullpen in July and was 2-2 with a 2.36 ERA (34.1IP, 9ER) in 27 appearances to end the regular season... Set a Red Sox rookie record with 9 appearances in the playoffs going 1-0 with a 1.86 ERA (9.2IP, 2ER).

LAST YEAR ... Started the season in the Red Sox bullpen making 4 relief appearances (6.0IP, 7H, 3ER) before being taking Daisuke Matsuzaka's spot in the rotation...Went 2-2 w/a 4.59 ERA (35.1IP, 38H, 18ER) in 6 starts before returning to the bullpen May 22... Went 1-1 with a 4.42 ERA in 25 relief outings with the Sox and was 3-3 w/a 4.50 ERA in 31 games/6 starts overall with the Red Sox...Acquired by the Indians from the Boston Red Sox on July 31 along with **LHP NICK HAGADONE & BRYAN PRICE for CA VICTOR MARTINEZ**...First appearance with the Indians came out of the bullpen as he tossed 3.0 scoreless innings on Aug. 1 vs. Detroit... Made his first start for Cleveland August 8 at Chicago-AL (4.0IP, 4H, 1ER) and stayed in the rotation through the end of the season... Was 1-7 w/a 4.80 ERA in 10 starts (54.1IP, 54H, 29ER) as the Indians scored just 27 runs in his starts... Finished the season on a high-note as he tossed a complete game (9.0IP, 4H, 1ER, 2BB, 12K) in a 1-0 loss to the White Sox on Sept. 30... Was his first career CG and set a new career-high in innings pitched and strikeouts (12)...Overall on the year with Cleveland & Boston was 4-10 with a 4.52 ERA (129.1IP, 128H, 65ER, 60BB, 119K) in 42 games/16 starts...

THIS SPRING... Went 1-2 w/a 5.14 ERA in 6 games/5 starts for the Indians (21.0IP, 28H, 12ER, 6BB, 29K, .315AVG AGAINST)...Was 2nd among AL spring pitchers in strikeouts...

THIS YEAR... Did not get a decision in his first start of Thursday, April 8 against the Chicago White Sox in US Cellular Field, a 5-3, 11.0 inning win over the Sox and JJ Putz...5.0IP, 4H, 1 R/ER, 2BB, 5K...92P...Struck out an Indians season-high 9 batters in his 2nd start vs. the Texas Rangers in Cleveland (L #1, 6.0IP, 9H, 4R/2ER, 9K)... Dropped his 2nd consecutive start on April 20 in a 5-1 loss to the Twins in Target Field... 4.0IP, 5H, 5R/2ER, 5BB, 6K.

⇒ **Carry's a personal 8-game losing streak into tonight's start covering his last 7 starts of the 2009 season from August 25th on and first 3 starts of 2010...Indians scored 20 runs over those 10 starts for Justin.**

⇒ So far thru 3 starts batters are hitting .295 (18-61) off him w/1 HR allowed...Is striking out 12.0SO/9.0IP and is T13th in the league in strikeouts w/ 20...RHH are hitting .189 (7-37, HR) and LHH are hitting .458 (11-24)...Batters are hitting .324 (11-34) with runners on and .231 (6-26) with RISP...Runners are 2 for 3 in steals against him...Indians are 1-2 in his starts.

LAST START ... Lost his 2nd straight on April 20 in a 5-1 loss to the Minnesota Twins and Kevin Slowey in Target Field... 4.0IP, 5H, 5R/2ER, 5BB, 6K... Allowed 4 runs in the 3rd as he threw a wild pitch and also committed an error... Threw 96 pitches/55 strikes.

ON THE ROAD ... Today is Justin's 3rd start/appearance on the road this year... **THIS YEAR:** Is 0-1 w/a 3.00 ERA (9.0IP, 9H, 6R/3ER, 7BB, 11K) in 2 road starts/appearances... **CAREER:** Is 1-11 w/a 4.66 ERA (110.0IP, 110H, 57ER, 55BB, 105K) in 14 career starts/38 appearances on the road...Career at home is 9-6 w/a 3.23 ERA...Has lost 10 straight road decisions dating back to 6/18/2008.
